FRISCO BLANKED IN SERIES FINALE BY AMARILLO:

The Frisco RoughRiders were shut out by the Amarillo Sod Poodles 8-0 in the final game of the three-game set from HODGETOWN on Sunday night. Frisco (7-8, 38-44) was held to just three singles on the offensive side, from **Kellen Strahm**, **Trevor Hauver** and **Evan Carter**. They stranded five on the bases. Amarillo (10-5, 44-40) scored in the first inning on an RBI groundout against Frisco starter **Noah Bremer** (0-1) before Neyfy Castillo hit a two-run home run and Jordan Lawlar cracked a three-run homer for a five-run second inning. The Sod Poodles totaled nine home runs in the three games. The Sod Poodles added on with a run in the sixth and another in the seventh. **Aidan Anderson** went a season-long 2.2 innings out of the Frisco bullpen, allowing just one run while **Nick Starr** struck out the side in the eighth in his one inning of work. In his Double-A debut, Yu-Min Lin (1-0) threw six shutout innings for the Sod Poodles, allowing just two singles and a walk while striking out eight batters.

GENTLEMEN, START YOUR ENGINES:

The RoughRiders have struggled on the starting pitching side of things this season. This year, Frisco has a 6.12 starting pitcher ERA which is the highest in recorded franchise history (dating back to 2005) and second in the league to Amarillo (6.14). They have used 19 different starting pitchers already, more than the 14 they used all season in 2022 and as many as they used the whole year in 2021. Frisco has not have a start of more than 5.1 innings since June 10th, when **Ryan Garcia** went seven innings. Over those 28 games since June 10th, the Riders' starters' ERA is 7.74 (86EB/100.0IP) while the bullpen has a 4.58 ERA (72ER/141.1IP). Over the 28 games, the Riders have the fifth-best offense in the league by OPS (.767) and have hit 27 home runs .

HATCH IS THE RIGHT MATCH:

Since coming to Frisco in June from High-A Hickory, **Josh Hatcher** has been a run-producing machine. In his 14 games, he has driven in 17 runs and in July, Hatcher is hitting .355/.371/.548/.919 with two homers and 13 RBIs in eight games.

WELCOME BACK, CARTER:

Evan Carter has been fantastic since returning from the Injured List on June 21st against Springfield. Over his last 20 games since his return, he has seven multi-hit games, batting .342 (27-for-79)/.404/.557/.961 with three doubles, one triple, four home runs, 14 RBIs and 15 runs scored.

THOMAS THE TANK ENGINE:

Thomas Saggese has been incredible for the RoughRiders on offense. Over his last 32 games, he is hitting .365/.445/.667/1.112 with nine home runs and 30 RBIs. The California native is currently fourth in the league in batting average (.313), third in RBIs (65), eighth in slugging percentage (.512), second in hits (102), third in doubles (20) and second in total bases (167).

AMBUSH EARLY AND OFTEN:

Thomas Saggese has been fantastic on first pitches this season, first in the Texas League (min. 11 at-bats) with a .586 average (17-for-29) when he puts the first pitch of an at-bat in play. He has a 1.544 OPS on the first pitch, which is first in the league as well. **Luisangel Acuña** has also been great, hitting .463 (25-for-54) on the initial offering while his 25 hits on the first pitch lead the league and are second in the minors

SPEED KILLS:

Luisangel Acuña leads the league in steals with 36 and is on pace for a career-best 60 swipes. Acuña is on pace to set a single-season record for the Riders, as **Elvis Andrus** has the record with 54 swipes in 2008. The RoughRiders are fifth in Texas League steals with 110 bases in 132 attempts (83 percent).

ONE HOME RUN, PLEASE. AND MAKE IT GRAND:

The RoughRiders have had a knack for grand slams this year with **Thomas Saggese** hitting Frisco's seventh grand slam of the season. They are one of two teams with seven grand slams in all of Minor League Baseball. Six different players have accounted for the grand slams (Hicks, **Luisangel Acuña**, **Jax Biggers**, **Dustin Harris**, **Trevor Hauver**, **Thomas Saggese** (2)). On July 5th, the Riders allowed their first grand slam this year, becoming the final Texas League team to do so.

ACUÑA MATATA:

RoughRiders infielder **Luisangel Acuña** has been on fire at the plate. The Rangers No. 3 prospect is hitting .354/.415/.438/.853 in July. He is fifth in the Texas League in batting average (.308), third in hits (99), third in doubles (20), second in runs (59) and first in steals (36).

ABOUT DANE

-Went to Brenham High School in Brenham, Texas (between Austin and Houston). His senior year of high school, he went 5-2 with a 1.79 ERA.

-Acker attended Rice for freshman season, going 5-2 with a 4.20 ERA and earned Conference USA All-Freshman Team honors. From there, transferred to San Jacinto College for sophomore season in 2019, going 10-0 with a 2.36 ERA in 14 starts. He struck out 97 batters in 76.1 IP.

-Drafted by the Arizona Diamondbacks in the 2019 23rd round, but did not sign.

-For his junior season, he went to Oklahoma University, making four starts in the COVIDshortened season, going 1-1 with a 3.51 ERA. At the Schrines College Classic on March 1st against No.11 LSU, Acker threw the first Oklahoma no-hitter since 1989, striking out 11 batters to just one walk and two hit batters. He threw 117 pitches in the game.

-Acker was taken by the Oakland Athletics in the 4th round of the 2020 draft, one pick after Braves pitcher Spencer Strider.
