LAST TIME OUT: The St. Paul Saints tossed their first nine-inning, team shutout since doing so in back-to-back games to open the 2025 season as five Saints pitchers combined to blank Indianapolis in a 4-0 win on Saturday afternoon at Victory Field, snapping a four-game losing streak. Mike Paredes got the start for the Saints and retired the side in order in the first two innings, snapping a streak in which opponents had scored a run in either the first or second inning in seven straight. The Saints scored for the first time in eight games, putting up a crooked number in the third. Ben Ross chopped a double past Alike Williams at third for his first Triple-A hit, a double, tagged up and eventually scored on an RBI groundout by Kaelen Culpepper. After a Ryan Kreidler infield hit, Kyler Fedko knocked a looping single to left to score two. Travis Adams followed Paredes' 3.0 shutout frames with two of his own to notch the win. Aaron Rozek, Dan Altavilla, and Drew Smith retired the last seven hitters to close the game.

PITCHING SUPERLATIVES: On Saturday, the St. Paul pitching staff combined for their first shutout win of the season. The Saints had played 170 games without a 9-inning shutout as a team until Saturday's win; St. Paul's staff opened the 2025 campaign with back-to-back shutout victories (one at home vs Indianapolis on March 28, the other on April 1 @Columbus following two straight rainouts), and did not shut out an opponent in a nine-inning game the rest of the year. In the win Saturday, Saints hurlers did not allow an extra-base hit for the first time since Opening Night when they scattered four singles in a 4-2 win at Victory Field.

WHO IS ZEB? Zebby Matthews gets the ball for the Saints in the series finale after having his start pushed back two days following an illness. The Cullowhee, N.C. native has allowed 14 ER in four starts after allowing just 7 ER in eight games with St. Paul last year. First reaching the Triple-A level in July of 2024, Matthews had gone 3-3, 3.07 ERA (19 ER, 55.2 IP) with a 70:10 SO:BB ratio over his first 12 starts. He is 0-2, 7.71 ERA (14 ER, 16.1 IP), 3 BB, 13 SO in four starts since then (all this season).

NO STARTERS, JUST OUT-GETTERS: The Saints are one of just four teams in the International League that have not had a starting pitcher complete at least 6.0 innings this year (also Omaha, Toledo, & Syracuse). St. Paul relievers have had to cover the second-most innings in Triple-A (138.2, trailing only El Paso-141.2). The Saints have had just two starting pitcher performances go at least 5.0 innings (Connor Prielipp on 4/16 vLHV & Zebby Matthews on 4/11 @TOL). Every other team in the IL has at least 3.

TAKE ME HOME, CAUSE I DON'T REMEMBER: The Saints offense has had extreme splits to begin the season when hitting at CHS Field compared to hitting away from the friendly confines this season. In St. Paul, the Saints are one of the best hitting teams in Triple-A, but have struggled mightily away from their home fans so far this season. Entering play Sunday, 19 of the Saints' 49 runs scored on the road have been accounted for by home runs (39%).

SWEET, SWEET VICTORY (FIELD): The Saints make their return to Victory Field for the first time since sweeping Pittsburgh's Triple-A affiliate in three games on Opening Weekend. The wins in three days from March 27-29 marked their first-ever sweep in the ballpark in franchise history. The Saints went just 1-5 in their lone series in Indianapolis last year and were just 1-11 the year prior. Since winning the first four games of a series from April 11-14, 2023 at Victory Field, the Saints had not even won back-to-back games in the ballpark until Opening Weekend; St. Paul were 2-19 in their previous 21 games in Indy entering the season.

LABORING EARLY, COMING ON STRONG LATE: Entering play Sunday, the St. Paul Saints staff have thrown the most pitches in the International League (3rd in MiLB) as a team so far (4,115). However, the two games on Friday and Saturday in Indy have been the fewest and 2nd-fewest pitches thrown in a game by St. Paul all year (121 on Friday, 118 on Saturday). Over the first 16 games of the season, the Saints had the 3rd-fewest strikeouts (138) and the most walks issued in the league (97), but in the nine games since then, they've combined for a 80:30 (2.67) strikeout-to-walk ratio, the 4th-best in the league in that span (their 1.42 over the first 16 games was the worst).

VARIETY IS THE SPICE OF LIFE: In his first 25 games as Saints manager, Brian Dinkelman has turned in 25 unique lineup cards. Only two Saints hitters have batted from the same spot more than 10 times (Kaelen Culpepper and Walker Jenkins, both leadoff). Only Culpepper (SS), Jenkins (CF), Orlando Arcia (2B), & Alex Jackson (C) have started at least 12x at a given position.

TWINS OF TOMORROW: The Saints opened the season with nine of the Twins' Top-30 ranked prospects according to MLB.com, marking the most players listed on MLB's Minnesota Top-30 list to open a campaign in the Saints' history as a Triple-A franchise. Between Walker Jenkins, Kaelen Culpepper, Emmanuel Rodriguez, & Connor Prielipp, they touted four prospects on either the MLB.com or Baseball America Top-100 list, surpassing last year's total of three when Rodriguez, Luke Keaschall, and Zebby Matthews all began the year with the Saints. The remaining ranked prospects included Gabriel Gonzalez (7/10), Andrew Morris (13/13), Marco Raya (18/21), and John Klein (20/23). LHP Kendry Rojas (10/8) also opened the year on the Saints' injured list. Morris, Prielipp, and Rojas all have all seen big league time so far this season for the first time in their careers.

LAST APPEARANCE: Started Friday at home against Lehigh Valley and went at least 4.0 innings for the third time in four starts...gave up solo homers in 1st and 3rd innings while pitching around traffic in every frame on the day...threw 35 four-seamers (36%), 20 sliders (21%), 14 curveballs (15%), 10 sinkers (10%), 10 cutters (10%), and 7 splitters (7%)...generated 13 swings-and-misses, tying a season-high

HITTING THE GLOVE: In 2024, Matthews opened up the year on an incredible stretch without walking a batter. He issued his first walk of the season on May 22, seven starts into the campaign (also his 24th birthday). He struck out 49 batters before issuing a walk, facing 141 hitters before issuing a free pass. Since 1893, when the mound was moved to its current position, only two major league pitchers began a season with more strikeouts before issuing a walk: Kenley Jansen with the Dodgers in 2017 (51 K) and Corbin Burnes for the Brewers in 2021 (58 K). Matthews led the Minors with a 16.29 K:BB ratio that year among all arms with at least 40 IP, and was 6th among all MLB rookies with at least 35.0 IP with a 3.91 ratio during his time in the Bigs to end the year. Since going pro, his career 10.55 K:BB ratio in the minors leads MiLB entering the season (min 200 IP).

TINKERING WITH THE ARSENAL: A big reason for Matthews' success over the past two seasons has been a jump in velocity, which he attributes to attending the Twins' velocity camp before the start of Spring Training. He went from a college pitcher who sat in the low-90's, sometimes touching 96 mph, to a guy who regularly sits at 96 with his fastball while occasionally reaching back for 98. Working with Tommy Bergians in the Spring of 2024, he scrapped a sweepy slider he threw in 2023 for a harder slider in 2024, which pairs well with his cutter, curveball, and changeup.

WHAT THE HECK IS A CATAMOUNT?: After starting his college career at Walters State Community College (TN) in 2019, Matthews transferred to the Division 1 ranks at Western Carolina, where he would put together one of the best careers for a Catamount pitcher in school history. After being limited to just 61.1 innings due to an elbow injury as a RS sophomore, he put together a 1st Team All-Southern Conference campaign in 2022, striking out 122, the only pitcher in the SoCon's history to eclipse the century mark; it was the third-most strikeouts in a single-season in program history for Western Carolina. When he went in the 8th round (234th overall) in 2022, he became the highest draft pick in Western Carolina history.

HIGHS & LOWS: While a high school pitcher, Zebby once gave up a walk-off homer in the 2nd round of the 2A NCHSAA playoffs

2025

- Opened the season with the Saints & went 2-1, 1.92 ERA (7 ER, 32.2 IP) before earning a promotion to the Twins...struck out 38 (28 K%) against 9 walks (7 BB%)
- Answered David Festa's 5.0 shutout frames on Opening Day with 5.0 scoreless innings of his own on April 1 @Columbus
- Went at least 5.0 innings and gave up 2 runs or fewer in each of his first three starts...did not allow more than 2 ER in any of his six starts before going up
- With the Twins, went 1-1 with a 5.21 ERA (11 ER, 19.0 IP) over four starts before landing on the 15-Day IL with a right shoulder strain
- Came back for one start on rehab assignment on July 13 vs Iowa...fired 4.0 shutout innings and struck out nine...did not walk a batter and gave up just one hit
- Following his rehab stint, closed the year going 4-5, 5.67 ERA (38 ER, 60.1 IP) across 12 starts with Minnesota...struck out 63 and walked 16 while yielding 10 HR
- In total with the Twins, made a career-high 16 starts in his second year in the big leagues, and produced a 5.56 ERA with 12 HRA across 79.1 innings
- Had the 7th-largest difference between his ERA and his FIP (3.79) in MLB (min 50 IP)

2024

- Jim Rantz Award Winner (Twins Minor League Pitcher of the Year)
- Ascended from High-A Cedar Rapids to to the Bigs in one season, becoming the first Twins pitcher since Randy Dobnak in 2019 to pitch at four separate levels in the Twins organization, including Minnesota, in one season
- Across 3 levels in the minors, accrued a 6-3 record with a 2.60 ERA, striking out 114 batters against just 7 walks in 97.0 IP...Led MiLB in K:BB ratio (16.29, min 40 IP)
- Promoted to Triple-A St. Paul on July 14 and made four starts for the Saints from July 21-August 8, going 1-2, 5.68 ERA, striking out 23 with just one walk in 19.0 IP
- Made his MLB Debut on Aug. 13 vs Kansas City at Target Field, earning the win with 5.0 innings of 2-run ball (struck out eventual AL MVP Bobby Witt Jr. for first MLB K)...went 1-4, 6.69 ERA across 9 starts w/ Twins to end year, struck out 43 vs 11 BB in 37.2 IP

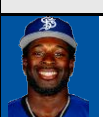
