LET'S BOUNCE BACK: After dropping the first game of the series with the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers last night, the FredNats will try to break this mini three-game skid tonight against this Chicago White Sox affiliate Kannapolis. This series is the first time since May of 2022 that the FredNats and Cannon Ballers meet, and this is the second of 12 scheduled meetings this year as FXBG will return to Kannapolis on the last road trip of the season. Tonight, RHP Travis Sykora makes his sixth professional start, all with Fredericksburg. He pitched very well last week in Kinston, allowing a walk and a double on the first two hitters of the game but then setting down 12 in a row with a careerhigh seven strikeouts after that. He faces Kannapolis righty Jake Peppers, who has been solid for the Ballers this year.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: FredNat starter Bryan Polanco did well to dance around a bunch of traffic on the base paths in the early part of the game, allowing just two runs with only one them being earned in four innings pitched. The FredNat offense was shut down by the Kannapolis pitching staff, with starter Jake Bockenstedt throwing six shutout innings. Three relievers came in to throw single shutout innings each, and FXBG was held to just three hits and was shut out for the fourth time this season and the second time in the last three games.

ROSTER MOVEMENT: Prior to yesterday's game, the FredNats made several roster moves. Carolina League save leader Thomas Schultz was promoted to High-A Wilmington after posting a league-best eight saves and an ERA of 1.82 in 24.2 IP. Returning to the FredNats from Wilmington is infielder John McHenry, who appeared in three games with FXBG prior to an early-season promotion to Wilmington. Reliever Anthony Arguelles returns to Fredericksburg from the Complex after four early-season appearances with FXBG.

FORMULA FOR SUCCESS: The FredNats are 21-4 this season when scoring first, including 18 out of the last 19 wins. Two of the four losses did come last week in Kinston against the Wood Ducks. FXBG did not score first in any of its losses in their last home series aginst the Lynchburg Hillcats.

BULLPEN WORK: So far in 2024, the FredNat bullpen has been one of the best units in all of Minor League Baseball. So far this season, the bullpen has pitched 271 innings this year and allowed 83 earned runs for a group ERA of 2.76, which is the best in the Carolina League. The Freddies are also 14/15 in save opportunities, and prior to his promotion, Thomas Schultz was first in the Carolina League and T-4th in MiLB with eight saves. Fredericksburg remains undefeated when leading after 7 (23-0), and 8 (24-0) innings this season as well.

HITTER OF THE MONTH: Roismar Quintana was named the Washington Nationals FredNat hitter of the month for May. In that month, he slashed .289/.352/.470 for an OPS of .822, and since May 1, his wOBA is .377 (great, .320 is average), and his wRC+ is 132.

STAY HOT NATE: Nate Ochoa's two-run homer in the 7th was another notch in his recent strong stretch at the pate. In Ochoa's last 10 games, he's slashing .308/.333/.538 for an OPS of .871 with two homers, and he's driven in 11 runs in that time frame.

RBI KING: Brandon Pimentel continues to lead the be second in all of Minor League Baseball Double-A and below in RBI with 48 after he drove in another run last night. This year, Pimentel is hitting .411 with runners in scoring position, and is 10-for-20 (.500) with runners in scoring position and two outs. Pimentel continues to be one of the best situational hitters in all of MiLB.

THE SKIP IS BACK: The FredNats' leader from the last two seasons returns to the Managerial role for 2024. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg Lowery, 34, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Iriple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978. Lowery is 170-142 in his two-plus years as Manager in Fredericksburg, including the 2022 Carolina League playoffs.

THE STAFF: The majority of the 2023 coaching staff returns for 2024, with the lone exception being Hitting Coach Mike Habas. Pitching Coach Justin Lord, Development Coach Carmelo Jaime, Performance Analyst Josh Freligh, Strength & Conditioning Nathan Sier and Athletic Trainer Jake Meyer are all back from last year's staff. Lord, 44, will begin his fourth season coaching in the Washington organization. The Alabama native and Florida State alum pitched six seasons professionally before transitioning to coaching, spending time in the Baltimore organization prior to joining the Nationals.

Habas, 33, begins his first season in the Washington organization after spending the last four seasons coaching in the Milwaukee Brewers organization. He was the hitting coach for the ACL Brewers the last two seasons, and was an Assistant Coach for the independent Gary SouthShore RailCats and Head Coach at Prarie State Junior College prior to his time with Milwaukee. Jaime, 38, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and has served as the first base coach and infield coach with the FredNats the past two seasons, roles he will continue in 2024. Meyer is in his seventh year with the Nationals overall and second with the FredNats, he spent his first five years at the facility in West Palm Beach, FL. Sier is in his second year with FXBG after previous stops with 2SP Sports and Macomb Community College (MI). Freligh begins his second year with the Nationals after previous stops with the Boston Red Sox and Los Angeles Dodgers.

TONIGHT'S START: Travis Sykora is making his sixth professional start this evening for Fredericksburg, against the Kannapolis Cannon Ballers. Sykora has worked as the Thursday starter, but due to some re-shuffling, he slides up a day this week.

He was taken in the third round by Washington in the 2023, who gave him double-slot money to sign him away from a commitment to pitch at the University of Texas. That, along with some command issues that popped up during his senior year at Round Rock HS, caused him to fall from a first-round projection into the third.

QUICK CLIMBER: Sykora was promoted to the FredNats during the late April series against the Delmarva Shorebirds, but did not pitch. He also did not pitch last year after being drafted, but Washington felt he was ready to jump to full-season ball and will bypass the Florida Complex League entirely.

Sykora's calling card is a big fastball that reached 101 MPH on the prep circuit, and will sit in the mid to upper 90's. He pairs the heater with a splitter and a tight slider, both in the mid 80's.

A BIG MENTOR: Sykora has been open about how much he looks up to fellow Texan Nolan Ryan. Travis sees similarities in their two deliveries, between a high leg kick and "elbows and knees flying everywhere," Sykora said in a MLB.com interview. He was able to meet Ryan this offseason.

LAST TIME OUT: Sykora brought his 'A' stuff last week in Kinston, as he held Down East to just one base hit while striking out a career-high seven hitters.
