### Today's Game

The Clippers will send RHP **Austin Peterson** to the mound today, looking for his first win of the season (progressed from 44 pitches in first start to 61 in second). Iowa will counter with LHP **Jordan Wicks**. Columbus is 3-10 (.231) versus left handers this year. Wicks has pitched against the Clippers five times in his career, going 1-2 with a (13.1IP, 12H, 6R, 6ER, 5BB, 18K).

### vs. the Cubs

Since a 5G win streak against Iowa from 5/12-6/14/24, the Clippers are 18-18 opposing the I-Cubs (33-25 in the last 58G). Individually, **Juan Brito** has 7HR and 23RBI in 29G against Iowa in his career, while **Nolan Jones** has hit 9HR with 34RBI in 35G (.302, 39x129) and **Milan Tolentino** has 9HR and 21RBI in 25G (.333, 29x87). **Stuart Fairchild** has hit .329 (26x79) with 4HR and 10RBI in 21G.

### Something in the Water

**Juan Brito's** grand slam last night was the 29th hit by a Clipper since the start of 2022 and the 10th hit against Iowa (seven on the banks of the Raccoon River, including one in three straight from 6/30-7/2/22 and consecutive games by **CJ Kayfus** from 6/24-6/25/25). Overall, the Clippers have hit 56HR in 49G in Des Moines since the beginning of the 2022 season (302 runs scored, 6.2 per game).

### Bad Losses

Last night's loss dropped the Clippers to 3-3 when they score at least 10 runs (rest of the IL is 67-2; Louisville and Worcester own the losses, with Worcester's coming to Columbus) and 7-3 when they lead by at least a grand slam (rest of the IL is 203-16, .927). While the Columbus comeback came up a run short last night, they still have the IL's best run differential from the 8th inning on (+35, 62-27).

### At the Top

**Stuart Fairchild** will start things off for the Clippers, batting leadoff for the third time (leadoff HR last night). Fairchild is hitting .286 (6x21) since the calendar flipped to May, but has crafted a .483OBP (7BB; .435OBP in April). Following him will be **Juan Brito**, making his 168th start batting second (79G more than any IL player since debut). Brito has a hit in each of 7G this month (.333, 10x30).

### Watch Out for Watson

Though he struggled in Buffalo (2x13 in 3G), **Kahlil Watson** is hitting .328/.476/.578 with 9XBH in his last 18G (1XBH in first 12G). His 4G walk streak was snapped Wednesday (5BB in 19PA, 4/30-5/5), but he has reached base in each of his last 9G (.477OBP since 4/23) and he has hit safely in 5G (.333, 7x21 since 5/1). He had 2SB on Thursday, pushing him to 21SB in his Clipper career (88 in MiLB).

### Since the Option

**George Valera** is hitting just .188 (6x32) this month with a double and 2RBI (.294, 10x34 with 3XBH and 12RBI in 8G rehab last month). While he has only 9K in 33PA in May (27%), he has only 1BB. In fact, he has 4BB in 73PA (5%) with Columbus this season (130BB in 972PA, 13%, in 233G with Columbus from 2022-25). His season-long strikeout rate (16%) is also down (27% from 2022-25).

### Hot Huff

**Kody Huff** rebounded from a pair of hitless games to end April with hits in each of his first 6G this month (.600, 12x20, five multi-hit). He has an XBH in each of his last 5G and 11XBH in his last 18G (.636SLG since 4/16). Huff is dominating on the run production front, sitting at 23 runs and 29RBI through 31G (one of 12 in the IL with 20+ of both; had 31 runs and a career high 47RBI in 101G last year).

### POW Hangover

Since being named the IL's Batter of the Week for 4/14-4/19 vs. Iowa (10x20, 4HR, 10RBI), **Milan Tolentino** is hitting .146/.281/.208 with 0HR and 1RBI in 13G (pair of doubles last night). Of 31 IL batters with at least 20HR since the start of last season, Tolentino is one of two that has not homered off LHP (104AB; 27HR in 406AB vs. RHP), but he is hitting .375 (9x24) off lefties this year (.138 in '25).

### No Experience Necessary

**Maick Collado** has hit safely in every game since skipping over Double-A to make his Triple-A debut on 4/26 at Buffalo (11x29 with 6XBH and 5RBI in 8G). Collado was a career .228 hitter over 188G in Advanced-A with Lake County, having gone hitless in 6G this year (.147/.205/.294 in 10G). Between Columbus and Lake County, he already has eight doubles (career best is 13, set last year in 84G).

# Columbus Clippers Game Information

## This Date in Clipper History

5/9/1990

**Hensley Meulens** homered off of Scranton's **Todd Frohwrith** in the top of the 10th inning to propel Columbus to a 7-5 win over the Red Barons. The 1990 season was Bam-Bam's first as an IL All-Star (OF), as he also took home the League's MVP Award. He would be named an All-Star again in 1992 (3B), becoming the 3rd of four Clippers to make multiple teams (**Jorge Posada**, **Randy Velarde** and **Marshall Brant**).

## Huntington (Small) Park

In each of the first 11 seasons after the move downtown (2009-19), Huntington Park ranked among the top two in the IL in homers per game. With the arrival of six new parks to the IL in 2021, Huntington Park finished 4th, 6th and 10th from 2021-23, respectively. The 2024 season saw a return to the top (2.96; 108HR hit by the Clippers, most for the home team in HP's existence), but it dropped back to 7th last year (2.31). Including the postseason, the Clippers have been out-homered over the life of the park (1,423 to 1,372).

## Challenging Times

The Clippers are 47-51 (.480) in pitch reviews, with batters going 30-36 (.455) and pitchers/catchers going 17-15 (.531). They have run out of challenges in 21G and have not challenged in 2G. Last season, they were correct 43.1% of the time (2nd worst in the IL).

## Extras, Read All About Them

Columbus is 1-3 in extra innings this season, after having gone 5-5 in 2025 and 9-9 in 2024 (most losses since 2013, 12). Since the start of the 2018 season, when baserunners started appearing at second base, the Clippers are 51-36 when playing past regulation (.586, best in the IL; no other team above .570), including 26-17 at home (.605, but 4-7 in last 11G). Of the 87G to require extra play, 69 have been resolved after one frame (including eight DH games) and only one has gone past the 12th (5-4 loss in 13 innings on 9/20/22 at Toledo). From 7/31/19-6/26/21, Columbus played 85 straight within the allotted innings.

## Didn't Add Up

The first half of the 2025 season saw the Clippers finish 12th with a 34-38 record (.472), despite ranking 10th in run differential (+3), 10th in pitching (4.61ERA) and 2nd in defense (.984; ranked 13th in batting, .250). Such a result was the product of a league-high 27 losses by three runs or fewer (22-27, .449, 13th), as they played in the fewest games decided by at least four runs (12-11, .522, 9th). In the second half, they went 19-21 in close games, while going 11-22 in blowouts.

## Hits the Spot

When turning in as many or fewer hits than their opponents last season, the Clippers went 18-64 (.220), coming in 13th out of 20 in the IL. The 2024 season saw them post an IL-worst .185 (12-53) winning percentage in such games. When allowing at least 10 hits last year, Columbus was 7-41 (.146, 20th in the IL; started the season 1-20).

## Juiced is Loose

In the Huntington Park Era (since 2009), Columbus leads the IL with 76 grand slams and 1,872RBI (led IL in RBI in 2010, '11, '12, '17, '18 and '22). Collecting an IL-best 10 grand slams last season, it marked their fifth straight season with at least four (118RBI last year; had only 97RBI in 2024, worst in a 140+G season since 2016).

## Not So Fast

On the basepaths, the 2024 Clippers established a franchise record of 200SB, (80% success rate) with four players topping 20 for the first time in club history. As a team, they were successful on 30 consecutive attempts (6/16-6/30/24) and 36 straight tries (7/23-8/7/24, including 8SB on 7/31/24 vs. Syracuse). Last season was a different story entirely, as they finished with the worst stolen base percentage in the IL (72%, 127SB and 49CS).

## Three True Outcomes

While not breaking records last season, the Clipper pitching staff topped 660BB for the third time ever (all in last three years, franchise record of 767BB in 2023) and cleared 1,300K for the fourth time (all in the last four years, franchise record of 1,392K in 2024). The homer rate was down considerably last year, but the three true outcome rate still ended around 39% (the 2024 season saw franchise high of 40.5%; last six seasons have all been at least 37.0%, no seasons above 33.4% prior).

## Department of Defense

The Columbus defense is sitting at 11th in the IL this year (.978), following a 2025 that saw a franchise record (.985, led the IL). On 4/10 at Worcester, the defense collapsed for the first 5E game since 8/27/24 (topped out at 3E in a game twice last year and had fewer than 5E in 21 of 26 series). The Clippers have played flawlessly in 20G this season (11-9, .550), after doing so in nearly 60% of games last year (44-42, .512), including 16 straight from 6/20-7/8/25 (longest streak in the IL over the last 20 years).

## Key to Victory

From 2022-23, Columbus owned the best record in the IL when holding opponents to three runs or fewer, going 95-8 (.922, no other team was above .880). The Clippers were 43-10 in such games in 2024 (.811, 13th in the IL), accumulating four losses by 4/14, and were just 47-10 (.825, 9th) last year, collecting four losses over 14G from 4/23-5/9 (had four losses total in both 2022 and 2023).

## Good Baseball

**Juan Brito** moved a runner into scoring position with a sac bunt on 5/7 at lowa and that runner came around to score in a 2-run win. Since the start of the 2018 season, Columbus is 85-23 (.787) in games in which a run is scored after a good bunt attempt, including a 2-2 mark this season (.500, blew 7-run lead in one of the losses; went 23-2 in 2018).

## To the End

The Clippers had the 6th most last at bat losses this season (17), after pacing the circuit with 23 in 2024 (tied with Toledo). They also suffered the 4th most walk-off losses (8), watching three in a row slip away at Rochester from 5/29-5/31. The 2024 season saw 41G decided in the last at bat (tied for 2nd most in the IL, one off lead), with Columbus going 18-23 in those contests (t-17th, .439).

## Manager Profile

**Andy Tracy** made his Clippers debut in 2021, following **Tony Mansolino's** championship rookie year in 2019 (sixth Clipper skipper to win Governors' Cup in first season; **Gene Michael**-'79, **Joe Altobelli**-'80, **Frank Verdi**-'81, **Bucky Dent**-'87 and **Mike Sarbaugh**-'10). This season marks Tracy's sixth year as a manager (first was with Williamsport in the Philadelphia system), as he holds a career record of 405-424 (.488), 375-378 with Columbus (.498).
