LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox are winners of four consecutive games for the first time all season, as they took down the Erie SeaWolves 7-5 on Friday night. Zach Watson and Shayne Fontana paved the way for Bowie, as each player homered in the top of the second inning - a solo blast for Fontana, before a two-run shot for Watson - to give the Baysox an early 3-0 lead. Starter Cade Povich would go four frames for Bowie, allowing Erie to score four unanswered runs in its next two trips to the plate to take a 4-3 lead. Povich allowed six hits on the evening and walked a season-high five batters. Watson restored the Baysox lead in the sixth with his second two-run home run of the night and Fontana added on insurance with his two-run double in the seventh to give Bowie its 7-4 edge. The Baysox bullpen allowed just one run in the final six frames, on a solo home run to Colt Keith, as Kade Strowd (2 IP, 0 R) and Tyler Burch (1.2 IP, 1 ER) bridged the gap to Ofreidy Gomez (1.1 IP, 0 R) to pick up his second save with the Baysox.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Erie SeaWolves enter tonight with a record of 29-26 - one game behind the Altoona Curve atop the Eastern League Southwest division. The Double-A affiliate of the Detroit Tigers, last night's loss solidifies Erie's first series loss since April. The SeaWolves had won or split each of their last five series, including take four of six from the Baysox in Bowie at the beginning of May, and were 21-9 in their last 30 games entering action this week. No. 2 Tigers/No. 84 overall prospect (via MLB Pipeline) Colt Keith leads a SeaWolves offense that collectively paces the league in OPS (.779) and slugging (.424). Keith ranks second in the league in average (.329) and hits (68), while leading the league in OPS (.983) and slugging (.580). He was also named the Eastern League's Player of the Month for May on Monday. Keith joins RHPs Wilmer Flores (No. 4 DET), Ty Madden (No. 5 DET), and Dylan Smith (No. 15 DET), alongside LHP Brant Hurter (No. 21 DET), as well as INF Wenceel Perez (No. 8 DET) and Gage Workman (No. 28 DET) as other notable prospects on the Erie roster.

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Wilmer Flores is set to get the ball tonight for Erie. Flores has been consistent for the SeaWolves, allowing just four home runs across 45.1 innings, while striking out twice as many (41) as he's walked (20). After allowing 13 ER in his first three starts (8.1 innings), Flores has only allowed nine earned runs in his last nine starts, while not allowing more than two earned runs in any single outing. Flores is coming off four innings against Richmond on Sunday, where he allowed one run on a single hit, walking none and striking out six. The right-hander faced the Baysox back on 5/6, taking the win after allowing a pair of earned runs on four hits through five innings, walking two and striking out three. In three starts against Bowie last season, Flores allowed six earned runs across 14.1 innings (3.77 ERA), striking out seven batters in each of his three outings. He is the brother of 11-year big league vet Wilmer Flores and was originally signed by the Tigers as a free agent in July of 2020. His arsenal features a mid-90s fastball, high-70s curveball, and a mid-80s cutter.

DOUBLE THE MAYO!

INF Coby Mayo has been a balanced mix of power, patience, and run production at the plate for the Baysox. Mayo leads the Double-A level with 19 doubles and is second with 28 extra-base hits. The No. 8 Orioles/No. 99 overall prospect, per MLB Pipeline, hit his eighth home run of the season last night, giving him an extra-base hit in nine of his last 12 games, to go along with seven walks in his last six contests. Mayo leads the Baysox with 32 walks and a .927 OPS. He is in the midst of a 23-game on-base streak - third-longest by a member of the Baysox this season (John Rhodes - 25 [Active], Heston Kjerstad - 29) and the third-longest such streak in the Eastern League.

HAIL CESAR

INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with 74 hits and a .365 average. Prieto has been on fire this week. The No. 16 Orioles' prospect is 10-for-19 on the week with 8 RBI, with at least three-hits in all three of the four games this week, including his second four-hit performance of 2023 on Thursday. Prieto has nine contests on the season with at least three knocks through his first 51 games. Overall, Prieto has feasted on Erie pitching in 2023, batting .452 (19-for-42) against the SeaWolves with four doubles, a home run, and six multi-hit performances in 10 games. In addition, Prieto sits third in the Eastern League with his .414 on-base percentage.

GETTING BACK TO WINNING WAYS

Friday night's 7-5 victory over Erie clinched the first four-game winning streak of the season for Bowie. The Baysox were the last team in the Eastern League to win three-straight games this season when they did so from 5/21-24, with a victory over Altoona and two wins over Akron. Bowie's last winning streak of at least four games came back on 7/30-8/7 of 2022, when the Baysox won eight-straight games (two against Altoona, six against Harrisburg). That marks a span of 90 games across both seasons between the last two winning streaks of at least four games for the Baysox.

CAREER NOTES

- Pitched to a 0.96 ERA in the month of June, allowing just three runs across 28 innings, while striking out 32 compared to just 10 walks. Also held opponents to .188 average in the month of June.
- Went four or more scoreless innings seven times on the season.
- Started two postseason contests for the IronBirds, allowing a single run over nine innings, including going four scoreless frames in the South Atlantic League Championship Series.
- Pitched two seasons at UC Irvine, where he posted a 4.03 career ERA in 19 appearances (18 starts) across 96 innings.
- Transferred to UC Irvine in 2020 after spending two seasons at Ohlone College, pitching 26 games (22 starts) with an ERA of 2.19, striking out 133 batters and walking just 33 in 119 innings.
- Pitched sparingly at California High School in San Ramon and entered college with a mid-80s fastball before truly developing his game at Ohlone.
- Oldest of six siblings.

NOTES BY START

- 4/8 Double-A debut. Pitched in tandem to Cade Povich's start. Third pitch thrown went for a double, and an error that should have ended the inning allowed the runner to score. Across a 1-2-3 inning in the next frame, was struck by a line drive on the forearm before assisting on the out at first. Left the game.
- 4/29 Second game of a doubleheader, only baserunner allowed was a double with two outs in the first. 22 pitches in the first, just 12 in the second.
- 5/6 Walked two batters in the first, but a caught stealing kept inning scoreless. Allowed a solo home run to lead off the second.
- 5/12 Relieved Garrett Stallings with Bowie up 2-0. Allowed double to first batter, and two-run home run to fourth. Walked first two batters in next inning and allowed go-ahead single.
- 5/18 Thanks to a double play, faced the minimum in the first two innings, and struck out the side in the second. Allowed the first four batters to reach in the third inning, allowing five total hits and two walks in the frame before being pulled.
- 5/24 Pitched in relief of Garrett Stallings. Walked the first batter he saw, then retired next six to open a scoreless outing.

Forrest Herrmann joins the Bowie Baysox coaching staff in his second season with the Orioles organization. He served as the pitching coach of the Aberdeen IronBirds during the 2022 season, helping Aberdeen clinch a first-half division title and make it all the way to game three of the South Atlantic League Championship Series. Herrmann guided one of the best staffs in the SAL last season, which led the league in strikeouts.
