**GAME 104:** Boasting a hot start, at one point winning 9 of its last 10 games, the FredNats have been cooled off by the Lynchburg Hillcats dropping their last three games. Heading into the Sunday series finale, the FredNats can only look to salvage a series split after taking the first two games of the series. After back-to-back games with the FredNats starter making their Single-A debut, it's back to the veteran on the bump with Riley Cornelio getting the starting nod.

**ABOUT LAST NIGHT:** For the second straight night the FredNats and Hillcats engaged in a back-and-forth battle. The Nats went up early 3-0 in the second, but the Hillcats would strike back against reliever Franklin Marquez as the first seven Lynchburg batters reached as the 'Cats put up a crooked number with a four-spot in the fifth. The Nats chipped away with a run in the sixth and seventh to tie the game at sixth, but in the eighth Yohandy Morales committed an error to allow a base runner aboard before Morales' former college teammate C.J. Kayfus launched his first professional home run to give the Hillcats the lead and the win with Tomas Reyes coming out of the Lynchburg bullpen to slam the door in the ninth, and earn his eighth save of the season.

**INSTANT IMPACT:** The 2023 draft class has had an incredible impact on the FredNats since being called up from the Complex League last Tuesday. In total, the class has driven in 37 runs in nine games since arriving, and four guys are hitting over .400 since arriving. Reigning Carolina League Player of the Week Andrew Pinckney (4th round, Alabama) is leading the way, and Dylan Crews (1st round, LSU), Marcus Brown (5th round, Oklahoma State), and Yohandy Morales (2nd round, Miami) have all had great starts with Fredericksburg.

**HOT BATS:** Two FredNats that have been with the team since the beginning of the year have had a big impact recently for Fredericksburg. Roismar Quintana had over a .900 OPS in July, and in his last 10 games, he's slashing .344/.512/.469 for an OPS of .951. Also, Max Romero Jr. has been on a tear since returning from the injured list in late June. He hit a walk-off home run on Sunday against Salem, and in his last 10, his slash line is .364/.523/.485 for an OPS of 1.085.

**CLOSE IT OUT:** When the FredNat offense has given the team a late lead in games this year, the bullpen has done well to close the games out. Fredericksburg is 40-5 this year when leading after seven innings, and 36-4 when leading after eight innings. Seven different pitchers have recorded a save this year for the bullpen.

**THE CALVARY HAS ARRIVED:** In addition to second overall pick Dylan Crews debuting last weekend, a good chunk of the Nationals' 2023 draft class has already arrived in Fredericksburg. 2nd round pick Yohandy Morales (INF) out of Miami (FL) highlights the group that includes 4th round pick Andrew Pinckney (OF) from Alabama, 5th round pick Marcus Brown (INF) from Oklahoma State, 6th round pick Gavin Dugas (UTL) from LSU, 8th round pick Jared Simpson (LHP) from Iowa, 14th round pick Elijah Nunez (OF) from TCU, and 16th round pick Austin Amaral (RHP) from Stetson. Additionally, prior to the start of this series, 9th round draft pick Thomas Schultz (Vanderbilt) and 12th round draft pick Travis Sthele (Texas) joined the FredNats in Lynchburg.

**THE SKIP IS BACK:** The FredNats' leader from 2022 returns to the Managerial role for 2023. Jake Lowery is back for another year in the 'Burg after winning the Washington organizational Manager of the Year award last year after leading the FredNats to a 75-55 record. Lowery, 33, was selected by Cleveland in the fourth round of the 2011 Draft out of James Madison University, where he was given the Johnny Bench Award as the nation's top collegiate catcher. The Midlothian, Virginia native played in the Nationals organization from 2016 to 2019, including parts of two seasons with the Potomac Nationals. Lowery reached the Triple-A level in 2018 and transitioned to a managerial role in 2021 after nine seasons in the minor leagues. Lowery is the 28th manager in franchise history dating back to 1978.

**THE STAFF:** Joining Lowery on the staff is returning hitting coach Delwyn Young, pitching coach Justin Lord, returning developmental coach Carmelo Jaime, athletic trainer Jacob Meyer, strength and conditioning coach Nathan Sier, and Performance Analyst Josh Freligh. Young, 41, played parts of five major league seasons with the Dodgers (2006-08) and Pirates (2009-10), and participated in spring training with the Nationals in 2013. Under his guidance, The FredNats' offense scored the most runs in the Carolina League in 2022. He previously served as a hitting coach with Kingsport and Brooklyn in the Mets system, and spent the 2021 season managing the State College Spikes of the MLB Draft League.

Lord, 43, begins his fourth year in the Washington organization after serving as the Pitching Coach for the Double-A Harrisburg Senators last season. Lord was scheduled to be the FredNats' Pitching Coach in the team's inaugural season in Fredericksburg in 2020, but that season was ultimately canceled due to Covid. Jaime, 37, was Detroit's 24th round selection in the 2008 Draft out of Miami Dade College. The Santo Domingo, Dominican Republic native reached Double-A in his three-year minor league career, and he returns with Lowery and Young as holdovers from last year's FredNat coaching staff. Meyer begins his sixth season in the Washington organization and first in Fredericksburg after spending the first five years of his Nationals career at the Spring Training facility in West Palm Beach, Florida. Sier begins his first year in the Washington organization after previous stops with Macomb Community College in Metro Detroit (Mich.) and 2SP Sports. Freligh steps into the newly-created Performance Analyst role after previous stops with the L.A. Dodgers and Boston Red Sox.

**TONIGHT'S START:** Riley Cornelio made his professional debut for the Fredericksburg Nationals in a start at Fayetteville this season, after being selected in the 7th round of the 2022 MLB Draft. The 22 year-old righty more than answered the bell, firing five innings with just one earned run, while picking up seven punchouts to just a pair of walks. However, he was saddled with the loss in a 3-2 defeat against the Woodpeckers.

A stalwart for the TCU Horned Frogs, Cornelio led the team in '22 with 15 starts, and also finished first with 77 strikeouts in 75.0 innings of work.

The right-hander excelled in Big 12 action, posting a 3.12 ERA with 40 strikeouts in just seven starts. His work earned him 2nd Team All Big-12 honors.

**HIGH HONORS:** Cornelio was a highly touted arm coming out of Pine Creek HS in Monument, Colorado. Baseball America tabbed him as the top overall draft prospect in the state for 2019, as he earned both the Perfect Game and Gatorade Colorado Player of the Year award in his senior campaign

**LAST TIME OUT:** Cornelio put together five strong innings against the Salem Red Sox last week. It was his second start against the Sox in the series, and he gave up just three base hits and one earned run while striking out five.
