The Lugnuts are 9-10 vs. the Loons in their 18-game season series after splitting the first four games of this series.

Yesterday: Lugnuts 8, Loons 4. Lansing relief trio Jack Owen, Will Johnston and Micah Dallas combined for five scoreless innings, limiting the Loons to two hits and one walk while striking out seven, and the Nuts used a four-run fourth inning and a three-run ninth to double up the Loons on Friday night in front of 4,174.

On Deck: The Nuts wrap things up with the Loons tomorrow, enjoy a day off on Monday, and then open a six-game homestand from August 13-18 against the archrival West Michigan Whitecaps.

Gig 'Em: The Loons are glad to be done with lefty Will Johnston, who in three appearances has totaled 20 strikeouts over 10 scoreless innings against Great Lakes while allowing only two hits.

Lightning Lasko: Center fielder Ryan Lasko stole two more bases and scored two more runs yesterday, reaching base three times. Lasko has five steals in the last three games and has scored 11 runs in the Lugnuts' last 10 games.

The Simpson Show: First baseman Will Simpson tops the Midwest League in runs batted in (67) and extra-base hits (40) while trailing the total-base lead by four (168-164), the runs lead by four (65-61) and the walks lead by eight (73-65).

Welcome to the Pros: The A's first round (Nick Kurtz), second round (Tommy White), third round (Joshua Kuroda-Grauer) and fourth round (Rodney Green, Jr.) were added to the Single-A Stockton roster yesterday and may well make their pro debuts tonight.

Red Hot Vladdy: A 17-year-old when he first donned the Lugnuts uniform in 2016, Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. extended his MLBleading hitting streak to 21 games yesterday, going 2-for-4 in a 3-1 Blue Jays victory over the A's.

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense is 1st in the MWL in batting average (.249), at-bats (3,522), base hits (876), total bases (1330), doubles (174) and triples (35); 2nd in runs (525) and OPS (.718); and 3rd in slugging percentage (.378) and on-base percentage (.340).

Prospecting: The Nuts have six MLB Pipeline Top 30 A's prospects: pitcher Luis Morales (No. 2), outfielder Ryan Lasko (No. 16), pitcher Kade Morris (No. 20), infielder Will Simpson (No. 26), pitcher Will Johnston (No. 27) and outfielder Jared Dickey (No. 28).

The Future is Here: Lugnuts right-hander Luis Morales. today's starting pitcher and the A's No. 1 pitching prospect, tossed 2/3 of an inning in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, striking out Jeral Pérez and Deyvison De Los Santos alongside an HBP and BB. Morales was the A's sole representative in the prospect showcase, and the fifth all-time current Lugnut to play in the game.

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2018: With an 11-4 victory over the Dayton Dragons at Cooley Law School Stadium, the Lugnuts completed an 11-0 home sweep of the Dragons in 2018, improving to 15-3 in the season series. The Lugnuts (70-47) also became the fifth MiLB to reach the 70-win threshold.

2019: A Miles Gordon one-out triple in the sixth inning supplied Dayton's only base runner in a near perfect game for the Lugnuts, settling for a 6-0 win at Dayton. Troy Watson fired seven innings, striking out four, before Will McAffer struck out the side in the eighth and Cre Finfrock struck out two in the ninth. Griffin Conine led the offense with a two-run tiebreaking single in the sixth and a solo home run in the eighth.

Off to Arlington: Luis represented the Oakland Athletics in the 2024 All-Star Futures Game on July 13 at Globe Life Field in Arlington, Texas, becoming the fifth active Lugnut in team history to participate in the Futures Game, joining Denzel Clarke (2022), Bo Bichette and Vladimir Guerrero Jr. (2017) and Ángel Perdomo (2016). He was one of seven current Midwest Leaguers to be part of the Futures Game roster, along with Ethan Salas (Fort Wayne), Ben Kudrna (Quad Cities), Noble Meyer and Thomas White (Beloit), Thayron Liranzo (Great Lakes) and Cam Collier (Dayton). He faced four batters, striking out two, hitting Dylan Crews with a pitch and walking Liranzo.

Prospecting: Morales is ranked the Oakland Athletics' no. 2 prospect behind SS Jacob Wilson and top pitching prospect by MLB Pipeline, which grades his fastball at 60, his curve at 50, his slider at 55, his change at 50 and his control at 50. They write, "Morales was billed as the consensus top pitching prospect of the 2023 international signing period when he signed for \$3 million with the A's in January that year. After setting a U-18 record for strikeouts with 161 across 82 2/3 innings between 2019-20 in Cuba's Serie Nacional, he defected in 2021 to Mexico, where he trained with Maels Rodríguez, a former Cuban National team pitcher and Olympian who regularly threw 100 mph fastballs. Initially expected to pitch solely in the Dominican Summer League for his introduction to pro ball, his excellent performance earned him stops at four different levels. He finished the year at High-A Lansing, combining for a 2.86 ERA with 53 strikeouts in 44 innings."

Path to Lansing: Luis opened the 2023 season in the Dominican Summer League, making his professional debut on June 6 with 1 2/3 hitless innings vs. DSL Astros Blue, striking out three... struck out six batters in three one-hit innings on June 20... struck out five batters in four one-hit innings on June 27... made four appearances in DSL before he was promoted to the Arizona Complex League Athletics on July 2, debuting on July 4 with three innings, allowing one run with three strikeouts vs. D-Backs Black... made three starts in AzCL before he was promoted to the Stockton Ports on July 24, debuting on July 28 with three one-hit innings and five strikeouts vs. Lake Elsinore... in last of five California League starts, tossed four two-hit scoreless innings at Fresno on August 25... promoted to Lansing on August 30, his fourth different stop along the ladder.
