TODAY'S GAME: The Quakes continue their longest road trip of the year, as they take on the Stockton Ports (ATH) in game four of a six-game set and game four of a 12-game, 13-day road trip. The Quakes will return to LoanMart Field on Tuesday, June 3rd to face the San Jose Giants. Tickets are available at rcquakes.com.

VS THE PORTS: Today's game is the 16th of 18 games (all in the first half) against the Ports and the tenth of 12 at Banner Island Ballpark. The Quakes have dropped six of nine in Stockton in 2025, but after winning five of six at home, are now 8-7 against Stockton in 2025. In 2024, Rancho went 8-2 against the Ports, 5-1 in Stockton.

LAST GAME: The Quakes overcame 12 walks issued and ended a two-game losing streak, defeating the Stockton Ports on Thursday night by a final of 9-4 at Banner Island Ballpark. Elijah Hainline (four hits) and Victor Rodrigues (three hits) combined for seven of Rancho's 15 hits, while Raynerd Ortega (4) and Eduardo Quintero (8) both went deep. Rancho reliever Jhonny Jimenez (1-0) earned his first Cal League win with 2.1 innings of scoreless relief, while Myles Caba earned his first professional save by getting the final four outs. Stockton's Wei-En Lin (1-2) took the loss.

ROSTER MOVES: The Quakes have made several roster moves over the last few days. Three days after sending RHP Jhonny Jimenez back to the ACL, they transferred him back to Rancho on Thursday. Gio Cueto was placed on the Injured List on Tuesday. INF Raynerd Ortega was added to the roster from the ACL and Marco Corcho was activated from the Injured List on Wednesday.

POW TREND KEEPS GOING: The Quakes have snapped up five of the 12 weekly awards that have been handed out this year, with Samuel Munoz keeping the trend going, as he was named the league's Player of the Week on Monday. Munoz hit .417 (10-for-24) against Inland Empire with two homers, five RBIs, 11 runs scored and five walks. Other winners this year include P Sean Paul Linan, P Sterling Patick, OF Mike Sirota and OF Eduard Quintero.

UNFAMILIAR TERRITORY: The Quakes ended their two-game skid last night, avoiding tying their longest losing streak of the year. Consecutive losses to open this Stockton series was the first time Rancho had lost two straight since they dropped back-to-back games against San Jose on April 17-18. The Quakes have only had three losing streaks this season, two two-game streaks and their longest of the year, a three-game losing streak here in Stockton back in April. Rancho's best record in a single half was in the second half of the 2018 season, when they went 52-18 and finished a whopping 15 games ahead of second-place Lancaster. That 2018 season also marked their last Cal League Championship, their third in franchise history.

JAKOB WRIGHT: 21-year-old left-hander Jakob Wright makes his second start against Stockton, just the third appearance of his pro career. Wright has not been on the Injured List over the last three weeks, but has not pitched since May 4th against the Ports (one hit allowed over two scoreless innings in a no-decision), which was his first appearance since coming off a one-month trip to the Injured List with a blister on his left hand. Wright made his pro debut on April 6th against the Lake Elsinore Storm and tossed 3.2 innings of scoreless baseball, allowing just two hits and two walks, while striking out five in a no-decision. Wright was drafted by the Dodgers in the fourth round of the 2024 draft out of Cal Poly Pomona.

JEFFERSON JEAN: 20-year-old right-hander Jefferson Jean makes his ninth appearance and sixth start of the year, his second start and third appearance against the Quakes. In two games against Rancho, he's 0-0, allowing just one run on six hits over seven innings. In his last outing overall, he allowed one earned run on two hits over 4.2 innings of relief in a no-decision against San Jose on May 17th. Jean signed with the A's in June of 2022 out of the Dominican Republic.
