Lehigh Valley IronPigs RHP Michael Mercado (0-0, 0.00) vs. Worcester Red Sox RHP Nick Pivetta (NR)

A Dry Thursday – For the first time at home this season, the Worcester Red Sox get to play a Thursday game at Polar Park when they host the Lehigh Valley IronPigs (AAA-Philadelphia) in game three of their 6-game series at 6:05 pm (live on NESN+ along with NASH 98.9 FM and the rest of the WooSox Radio Network). The first two scheduled Thursday home games of the season were both postponed at Polar Park...four weeks ago on April 4 vs. Buffalo due to snow and two weeks ago on April 18 vs. Durham due to rain. We know anything can happen weather-wise in the wonderful world of Worcester, but tonight's weather calls for a pleasant evening with temperatures in the 70's!

Pivetta Makes a Pit Stop at Polar Park - Boston Red Sox RHP **Nick Pivetta** will make an injury rehab start for the WooSox this evening at Polar Park. Pivetta, 31, has been on Boston's injured list since April 9 (retro to April 6) with a right elbow flexor strain.

He made two starts for the Red Sox this season and both were brilliant - each ending with a 1-0 final score. On March 29 at Seattle he was a tough-luck, 1-0 loser despite going 6-innings and allowing just 3 hits and 1 run (a HR to J.P. Crawford in the 6th-inning) with no walks and 10 strikeouts. And on April 3 at Oakland he was a 1-0 winner tossing 5 shutout innings giving up 5 hits, 1 walk, with 3 strikeouts. So overall in his two starts this season, Nick is 1-1 with a 0.82 ERA – 11 IP, 8 H, 1 R, 1 ER, 1 BB, 13 SO.

Pivetta is in his 8th Major League season and his 5th with the Red Sox since being acquired from the Phillies along with RHP Connor Seabold for relievers Brandon Workman and Heath Hembree on August 21, 2020. He spent most of 2017-2019 and part of 2020 with Philadelphia and then part of 2020 and all of 2021-2023, and now 2024 with Boston. Overall in 198 big league games (154 starts) he is 51-60 with a 4.81 ERA along with 980 SO in 894.2 IP. In 106 games (83 starts) for the Red Sox he is 32-30 with a 4.26 ERA.

A Victoria, British Columbia native, Pivetta was originally a 4th round selection of the Washington Nationals in the 2013 June Draft. He was traded to Philadelphia for Jonathan Papelbon in July of 2015. He last pitched in the minor leagues with Lehigh Valley during the 2019 season going 5-1 with a 3.07 ERA in 9 games (6 starts). Between 2021-2023, Nick ranked 8th in the American League in innings pitched with 477.1 (Gerrit Cole led with 591 IP) while Pivetta was 4th in MLB in Strikeout Pct. in 2023 (31.2%).

This Series – Worcester has won each of the first two games of this 6-game set vs. the IronPigs. The WooSox made it two in a row over the Pigs with a 5-2 victory yesterday afternoon following a 12-5 rout on Tuesday night. The clubs play tonight & tomorrow at 6:05 pm, Saturday at 4:05 pm, and Sunday in the series finale at 1:05 pm. After that, the teams won't meet again until after the All-Star break for a 3-game series in Allentown, PA from July 19-21. The IronPigs will return to Polar Park for a 6-game set from August 13-18. And for the second straight year, the WooSox and IronPigs will conclude the regular season against each other for 6-games in Allentown from September 17-22.

Leading Lehigh – The WooSox – who lead the season-series over Lehigh Valley by a 4 games to 1 margin thus far this year - have beaten the IronPigs 32 times in their last 50 meetings dating back to September 11, 2021. Worcester and Lehigh Valley began the 2024 season with a 3-game weekend series in Allentown, PA back from March 29-31 with the WooSox taking the series, 2 games to 1. The WooSox won the rubber game on March 31, 6-2 after evening the series at a victory apiece on March 30 with a 5-2 win thanks to a 3-run top of the 9th-inning. It was an impressive bounce back for the Sox after suffering a tough 7-4 loss on Opening Night on March 29 when the IronPigs rallied for 7 runs in the bottom of the 9th-inning to erase a 4-0 WooSox lead. The WooSox are 2-0 here vs. the Pigs at Polar Park this week with their 12-5 and 5-2 victories the past two days.

Welcome to Polar Park John Trautwein – Former Boston Red Sox and Pawtucket Red Sox relief pitcher **John Trautwein** is the WooSox “Throwback Thursday” guest at Polar Park tonight. Trautwein, now 61, pitched in 9 games for Boston in 1988 and was a workhorse out of the Pawtucket bullpen in 1989 & 1990 going 12-15 with 9 saves in 104 combined games. A Chemistry major at Northwestern University where he helped lead the Wildcats baseball team to one of their best seasons ever in 1984, John was originally signed by the Montreal Expos and spent 1985-87 in the Expos Minor League system. He was a Rule 5 draft pick of the Red Sox in 1987.

John and his wife Susie were the recipients of the Presidential Point Of Light Award, for their work in founding the non-profit Will To Live Foundation, Inc., a 501(c)(3) public charity that is dedicated to spreading the awareness and education of teen suicide in America and around the world. John and Susie started the foundation after the suicide death of their oldest child, and son, Will, who passed away in October of 2010.

John is an accomplished public speaker and gives over 100 speeches a year on teen suicide awareness to schools, teams and organizations around the country. He wrote a book about his son Will's suicide, and the creation of the Will To Live Foundation, *My Living Will: A Fathers story of Loss & Hope* which was published in December 2014.

Trautwein lives in the Atlanta, Georgia, area with his wife and their three grown children. Son Michael is currently a catcher for the Louisville Bats (AAA-Cincinnati) and is regarded as one of the best defensive backstops in Triple-A.

John is presently the chief customer officer of Source Support Services, Inc., where he formerly was president and COO for 10 years. Source Support is a global IT services organization headquartered in Lawrenceville, Georgia. John was formerly director of sales and marketing for Zellweger Analytics for 13 years, living in Munich, Germany; Poole, England; and Johns Creek, (Atlanta), Georgia.

Three in a Row – The WooSox have won three straight games...yesterday's 5-2 triumph and Tuesday night's 12-5 rout of the IronPigs coupled with their 8-5 victory on Sunday in their series finale at Toledo. A victory tonight would match their longest winning streak of the season (4 in a row from G2 on April 14 – April 19).

Home Getting Sweeter - Worcester has also won three straight home games and 6 of their last 8 home games dating back to their last series at Polar Park vs. Durham that began on April 16. As a result, the WooSox are 7-6 at home to go over the .500 mark at Polar Park for the first time this season. Worcester went 43-33 at home last year. A victory today would give the Sox a 4-game home winning streak which would be their longest since last June 8-21 when they won 6 in a row at Polar Park over the course of two different homestands.

Pigs Feat – The WooSox captured the 2023 season-series over Lehigh Valley by a 12 games to 10 count (with the final two scheduled games canceled due to rain last September 23 & 24 in Allentown). The Sox were 8-4 vs. the IronPigs at Polar Park last season while going 4-6 at Coca-Cola Park in PA. All-time, Worcester is 48-31 vs. Lehigh Valley including a 23-9 mark at Polar Park and a 25-22 record in Allentown. The WooSox won both the 2022 season-series over Lehigh Valley (10 games to 7) and the inaugural 2021 season-series (by a 22-13 count) - the 22 wins against Lehigh Valley during the 2021 season their most against any rival ever.

Comeback Kids – Until the Sox scored 4 runs in the 4th-inning to take a 4-0 lead and cruise to a 5-2 victory yesterday afternoon, the previous seven Worcester wins since April 16 had been of the come-from-behind variety. Worcester have 8 CFB victories this season including two wins in their last at-bat of the game (the 9th-inning comeback on April 25 at Toledo, 7-5 and a 5-2 win on March 30 at Lehigh Valley when the Sox broke a tie with 3 runs in the top of the 9th-inning).

One Has Been a Lonely Number – Worcester is 0-6 in 1-run games this season. Last year the WooSox went 21-24 in 1-run games. The Sox are 2-3 in 2-run games this season. Last year they were 13-10 in that category.

Run Differential is Different – The WooSox are +13 in run differential overall this season (149 runs scored to 136 runs allowed). 1st-place Scranton/Wilkes-Barre is a +41 (the best in the entire league) and 2nd-place Buffalo is +17. After that the WooSox and Norfolk are +13 tied for third best in the IL East division.

Streaks – Worcester is 5-5 in their last 10 games. They had a season-high 4-game winning streak (from Game 2 on April 14 – April 19) that came immediately on the heels of a 4-game losing skid (April 10 – Game 1 on April 14).

Series Math – Worcester is 2-3-0 in their first five series of 2024. They finished 13-8-5 in their 26 series last season...13 winners, 8 losers, and 5 splits. The WooSox went 8-3-2 in their 13 series at Polar Park and 5-5-3 in 13 sets on the road.

Hit Me With Your Best Shot – Sox batters are 1st in the 20-team International League by being hit by pitch 27 times this season.

Ground Beef – The WooSox have hit into only 9 double plays this season – the fewest GIDP in the league.

Rankings – Worcester is 15th in the IL in team batting with a .241 average while Lehigh Valley is 11th at .250. On the pitching side, the Sox are 15th in team ERA (5.20) while the IronPigs are 16th with a 5.54 ERA.

April Recap - The WooSox finished 10-14 in April (after going 2-1 in March) while batting .244 (180-for-737) with 22 HR. Sox pitchers were 10-14 with a 5.55 ERA (119 ER in 193 IP) with 25 HRA. Worcester out-scored their opponents, 129-123 in April. The month also featured five postponements, four doubleheaders, 29 player transactions, 10 players promoted to Boston (not including any rehabbers), and a total of 41 players used already (19 position players & 22 pitchers). Worcester went 11-14 last April and by the end of April, 2023 they were tied for 5th-place and 7 games back. They were in 8th-place and 6 GB at the end of this April.

A Winning Tradition – The 2023 Worcester Red Sox went 79-68 to post a winning season for the third time in as many years of existence. Worcester finished with a 43-33 home record compared to 36-35 on the road last year. The 2021 WooSox went 74-54 during their abbreviated inaugural season while the 2022 WooSox finished 75-73.

Finish Line – In the overall International League Standings for the 2023 season, out of 20 IL teams, Worcester finished in 7th-place with a 79-68 overall record. In the 1st half standings last year, the WooSox went 39-36 while they improved to 40-32 in the 2nd half. This season, for the second time ever, the IL will again invoke a split season with the first half starting tonight and ending on June 23 while the second half will run from June 25 – September 22.

Month to Month – Worcester went 12-14 last March/April, 13-14 in May, then had three straight winning months going 16-9 in June, 13-10 in July, and 16-11 in August, before finishing 9-10 in September.

Seven Days a Week – The WooSox were 0-1 on Monday last season, went 9-12 on Tuesdays, 11-11 on Wednesdays, 12-13 on Thursdays, 14-12 on Fridays, 20-6 on Saturdays, and 14-13 on Sundays in 2023.

We Interrupt This Program – Worcester had a total of 14 games either postponed (11) or canceled (3) last year due to weather. They have had five postponements thus far this season (three at home and two on the road).

You Need a Scorecard – The 2023 WooSox built on a pair of all-time Red Sox Triple-A records as they made **271 player transactions** during the 2023 campaign and set a new all-time Red Sox Triple-A record for players appearing in a single season. The WooSox used **79 different players** in 2023 (33 position players and 46 pitchers) to better the mark of 75 different players in 2022 (31 position players and 44 pitchers). Ironically, the 2021 WooSox set the previous mark of 72 different players (31 position players and 41 pitchers).

Two Dozen to Go - 24 different WooSox players were promoted to Boston during the 2023 season (not counting Red Sox rehabbing players) including Jarren Duran, Chris Murphy, Brandon Walter, David Hamilton, Wilyer Abreu, Ceddanne Rafaela, and many others.

PORTLAND SEA DOGS UPDATE – The Portland Sea Dogs (13-8) rolled over Reading, 8-3 last night. Catcher Kyle Teel smacked a 2-run single in the 3rd inning and drilled a 2-run HR (#3) in the 8th inning. SS Marcelo Mayer added a 2-run double and had an RBI groundout. Blaze Jordan extended his hitting streak to 11 games with a pair of hits. Alex Hoppe (1-1) was the winner with 2.1 scoreless innings of relief.

WOOSOX PLAYER MOVES – The Boston Red Sox today added left-handed pitcher **Bailey Horn** to their roster to take the place of RHP **Vladimir Gutierrez** who was designated for assignment by the Red Sox yesterday. The WooSox today added INF **Enmanuel Valdez** who was optioned from Boston following the Red Sox victory last night with the Red Sox adding INF Zack Short to their active roster today. OF **Tyler McDonough** has been transferred from Worcester to Double-A Portland.

Horn, 26, was acquired from the Chicago White Sox on Tuesday, in exchange for cash considerations, and optioned to Worcester. He was designated for assignment by the White Sox on April 26, after they acquired him in a trade with the Chicago Cubs on February 27. The southpaw owns a 12-10 record with a 4.60 ERA with 11.54 strikeouts per 9.0 innings pitched (236 SO in 184 IP) in 108 career minor league games (14 starts). Horn has made 9 relief appearances with the Charlotte Knights (AAA-White Sox) this season going 1-1 with an 11.32 ERA – 10.1 IP, 14 H, 13 R, 13 ER, 10 BB, 15 SO. He had a fine season with the Triple-A Iowa Cubs last year posting a 7-2 record with a 4.58 ERA in 39 relief appearances along with 2 saves – 53 IP, 52 H, 29 R, 27 ER, 29 BB, 59 SO. A Texas native, he was originally selected by the White Sox in the fifth round of the 2020 First-Year Player Draft out of Auburn University.

Valdez, 25, has played in 28 games for the Red Sox this season, making 26 starts at second base and batting .156 (14-for-90) with 11 RBI. Originally signed by the Houston Astros as an international free agent in July 2015, the Dominican Republic native has batted .224 (51-for-229) with eight home runs and 30 RBI in 77 games with the Red Sox (2023-24). Valdez had a productive 2023 season with both Worcester (.254/10/41 in 57 games) and Boston (.266/6/19 in 49 games). He made his Major League debut with the Red Sox on April 19, 2023 and had four different stints with Boston during the course of the year. Enmanuel (en-mahn-WELL) was acquired from the Houston Astros in August 2022 along with OF Wilyer Abreu in exchange for Christian Vazquez. The left-handed hitter batted .296 with 92 runs scored, 35 2B, 2 3B, 28 HR, and 107 RBI in 126 games during the 2022 season between Double-A Corpus Christi (44 games) and Triple-A Round Rock & Worcester (82 games). His 107 RBI tied for the 6th most in all of Minor League Baseball.

The WooSox have already sent 10 players to Boston in the five weeks since the season started...INF David Hamilton, INF Romy Gonzalez, LHP Brennan Bernardino, INF/OF Bobby Dalbec, RHP Cooper Criswell, LHP Joe Jacques, LHP Cam Booser, C Tyler Heineman, RHP Zack Kelly, and RHP Naoyuki Uwasawa. Those ten do not include OF Rob Refsnyder who was an injury rehab recall from Worcester to Boston. Gonzalez & Heineman are currently on Boston's injured list and Jacques was claimed off waivers by Arizona, but the rest of those players are still with the Red Sox.
