LAST NIGHT: The Amarillo Sod Poodles (27-27) defeated the Tulsa Drillers (35-20), 10-7, on Friday night at HODGETOWN. Jesus Valdez brought in the first run of the night on a cue shot that popped over the first base bag, allowing Ben McLaughlin to score with ease.

WHAT CONTI DO?: Extending his hit streak to eight games last night was Gavin Conticello...the outfielder is batting .357 (10x28) with an .990 OPS over the stretch (5/26-c)...over that same span, eight of his 10 hits have been collected in innings 1-5.

LONG LIVE THE LONG BALL: Entering play last night, the Sod Poodles were 4-22 all-time in games where they allow five or more home runs... Tulsa launched five in Amarillo's 10-7 victory Friday.

HOUSE OF PENA: Manuel Pena remains the only player in Minor League Baseball with 20+ home runs this season...he also ranks 2nd across MiLB in total bases (142) and 5th in RBI (55)...his 22 HR this season is currently tied for 4th-most in a single season in Soddie history, matching Ivan Melendez (2024) and A.J. Vukovich (2023)...

START ME UP: Since May 23, Amarillo starting pitching is posting a 2.38 ERA (14 ER/53.0 IP), ranking first in that category in all of Double-A baseball...Hartford (Colorado Rockies) ranks 2nd over that same span with a 2.77 ERA...the rotation is also 3rd in WHIP (1.08) and tied for 5th in strikeouts (60) in the 12-game stretch...tonight's starting pitcher for Amarillo, Ashton Izzi, is one of five starters across Double-A that has yet to allow a run over multiple starts since 5/23.

KEEPING UP WITH THE JONESES: Since May 21, Drew Jones is currently riding an 11-game on-base streak, the longest active stretch on the Sod Poodles...in those games, Jones has posted a .400 OBP...for the year, he is posting a 1.153 OPS when he is ahead in the account compared to a .308 OPS when he is behind.

RISP AND REWARD: With runners in scoring position, the Soddie's are batting .360 with a 1.006 OPS since May 22, averaging 0.43 RBI per PA over that span...from Opening Day through May 21, the Soddie's were posting a .240 AVG and .741 OPS, averaging 0.30 RBI per PA.

JESUS TAKE THE WHEEL: Checking in with his first homer of the year last night was Jesus Valdez...it is the first three-run blast in Valdez's career in the seventh inning or later in a game that his team went on to win.

DOWN IN THE DESERT: Former Soddie LuJames Groover had his contract selected by Arizona yesterday...the corner infielder was the Texas League Batting Champion in 2025 with a .309 clip and total hits, marking the second-most in a season in Soddie's history.

#### SUMMARY

- ▶ Ranked as the No. 18 Diamondbacks prospect by MLB Pipeline ahead of the start of the 2026 season.
- ▶ Traded along with LHP Brandyn Garcia from the Seattle Mariners to the Arizona Diamondbacks on July 24, 2025 in return for Josh Naylor.
- ▶ Selected by the Seattle Mariners in the fourth round (126th ovr.) of the 2022 MLB Draft out of Oswego East High School...agreed to a \$1.10 million signing bonus.
- ▶ Was committed to play college baseball at Wichita State.

#### LAST TIME OUT

- ▶ Continued his excellent week in Midland by tossing four no-hit innings and struck out five RockHounds, the most in his three starts at Midland this year...Izzi tossed 10 shutout innings between May 26-31, the largest workload by a Soddie in a single week this season.
- ▶ Izzi became the sixth Sod Poodles starting pitcher to throw 4.0+ no-hit innings in a game...the most recent player to join the club was Dylan Ray, who held the San Antonio Missions without a hit over 5.2 IP on 7/12/24.

#### A QUALITY FIRST IMPRESSION

- ▶ Made his first Double-A start on April 5...blanked a hot Springfield Cardinals offense over five innings, allowing just four hits on an efficient 49 pitches...it was the lowest pitch count of his career for any starts of 5.0 innings or more.

#### 2025 HIGHLIGHTS

- ▶ Started the season with the Everett AquaSox...made his first start on May 1, where he threw three scoreless innings against the Eugene Emeralds.
- ▶ Earned his first win of the campaign three starts later...he blanked the Hillsboro Hops over five full frames, allowing just three hits and striking out five.
- ▶ Finished the month of May with a 2.60 ERA (5 ER/17.1 IP).
- ▶ Matched the longest outing of his career on August 19...tossed 6.2 innings, allowing four runs (two earned).
- ▶ Set a career-high in strikeouts on September 2 by punching nine tickets and allowing just two baserunners over six full frames.
- ▶ Started 128 games, finishing with a 3-6 record and a 4.80 ERA.
- ▶ His control really took off down the stretch in the Northwest League...posted a 4.9 percent walk rate in his final eight starts.

#### BRINGING HOME HARDWARE

- ▶ Won the NWL Pitcher of the Week award for the week of September 7, 2025 after setting a career-high in strikeouts (9) five days prior.
- ▶ Took home the California League Pitcher of the Week award for the week of June 2, 2024...tossed 5.0 no-hit innings on June 2 and earned the win for Single-A Modesto in a 7-6 victory over the Stockton Ports.

#### BIG MEN ON CAMPUS

- ▶ Was teammates with Noah Schultz at Oswego East HS, who was also drafted in 2022 by the Chicago White Sox in the first round (26th ovr.)... Schultz made his big league debut with the South Siders on April 14.
