YESTERDAY: The Captains lost to Dayton, 5-4, in a game that featured three lead changes. Dayton took a 1-0 lead in the third when Garrett Wolforth tripled and scored on a sacrifice fly by Victor Ruiz. The Captains took a 2-1 lead in the sixth on a two-run single by Bryan Lavastida. The Dragons tied the score on an RBI single by Francisco Urbaez in the seventh and took the lead, 3-2, when Urbaez scored on a wild pitch. Lake County knotted the score at 3-3 in the top of the eighth when Dragons reliever John Ghyzel walked three men and Lavastida hit a sacrifice fly that plated Aaron Bracho. The Dragons grabbed the lead for good in the eighth on a two-run double by Jacob Hurtubise. The Captains scored one final time in the ninth on a leadoff homer by José Tena

DRAGON SLAYERS: José Tena, Aaron Bracho, Joe Naranjo, Will Brennan and Brayan Rocchio have done the most damage of any Captains against Dayton pitching this year. Tena is 10-for-27 (.370) with a homer, three doubles and a triple. Bracho is 6-for-18 (.333) with two homers and five walks. Naranjo has gone 7-for-20 (.350) with a home run and seven walks. Brennan has gone 8-for-23 (.348) with two homers, two doubles and 10 RBI. Rocchio has gone 7-for-25 (.280) with a homer and four doubles and four walks.

SUPER NOVA: Victor Nova has hit .304/.403/.607 (1.010 OPS) in the month of July. Over the first two months of the season, he hit .179/.295/.241 (.536 OPS) with one home run in 37 games. Nova, however, is currently in the midst of a home run drought. After hitting four homers in the first six games of July, Nova has not homered since July 10 at Fort

LEADERBOARD: Captains OF Will Brennan and INF José Tena are neck-and-neck on the High-A Central League leaderboards. Tena is sixth in average (.294) and tied for seventh in doubles (16). Brennan is eighth in batting average .290) and second in doubles (22).

TAKE YOUR BASE: George Valera ranks sixth in the High-A Central League (minimum 160 PA) with a 16.2 BB%.

CONTACT HITTERS: Will Brennan has the eighth-lowest SwStr% (8.3) and the 11th-lowest K% (16.0) in the High-A Central League (minimum 160 PA). Bryan Lavastida has the eighth-lowest K% (15.5%).

HOME COOKIN' TASTES BETTER: The Captains are 20-10 at home, compared to 19-25 on the road. Captains pitchers have experienced the biggest home/road disparity. Lake County has a 3.79 ERA at Classic Park and a 4.82 ERA on the

ALUMNI UPDATE: 2017 Captains RHP Justin Garza became the 102nd former Captain to reach the major leagues when he debuted for Cleveland on June 27. A record 10 former Captains have made their major league debuts this year – OF Ka'ai Tom (2016), RHP Luis Oviedo (2018-19), LHP Sam Hentges (2016), RHP Louis Head (2012-13), RHP Nick Sandlin (2018), INF Ivan Castillo (2014), Jean Carlos Mejia (2018), RHP Eli Morgan (2018), INF Ernie Clement (2018) and Garza. That breaks the record for the most former Captains to debut in a single year, besting the nine alumni that debuted in 2013 and 2016.

DEFENSIVE FLEXIBILITY: The Captains' have shuffled their defenders in 2021. Lake County has used four different first baseman, six different second baseman, six different third basemen and two different shortstops. Raynel Delgado, Brayan Rocchio and José Tena have each played three different infield positions. Victor Nova and Daniel Schneemann have played two different infield positions and left field.

YOUNGSTERS: The Captains have five of the 10 youngest players in the High-A Central League – 1B Joe Naranjo (20), INF Aaron Bracho (20), INF José Tena (20), INF Brayan Rocchio (20) and OF George Valera (20). Naranjo, Bracho and Tena are the three youngest players in the league. Naranjo, who turned 20 on May 11, is the youngest player in all of High-A. Bracho (born 4/21/00) is the second youngest in all of High-A. The Captains have eight players who are age 21 or

LAST TIME OUT: Draper made his first start with the Captains in 2021 after being transferred from Double-A Akron. Draper surrendered three runs, two earned, over four innings against Great Lakes last Thursday at Classic Park. Draper gave up two runs in the first when Great Lakes tallied four straight hits with one out. Captains right fielder **George Valera** threw out one runner at home in the first inning and nearly threw out two, but catcher **Bryan Lavastida** dropped the throw. The missed-catch error made the second run of the first inning unearned against Draper. Deacon Liput later hit a solo homer in the fourth for the third run against the lefty. Draper ultimately took a no-decision, as the Captains lost in 11 innings, 8-5.

2021: Assigned to Triple-A Columbus on May 23 and made four appearances out of the Clippers' bullpen, posting an 8.31 ERA. Transferred to Double-A Akron on June 11. Made three starts and four relief appearances for the RubberDucks, posting a 6.43 ERA. Transferred to Lake County on July 21.

COLLEGE OF IDAHO HISTORY: Draper was drafted in the same year as his College of Idaho teammate, Riley O'Brien, a right-handed pitcher who the Tampa Bay Rays selected in the eighth round in 2017. It was the first time two C of I Yotes were drafted in the same year since 1996, when the Montreal Expos selected Kurt Alderman in the 15th round and the St. Louis Cardinals picked Tim Onofrei in the 28th round.

COLLEGE ACCOLADES: Draper earned All-NAIA West honors in both of his seasons at the College of Idaho (2016 & 2017).

WEST COAST LEAGUE: Draper was named the WCL Pitcher of the Year in 2016 after posting an 8-0 record with a 0.72 ERA. He did not allow an earned run in July, tossing 35 shutout innings.

COLLEGE TRANSFER: Transferred to the College of Idaho after two seasons at the College of Southern Idaho. He was initially signed to play at the University of Central Florida.

COLLEGE TEAMMATE LINEAGE: Draper's college teammate, Tampa Bay Rays pitching prospect Riley O'Brien, is the grandson of former Pittsburgh Pirates infielder Johnny O'Brien. Johnny and his twin brother Eddie O'Brien played together on the Pirates in the 1950's and even formed the Bucs' double play combo (one of four pairs of brothers to play together up the middle in MLB history) in their rookie season of 1953 (Eddie at shortstop and Johnny at second). Johnny was mostly a second baseman during his six-year career, but also pitched 25 times, including 16 appearances (one start) in 1957. Eddie also pitched five times (one start) during his career with Pittsburgh, though he was primarily a shortstop and centerfielder. In addition, the pair played basketball at Seattle University where they upset the Harlem Globetrotters and were both drafted by the NBA's Milwaukee Hawks in 1953, though neither signed. In basketball, Johnny earned the distinction as the first player in NCAA history to score 1,000 points in a season and was the shortest player to be named an All-American (5'9") until 2016.
