RANCHO CUCAMONGA QUAKES (11-9, 41-43) **Stockton Ports (7-13, 33-51)**

TONIGHT'S GAME: The Quakes finish a nine-game, 11-day road trip tonight, with the final game of a six-game set at Banner Island Ballpark, as they take on the Stockton Ports (OAK).

VS THE PORTS: This is the last of what will now be 10 meetings between the two clubs in 2024 and the sixth of six at Banner Island Ballpark. The Quakes and Ports lost two games due to rain back in Rancho's opening home stand of 2024, with the Quakes winning three of four prior to the final two games getting rained out. With last night's win, Rancho is 7-2 against Stockton in 2024. In 2023, the Quakes went 7-5 against the Ports, 3-3 here in Stockton.

LAST GAME: Sean McLain had three hits and three RBIs, as the Quakes rallied to take a 7-6 win over the Stockton Ports on Saturday night at Banner Island Ballpark. Trailing 3-1 in the fifth, Rancho scored five times to take the lead for good. McLain had a game-tying two-run single, while Alexander Albertus, Carlos Rojas and Jose Meza all had RBIs in the five-run outburst against Stockton reliever Derek Cotto (2-1). Rancho starter Roque Gutierrez (2-2) fired a season-best six innings, allowing four runs in the win. Reynaldo Yean worked a scoreless ninth for his fourth save. **SERIES WIN!:** Last night's win gives Rancho four of five in the series, meaning their first series win since they took

four of six from Inland Empire in the opening days of the second half. It's the second series win they've taken from Stockton this year, after winning three of four at LoanMart Field in the opening home stand of 2024.

MCLAIN ON FIRE: Sean McLain has had a tremendous series in Stockton through five games, batting .545 (12-for-22), with two home runs and eight runs driven in, while slugging 1.000 with an OPS of 1.615. He's batting .288 through 19 games in the second half, after hitting just .148 through 32 games in the first half.

FUTURE BOYS: A former Quake and a current Quake are slated to participate in Sunday's annual All-Star Futures Game in Arlington Texas. 2023 Quakes catcher Thayron Liranzo and 2024 Quakes infielder Jeral Perez will both represent the Los Angeles Dodgers. Liranzo, who's currently in the High-A Midwest League playing for the Great Lakes Loons, is ranked as the Dodgers' eighth best prospect, while Perez is ranked 17th. The game can be seen on MLB Network today with first pitch at 1pm Pacific.

SECOND HALF STUFF: In order to make the playoffs in 2024, the Quakes must win the second half, or else finish second in the South Division's second-half race, while having the first-half champion Storm win the division again. The Storm will meet the second-half winner or the team with the next best second-half record. Lake Elsinore last went to the playoffs in 2022, when they won the Cal League title. Modesto won the North Division First Half Title. **WYATT CROWELL:** Left-hander Wyatt Crowell makes his fifth appearance for the Quakes and his ninth total appearance of 2024. Crowell has been incredible over his first four starts, allowing just one run on three hits over his first 11 innings. In his last appearance this past Tuesday night, he struck out three Stockton Ports over two perfect innings. Crowell joined the Quakes from the Arizona Complex League, where in four starts, he pitched just six innings, allowing four runs on just two hits, but with four walks and nine strikeouts. The lefty was drafted by the Dodgers in

JACKSON FINLEY: Jackson Finley makes his tenth start and 18th appearance, his third appearance and first start against the Quakes. In his first outing against Rancho, he allowed one run on one hit over two innings in a loss at LoanMart Field on April 11. He also pitched in relief earlier this series, striking out seven batters across three perfect innings of relief on July 9. Finley was an eighth-round pick in the 2023 draft out of Georgia Tech University. **BROADCAST HOME:** Catch all the 2024 action with the "Voice of the Quakes" Mike Lindskog, from the ease of
