CORPUS SCORES EIGHT IN NINTH INNING TO SINK RIDERS:
The Frisco RoughRiders dropped their series finale 11-6 to the Corpus Christi Hooks on Sunday night from Riders Field. Corpus Christi (9-12, 31-58) tallied first when Wes Clarke drilled a two-run homer in the top of the first, taking a 2-0 lead. Frisco (8-13, 46-43) then answered when Sebastian Walcott clipped a two-run triple in the bottom of the third, tying the game at two. The Hooks regained the lead in the top of the fourth when Pascanel Ferreras blasted a solo shot, grabbing a 3-2 advantage. The RoughRiders then responded in the bottom of the sixth when Walcott singled, stole second and came around to score on a wild pitch, leveling the game at three. In the bottom of the eighth, Aaron Zavala launched a go-ahead, solo homer to snag a 4-3 lead, Frisco's first of the game. Ortiz then added an RBI groundout, stretching the lead to 5-3. Down to its final three outs, Corpus Christi exploded for eight runs in the top of the printh Ryrag Willits plated a run on a fielding error. Wes Clark drew a game-tying walk. Orlando Martinez rolled a two-run single the ninth. Bryce Willits plated a run on a fielding error, Wes Clark drew a game-tying walk, Orlando Martinez rolled a two-run single, Zach Cole drove a two-run triple, then Trevor Austin and Pascanel Ferreras smashed RBI singles to take a 10-5 lead. In the bottom of the ninth, **Josh Hatcher** drew a bases loaded walk, trimming the Hooks lead to 11-6. With the bases loaded and two outs, Corpus Christi reliever Anderson Bido induced a game-ending groundout earn the save. Hooks reliever Alimber Santa (3-1) earned the victory, pitching a scoreless eighth. Riders reliever **Gavin Collyer** (4-5) took the loss, yielding four earned runs and a blown save.

Abimelec Oritz has been on fire at the plate in July. In the month, he is hitting .309/.387/.618/1.005 over 13 games with five doubles, four home runs, nine RBIs and six walks. He has collected four-straight multi-hit games, batting .556 (10-for-18)/.579/1.111/1.690 with four doubles, two home runs and five RBIs.

#### WALK IT LIKE I TALK IT:

Aaron Zavala walked twice on Friday, collecting his 207th career walk in a RoughRiders uniform to break the all-time franchise record, previously held by **Guilder Rodriguez**. Making it much more impressive, Zavala accomplished the feat in 312 games with a 15.1 percent walk rate over four seasons (2022-2025) while Rodriguez needed 524 RoughRiders games from 2009-2015 and a 9.8 percent walk rate.

#### **HOLD ME CLOSE AND DON'T LET GO:**

In their last nine games, the RoughRiders have had the lead or a tie game in the eighth inning in each contest, but they are 4-5. The Riders have blown five saves during that span. Their bullpen ERA of 4.70 in July is last in the Texas League.

**Keyber Rodriguez** has been swinging a hot bat for the Riders recently. Since June 15th, in his last 22 games, he is hitting .363 (29-for-80)/.446/.450/.896 with seven doubles, five RBIs, 10 walks, 10 runs scored, 11 walks and just nine strikeouts. In July, he is batting .341 (15-for-44) over 12 games.

CAULEY! CAULEY, CAULEY ANYTIME:
Cam Cauley has been incredible for the RoughRiders lately on offense. In his last 57 games since May 7th, he is batting .269/.332/.461/.793 with 17 doubles, seven home runs, 22 RBIs and 14 stolen bases. In his last 21 games, he is slashing .289/.337/.522/.859 with seven doubles, four home runs, 11 RBIs and seven steals.

#### **EVERY DAY SHOULD BE BRATT-URDAY:**

Starting pitcher Mitch Bratt has been one of the best in the Texas League this season and was dominant on Saturday against Arkansas, going six innings on one-run baseball. He is four in the league in ERA (2.73) while second in the league with 100 strikeouts this season. He is also seventh in innings (80.0), fourth in WHIP (1.11), first in strikeout rate (30.8 percent), first in walk rate (4.0 percent), first in left on base rate (82.7 percent) and second in swinging strike rate (13.9). Among full-season pitchers, his strikeout to walk ratio of 7.69 is second in all of Minor League Baseball.

The RoughRiders have now stolen at least one base in 19 of their last 22 games. Over those 22 games, they have stolen 36 total bases, which is second in the league. Sebastian Walcott is first in the league with 11 steals in that span while Cam Cauley is sixth with seven. Overall this season, the Riders are sixth in the league with 104 stolen bases.

Rangers top prospect Sebastian Walcott has showed off incredible consistency this season. In April, he hit .244 with a .766 OPS, in May, produced a .257 average and .811 OPS, but struggled with extra-base hits in June, hitting .239, but just a .640 OPS. This season, his walk rate of 12.2 percent is a career high while he is striking out at just 21.6 percent, a career low. This season, he is on pace for 34 steals over 124 games, which would best his prior career high of 27 last year. The only teenagers since 2005 to steal 30 or more in Double-A are **Elvis Andrus** (51, 2008), Jackson Chourio (43, 2023), Nelson Rada (35, 2024) and Mike Trout (31, 2011). Chourio was the only one on that list with 30+ stolen bases and double-digit home runs (22). Walcott participated in the Futures Game for the second season in a row over the All-Star Break, going 0-for-1 with a sacrifice fly and a groundout to shortstop while playing third base defended. sively. Over a five-game hitting streak, he is hitting .364 (8-for-22)/.417/.727/1.144 with one triple, two home runs and seven RBIs


