Game 2 - TinCaps 2, Lugnuts 1 (7 innings). Will Johnston struck out eight in five scoreless innings and CJ Rodriguez delivered a walkoff RBI single to cinch a twinbill split.

LUG•NOTES

Clean Baseball: The Lugnuts have played six consecutive error-free games entering tonight. This is the Lugnuts' longest error-free stretch since a streak of six straight error-free games from August 5-11, 2024.

Walkoff Winners: Last night's thrilling Lansing victory marked the Nuts' fifth walkoff of the year. The fourth, coincidentally, also came in Game 2 of a doubleheader, on August 18 vs. West Michigan. Also a coincidence: the Nuts walked off with wins on April 28 (over Dayton), May 28 (beating Peoria) and August 28, last night. Games on June 28 and July 28 each ended in defeat.

Welcome to the Ballclub: The winning run was scored last night by shortstop Josh Kuroda-Grauer, just added to the team from Single-A Stockton to start the series. Kuroda-Grauer, the 2024 Big Ten Player of the Year at Rutgers, is the 46th different Lugnut to suit up this year and the 949th all-time player in team history.

Big Note: Lansing's hottest hitter is Nate Nankil, a San Diego native who grew up cheering on the Padres and considers former TinCap Fernando Tatis, Jr. his favorite player. Nankil, drafted in the seventh round last from Cal State Fullerton, is hitting .378 since joining the Lugnuts on July 30. That's the second best batting average in High-A over that span, trailing only West Michigan's Seth Stephenson. Since August 10, however, Nankil is hitting a red hot .439 avg. (25-for-60), and that ranks tops for High-A and 5th in all of Minor League Baseball.

Alumni Watch: 2017 Lugnut Vladimir Guerrero, Jr. ranks 3rd in the Major Leagues in batting average (.322) and base hits (165); 5th in on-base percentage (.398) and doubles (37); 6th in total bases (285); and 7th in OPS (.955)

Welcome Back: 2003 Lugnuts southpaw Rich Hill was signed by the Red Sox on August 17 and recalled to the Majors on August 27, thus entering his 20th MLB season. Hill had spent the summer coaching his son in Little League.

Prospecting: Lugnuts among MLB Pipeline's updated Top 30 A's Prospects include Luis Morales at No. 3, Josh Kuroda-Grayer at No. 13, Kade Morris at No. 19, Jared Dickey at No. 27 and Ryan Lasko at No. 30.

Team Effort: The Nuts' offense ranks 1st in the MWL in batting average (.249), base hits (1000), total bases (1503) and triples (37); 2nd in at-bats (4022), runs (585), and slugging percentage (.374); tied for 2nd in doubles (198) and OPS (.712); and 3rd in on-base percentage (.338).

TODAY IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2016: 1st-rounder T.J. Zeuch (the 21st overall pick in the June draft) arrived with the Lugnuts from Vancouver, and the Lugnuts supported him with a ten-run 3rd inning (the first 10-run inning since June 15, 2008) on their way to a 12-6 win at Lake County. Zeuch struck out seven in three innings, allowing seven singles and leaving with the bases loaded in the fourth. All three runners scored against Daniel Young, charging Zeuch with five runs. The Lugnuts also had their defensive play of the year, a behind-the-back glove flip from shortstop Ryan Metzler that started a 6-4-3 double play in the seventh.

2019: It was beat-the-rain with the Lugnuts, in a two-hour, 24-minute 7-3 victory over West Michigan before a massive storm showed up at Cooley Law School Stadium. Fitz Stadler gave up one run in six innings and LJ Talley, Johnny Aiello, Rafael Lantigua and Griffin Conine all homered off Whitecaps starter Chance Kirby in the win.

No-Hit History: On June 13, tossed five hitless innings, walking two and striking out six, before handing the baton to Grant Judkins (2 2/3) and then Colton Johnson (1 1/3) as part of the Lugnuts' 8-0 no-hitter of the Cedar Rapids Kernels, the 4th no-hitter in franchise history and the first home no-hitter since April 2003.

Hometown Hero: Started four years for Jupiter High School varsity baseball ("Warriors," wearing green and gold)... totaled 229 strikeouts, 1.49 ERA and 1.13 WHIP... named two-time FHSAA All-State... honored twice as the 9A Player of the Year... also from Jupiter H.S.: Miles Mikolas and Dante Bichette (but not son Bo, who attended Lakewood High School in St. Petersburg)... family originally from New England before moving to Florida shortly before he was born; the Garlands thus all root for Boston-area teams.

Jupiter? How did Jake's hometown receive its name? The Hobe tribe lived in the area, a Spanish mapmaker miswrote their name as Jobe, which was then miswritten again as Jove, which was then mistranslated to Jupiter. Misunderstandings the whole way down to the city's incorporation in 1925. Jupiter is located on the eastern coast of Florida in Palm Beach County on the Atlantic Ocean.

The Bandit Connection: Burt Reynolds was born in Lansing in 1936, and died in Jupiter in 2018.

The U: Attended the University of Miami (Coral Gables), a baseball program founded in 1940 with four NCAA championships and 25 CWS appearances... played for head coach Gino DiMare... true freshman year was the pandemic-shortened 2020 season, making six relief appearances before the year was shut down... returned in 2021 as a member of the rotation: 16 games, 13 starts, totaling a team-high 68 innings (5.69 ERA, 38 K, 14 BB, .286 avg.)... improved in 2022 to a 3.99 ERA in 65 1/3 innings (54 K, 11 BB, lowering home runs from 10 to four)... fifth of six Hurricanes drafted in 2022, going 514th overall in the 17th round to Oakland... the last Miami product drafted by the A's: Jemile Weeks (1st round, 12th overall, 2008)... two other Hurricanes have played for the Lugnuts: 3B Mark Sobolewski and OF Adam Finnieston.

Path to Lansing: After signing for \$100,000, made three appearances, one start, for the Arizona Complex League A's, tossing three total innings... opened 2023 pitching in relief in Stockton's second game of the year, started by rehabbing American League All-Star Paul Blackburn... earned the honor of **California League Pitcher of the Week** with his very next outing, firing five perfect innings on April 13 at Fresno with seven strikeouts (69 pitches, 47 strikes)... finished his time in Stockton with back to back six-inning outings against Fresno and Rancho Cucamonga before getting called up to the Lugnuts to replace Jorge Juan on May 15... dominated in Lugnuts debut May 18 vs. Lake County: 95 pitches, 59 strikes, 7 innings, 2 hits, 1 run, 2 walks, 10 strikeouts, in 5-2 win.
