**LAST TIME OUT:** Brooklyn and Hudson Valley split a pair of games on Saturday... In the first contest, the Renegades walked away 2-0 winners thanks to a run in the 6th and 7th...Despite the loss, RHP **Joel Díaz** tossed 4.0 scoreless innings, allowing only 3 base hits and 1 walk...The Cyclones were just 1-for-8 with men in scoring position...The second contest didn't see a ton of hitting either, but Brooklyn captured a 2-1 win thanks a 2-run single from 2B **Nick Roselli** in the 3rd...LHP **Zach Thornton** continued his outstanding start to the year, hurling 5.0 shutout, 2-hit innings...The southpaw struck out 6 and walked only 1...The Renegades loaded the bases in the 7th, but could not pull even as the Cyclones converted a game-ending double play to escape the jam.

**THOR'S HAMMER:** LHP **Zach Thornton** picked up right where he left off in 2024... After 5.0 more shutout frames on Saturday, the Grand Canyon product is now 2-0, has yet to allow an earned run, and holds a 14:2 strikeout-to-walk ratio...Thornton is 1 of just 2 pitchers in the circuit to have thrown at least 10.0 innings this season... He is also 1 of only 3 arms at the High-A level to toss 10.0 or more innings without allowing an earned run (Great Lakes' RHP **Brooks Auger** & Vancouver's RHP **Grant Rogers**)...Thornton is the only one to not allow a run at all...His 14 strikeouts are tied for 3rd in the SAL, while his outstanding 0.60 WHIP is 2nd amongst those qualified... Thornton collected his 1st win of the year, behind 5.0 shutout innings against Wilmington on April 6 while striking out a career-high 8 batters.

**ROTATION ROCKS!:** Brooklyn's starters have been exquisite after the first full turn through the rotation...Cyclones starting pitchers possess a 1.56 ERA through the first 8 games of the season...The group has permitted just 6 earned runs over 34.2 innings...Under the leadership of first year pitching coach **Jordan Kraus**, the starters hold an impressive 44:11 strikeout-to-walk ratio...The 1.56 ERA is good for 2nd in the South Atlantic League, while the 'Clones starters' WHIP of 0.98 is tied for the league lead with Aberdeen.

**THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY:** On April 13, 2024, the Cyclones swept a doubleheader from Asheville on Coney Island...Brooklyn captured Game 1, 6-2, thanks to a 3-run LF **Stanley Consuegra** home run in the 1st...The Cyclones took the finale, 3-1...C **Drake Osborn** powered the decisive 3-run blast in the 4th...In 2023, Consuegra went 4-for-5 at the plate with 2 doubles and 4 RBI in a 7-5 loss at Winston-Salem.

**LEVITTOWN LEGEND:** INF **Nick Roselli** provided the decisive base hit in Saturday's Game 2 victory over Hudson Valley...The infielder came through with the bases loaded in the 3rd, smacking a 2-run single that accounted for all of Brooklyn's scoring in a 2-1 victory...His 5 RBI are tied for 3rd on the team...Roselli grew up 34 miles northeast of Maimonides Park in Long Island's Levittown...The 11th round pick played his college ball at Binghamton University, where he was a career .349 hitter for the Bearcats...The Division High School product grew up a huge Mets fan, and was considered to have the "Best Pro Debut" of any member of the 2024 Mets draft class by *Baseball America*.

**THE LONG HALL:** RHP **Noah Hall** is off to a wonderful start to 2025...Through two starts, the 2023 draftee is 1-0 with a 0.93 ERA, 11 strikeouts and only 4 hits given up...The right hander tossed 4.2 innings of 1-run ball in a loss to Hudson Valley on Thursday...The righty punched out a career-high 8 batters, and gave up only 1 hit... All this came after Hall spun arguably his best career pro outing on Opening Day for Brooklyn...The 2023 draftee picked up the win, thanks to 5.0 innings of 1-run ball...Hall surrendered only 3 hits, and gave up just 1 run...The University of South Carolina product became not only the 1st player in franchise history to start on consecutive Opening Days, but the first player in franchise history to start multiple Opening Days.

**SOARIN' SERRANO:** OF **Eli Serrano III** has impressed to begin his High-A career... On top of making an outstanding catch colliding into the left-field wall on Thursday night that was featured on ESPN's *SportsCenter* Top 10, the 2024 4th-round selection is 8-for-27 at the plate...3 of his 8 hits have gone for extra bases, including 2 home runs, one of which was a mammoth blast to right-center field, no small feat at Maimonides Park...The N.C. State product has also displayed a keen eye at the plate, drawing 7 walks through 6 games...Serrano III is tied for second in the league in home runs and walks entering play on Sunday.

**SUERO SUAVE:** C **Chris Suero** is off to a scorching start in 2025...The Bronx native is 1 of 2 players on the Cyclones with multiple home runs...Suero is a blistering 9-for-26 at the dish, with 7 extra-base hits, 8 runs batted in, and boasts an impressive 1.62 OPS.

**YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT, YOU GET A HIT...YOU GET THE POINT:** In Saturday's lopsided victory over Wilmington, Brooklyn put up some gaudy numbers that haven't been seen on the boardwalk in quite some time...The 15 runs scored are the most scored in a single game by the Cyclones since Brooklyn scored 18 times in an 18-1 victory at Jersey Shore on August 28, 2022...The Cyclones offensive output was their best at Maimonides Park since June 24, 2010, vs. Hudson Valley, in a 16-5 win... Additionally, Brooklyn's 20 hits collected on Saturday were the most hits the 'Clones in any game since a 20-hit effort in a 13-0 triumph vs. Aberdeen on July 21, 2011...3B **Richard Lucas** went 5-for-6 at the dish, while CF **Travis Taijeron** was a perfect 4-for-4 with 5 RBI...The contest was just the second game since 2005 where Brooklyn accumulated 15+ runs and 20+ hits in the same contest...The Cyclones first accomplished the feat with 16 runs and 22 hits in a 16-7 win at Tri-City on July 13, 2007.

**vs. HUDSON VALLEY:** The Cyclones welcome in the Hudson Valley Renegades for the first installment of the SAL Subway Series of 2025...The Yankees High-A affiliate went 2-1 against Jersey Shore to start the new year, including an 8-7 walk-off victory last Saturday...Hudson Valley boasts 8 top 30 Yankees prospects including INF **George Lombard Jr.** (2), RHP **Ben Hess** (4), RHP **Bryce Cunningham** (6), RHP **Elmer Rodriguez-Cruz** (8), RHP **Cade Smith** (16), RHP **Carlos Lagrange** (19), LHP **Kyle Carr** (20) and INF **Roc Riggio** (27)...Riggio and Smith are currently on the injured list.

**REIM TIME!** It's difficult to get out to much of a hotter start than Cyclones INF **Jacob Reimer**...Through 8 games, the California native is an impressive 9-for-32 at the plate with 8 RBI, 6 runs scored, 3 doubles and a triple...The 2022 draftee is tied for 3rd in circuit in RBI (8) and tied for 4th in the league in doubles (2)...Reimer collected more RBI through his first 2 games played this season than he logged all of last year through 25 games scattered across three different levels.

**BOARDWALK BENGIE:** OF **Carson Benge** started his 2025 on the right foot thanks to a keen eye at the plate...Benge is 3-for-14 with a double, 2 RBI and 7 walks through his first 5 games played...The 7 walks are 2nd on the team behind only **Eli Serrano III**, while being tied for 4th in the South Atlantic League...The Oklahoma State product laced a double to left field last Friday for the first High-A hit of his career.

**2024 IN REVIEW:** Although the Cyclones did not qualify for the postseason last year, 2024 saw a bevy of achievements on the boardwalk...Numerous franchise records were set, including the all-time games played, hits and stolen base records, in addition to the single season hits and stolen base records being set...The 2024 'Clones tossed the first nine-inning no-hitter in franchise history thanks to a combined effort, and six players appeared in Brooklyn on big league rehab assignments.

**BROOKLYN TO THE BIGS:** After four former Cyclones made their Major League debuts in 2024, three alumni had already accomplished the feat before the end of March in 2025...C **Hayden Senger** ('18, '21) came off the bench and became the 103rd former Cyclone to play in the Majors and the 68th to debut with the New York Mets on Opening Day, March 27 at Houston...Three days later, on March 30, OF **Jake Mangum** ('19, '21) batted second and played right field for the Tampa Bay Rays and went 0-for-3 with a walk...RHP **Mike Vasil** debuted for the Chicago White Sox a day later, tossing 2.0 innings of two-hit shutout relief, whiffing 1B **Ty France** for his first Major League strikeout...The franchise record for debuts in a single season is nine in 2015 and 2017.

**GOMEZ GEARED UP FOR ROUND TWO IN BK:** Cyclones manager **Gilbert Gómez** embarks on his second season at the helm after serving as the youngest manager in franchise history in 2024...The 33 year old becomes the first Cyclones skipper to begin a 2nd consecutive season as manager since **Edgardo Alfonzo** (2017-2019)... Gómez led Brooklyn to a 65-67 record during his inaugural season at the controls... Gómez spent the winter as the head man for Tigers del Licey in the Dominican Winter League.

**FAMILIAR FACES:** 21 players on the Cyclones break camp roster have previous playing experience in Brooklyn...Notables include: INF **Boston Baro**, who played in 11 games with Brooklyn towards the end of last season...INF **Jacob Reimer**, who suited up in 39 games for the 'Clones over the last two years...RHP **Dakota Hawkins** had a hand in the first nine inning no-hitter in franchise history last year...RHP **Ben Simon** logged 22 appearances, the most amongst any returning pitcher outside of Hawkins.

**NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK:** 7 members of the Mets' 2024 draft class begin the 2025 campaign with the Cyclones...RHP **Ryan Lambert** was the lone '24 draftee that returned to the Brooklyn roster, while 1st-round selection OF **Carson Benge**, 2nd-round pick LHP **Jonathan Santucci** and 4th-rounder OF **Eli Serrano III** all made their High-A debuts...RHP **Brendan Girtton**, RHP **R.J. Gordon** & INF **Nick Roselli** round out the class.

**KEEP IT IN THE BALLPARK!:** With so much of Brooklyn's pitching staff returning from last year, it's worth noting that Cyclones pitchers led the South Atlantic League by a wide margin in home runs allowed (59)...Hudson Valley was the next closest (78)...Of the 59 long balls permitted, only 20 of them came at Maimonides Park...Over the last two seasons, Brooklyn arms have surrendered just 55 home runs in 132 home games.

**AMAZIN' STARTS HERE:** Brooklyn's Opening Day Roster features no shortage of talent...According to MLB Pipeline, the Cyclones boast seven of the Mets Top 30 prospects...Those include OF **Carson Benge** (3), LHP **Jonathan Santucci** (13), INF **Boston Baro** (14), INF **Jacob Reimer** (21), C **Chris Suero** (22), OF **Eli Serrano III** (23) and C **Ronald Hernandez** (27)...Of those seven, four have previous experience playing in Brooklyn.

**LAST TIME OUT:** Took a no-decision in his professional debut on Tuesday night vs. Hudson Valley...Allowed 2 runs on 3 hits over 4.1 innings...Walked 1 and struck out 4...Threw 69 pitches and 49 strikes (71.01%)...Retired the final 7 batters he faced in order starting with the first out of the 3rd inning...Relieved by RHP **Layonel Ovalles** with the bases empty and 1 out in the top of the 5th inning and the Cyclones leading 5-2...Ovalles (1.1 IP), RHPs **Eduardo Herrera** (1.1), **Ryan Lambert** (1.0), and **Saúl García** (1.0) combined to toss 4.2 innings of hitless relief to close out Brooklyn's 7-3 win.

**MAIDEN VOYAGE:** Gordon made his professional debut on Tuesday night...The 23-year-old did not pitch after signing with the Mets on 7/22/24 for \$150,000...Gordon was the first player to make his professional debut for the Cyclones since teammate RHP **Ryan Lambert** debuted in relief on 9/1/24 at Winston-Salem...LHP **Jonathan Santucci**, New York's second-round pick in 2024, did the same on Wednesday afternoon.

**DUCK TALES:** Gordon spent his four-year collegiate career at the University of Oregon...As a junior in 2024, the Santa Clarita, Calif. native accumulated a 7-6 record with a 5.13 ERA (54 ER in 94.2 IP), 46 walks, and 87 strikeouts in 17 starts for the Ducks...Gordon was named All-PAC 12 Honorable Mention and was recognized on the University's Dean's List in the Winter of 2023...Served as Oregon's Opening Day starter in 2024...Was the Game 1 starter in every regular-season series, as well as the Santa Barbara Regional and the Bryan-College Station Super Regional...Led the PAC-12 in games started (17)...Also ranked 2nd in innings pitched (94.2), tied for 3rd in wins (7), and 8th in strikeouts (87).

**ON THE MEND:** The 23-year-old returned to the bump for the Ducks in 2024 after missing and redshirting the entire 2023 season due to a UCL injury that required internal brace surgery to correct...Despite missing an entire campaign, Gordon still finished his career at Oregon tied for 10th in program history in games started (28)...Finished his college career with a 14-9 record, a 5.22 ERA (106 ER in 182.2 IP), 1 save, 89 walks, and 155 strikeouts in 51 appearances (28 starts).

**SUMMER FUN:** Following his freshman season at Oregon, Gordon spent his summer of 2021 pitching for the Bend (Ore.) Elks of the West Coast League...In four starts, the right-hander posted a 2-1 record with a 3.97 ERA (10 ER in 22.2 IP), 7 walks, and 29 strikeouts...Gordon was teammates with a pair of former Cyclones that summer, spending time on the pitching staff with LHP **Eli Ankeney** (2023) and RHP **Kade Morris** (2024).

**BOTH WAYS:** Gordon finished his high school career at West Ranch High School in Stevenson Ranch, Calif. before attending the University of Oregon...The 23-year-old spent his sophomore and junior seasons at Notre Dame High School...During his time in high school, the right-handed pitcher also served as a gifted outfielder, hitting .414 (12-for-29) with a home run, 4 RBI, and 1.204 OPS in a COVID-shortened senior season...In high school, Gordon faced off as a hitter against 2024 National League Rookie of the Year and Pittsburgh Pirates RHP **Paul Skenes**, who attended El Toro High School (Lake Forest, Calif.), registering a double.

**FORE!:** R.J. is far from the only athlete in the Gordon family...R.J.'s father, **Jason**, is an accomplished professional golfer who has played on the Canadian PGA Tour, the PGA Tour, and the Nationwide Tour.
