NEWS AND NOTES:

- **Last Time Out:** The Chiefs were on the wrong end of an 11-8 slugfest Friday at Dow Diamond. Great Lakes jumped out to a 6-0 lead after two and appeared to be on their way to an easy victory. Peoria had other ideas as the Chiefs scored four runs in the third to get right back in the ballgame. The Chiefs moved within one run twice Friday but couldn't get over the hump. **Mack Chambers**, **Jacob Buchberger** and **Oswaldo Tovalin** all homered in the defeat. Friday's loss marked just the second time this season that Chiefs lost while hitting three or more homers.
- **Run, Chiefs, Run!:** After a steal from **Tyler Reichenborn**, Peoria enters action tonight with 152 swipes in 182 attempts (.835). The 152 steals are good for eighth most in a single season in franchise history and the most since 2015 (157). Yet, the Chiefs still have a long way to go to get the franchise record. The 2001 Chiefs stole 249 bases, paced by Chris Evans' 111 stolen bases, the Midwest League all-time record.
- **Breaking Out:** In what turned out to be his fifth three-hit game of the season, **Jacob Buchberger** enjoyed a fine night at the plate. Friday's performance was a bounce back game for one of Peoria's most consistent players this season. The Michigan native was 2-for-39 in the month of August prior to last night's outburst. Still, Buchberger has found a way to impact the Peoria offense. He's swiped four bags since August 1, one shy of the team lead this month.
- **Hitting His Stride:** Saturday's starter **Dionys Rodriguez** has found his groove in the latter half of the season. Over his last three starts, Rodriguez is 2-0 with a 1.88 earned run average and has scattered just 10 hits over 14.1 innings of work. The right-hander was really sharp in his only start against Great Lakes this season. On April 16, Rodriguez allowed just one run on one hit while punching out four.
- **About the Chiefs:** The 2022 season marks the Chiefs 20th year of affiliation with the St. Louis Cardinals. Additionally, Dozer Park is celebrating its 20th year of operation after it opened in May of 2002. As a franchise, the Chiefs have sent more than 200 players to the majors, including Rafael Palmeiro, and current Cardinals Albert Pujols and Yadier Molina. The organization has also retired four numbers- #6 for Wally Joyner, #17 for Mark Grace, #23 for former manager Ryne Sandberg and #31 for Hall of Fame pitcher Greg Maddux.
