(SYRACUSE, NY - July 9) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre RailRiders topped the Syracuse Mets 8-6 in ten innings. Down a run in the top of the ninth inning, Jeter Downs smoked a home run to tie things up. The RailRiders plated three in the tenth to earn the road victory.

Syracuse took an early lead off of Yoendrys Gómez in the first inning. Carlos Cortes homered for the home team in the next frame, his seventh of the season. Gómez was finished after two frames and 60 pitches. Oddanier Mosqueda went an inning and two thirds clean and Alex Mauricio got the final out for him in the fourth. Chasen Shreve was sharp out of the bullpen setting down six of six Mets. In the top of the seventh, the RailRiders worked to tie it at four apiece. Jose Rojas led off with a base hit and Taylor Trammell walked to reach. Oscar González doubled down the first base line to cut the lead in half. Oswald Peraza and Jorbit Vivas worked consecutive free passes to load the bases. Carlos Narvaez placed a ball in shallow right center to score a pair for a 4-4 game. Scott Effross entered to pitch the bottom half on a Major League rehab assignment. Yolmer Sanchez notched a bunt single and moved over to scoring position on a Pablo Reyes double. The Mets loaded the bases and Effross induced a ground ball off of Rhylan Thomas. SWB tried to turn two, but Thomas beat out the throw at first to, allow a run to score. Down 5-4 in the ninth, Jeter Downs smoked his tenth home run of the season to tie things up. Peraza followed with a base knock and stole second. He got to third but was stranded there as Tyler Jay retired the next three batters. In the home half, Morris (W, 6-0) set down the side 1-2-3 just as he did in the eighth inning. Jay came back out in the tenth to face the RailRiders. #### **NEWS & NOTES**

SECOND TO TEN- Tuesday night's victory in extra innings against Syracuse was just the second time the team has seen the tenth frame this season. It is also their second win in this instance as well with the last coming on June 9 versus Norfolk. They have had only one other extra inning game this season which was interestingly against Syracuse. At PNC Field on April 6 in game two of a doubleheader, the RailRiders lost in eight frames.

LOCKRIDGE LEGS IT OUT- Brandon Lockridge stole his 28th base on Tuesday to lead the team. He has the most in the Yankees farm system, two ahead of Enmanuel Tejeda. He is three behind the International League leading Steward Berroa with 30. Lockridge career high in a single season is 40 which he did last

CHASEN BACK- Reliever Chasen Shreve has now made all five scoreless appearances since rejoining the Yankees farm system . He spent parts of three seasons from 2015-2017 affiliated with the club. A lefty arm, Shreve saw time in Scranton/Wilkes-Barre for parts of each of those summers totalling 23 appearances. Then he signed back with the organization in 2022 where he had five outings as a RailRider. Shreve originally started the season with the Texas Rangers Triple-A team, but after not receiving the call up he took his opt out and was granted release. The Yankees signed him back on June 24. The 33-year-old has a 3.97 ERA in 367 Major League outings.

JT'S JOURNEY- JT Brubaker will make his second rehab appearance in Triple-A after tossing 2.2 innings allowing three runs back on July 5. Two of the runs came on the last pitch he threw which was a home run to LHV's Ruben Cardenas. Brubaker was traded from the Pittsburgh Pirates along with \$500,000 of International Bonus Pool money for a Player to Be Named Later (INF Keiner Delgado) on March 29, just prior to Opening Day. Brubaker did not pitch last season after undergoing Tommy John surgery on April 2, 2023. Yankees Manager Aaron Boone said he is going to be built up as a starter, but could be used in many different roles.

DUANE'S WORLD- Duane Underwood Jr. has worked a 2.84 ERA in 25 appearances. In 31.2 innings, he has struck out 32 batters. The righty has inherited ten runners this season and hasn't allowed any to score. Underwood, Jr. has two wins and three saves. The Yankees signed him as a minor league free agent in December after spending parts of six seasons with the Cubs and Pirates in the big leagues.

CODY'S CRUSHIN IT- Cody Morris took home his team-leading sixth win of the season on Tuesday after throwing two shutout frames. It was his fourth consecutive scoreless appearance totaling five and two thirds frames clean. He has bounced back impressively after his roughest outing of the season on June 21 when he issued five runs while recording only one out.


