SETTING THE SCENE: Springfield and NW Arkansas (KC) meet for the 3rd game of a 3-game series and final game of the 6-game July 4th week home/home series ... is 3rd game of a season-long 9-game road trip for SGF.

SOUTHWEST TO NORTHWEST: Today's game is the 3rd of 9 for the Cardinals at Arvest Ballpark this season ... are 1-1 through the 1st 2 games and 9-8 vs. NWA overall ... clubs matchup for final Ozarks Series of the season, Sept. 2-7.

X MAN: LHP Ixan Henderson makes his 14th start of the season and his 3rd vs. NWA ... making his 1st start since 6/25 at WCH where he took a loss after allowing a career-highs with 6 runs and 5 walks over 3.1 IP ... in last start vs. NWA on 5/30 struck out 8 and did not allow an ER on 4 hits over season-high 6.2 IP ... ranks top 5 in TXL in ERA, SO, OBA, and WHIP.

WALKER THIS WAY: OF Jordan Walker (appendix) is currently rehabbing with Springfield ... picked up his 1st hit with an RBI-double in Saturday's contest ... is 1x13 through 3 games ... 3rd-year big leaguer has played in 55 games with STL this season ... appeared in 119 games with SGF in 2022 and hit .306 with 19 HR.

ABOUT LAST NIGHT: The Naturals broke out the bats for 8 runs on 13 hits, including 4 doubles in the 4th inning, to end the Cardinals' 4-game win streak, 8-2 ... RHP Hancel Rincon allowed gave up season-highs in runs (5) and hits (10) and picked up his 1st Double-A loss ... OF Joshua Baez hit a solo HR, his 7th homer in Double-A.

LET IT LINGER: OF Noah Mendlinger went 1x3 with 2 walks on Friday to extend his hitting streak to 7 games ... is batting .464 (13x28) during the stretch ... in 25 games batting 1st in the order is hitting .337 with a .448 OBP ...
