#### CORNWELL, LLOYD PROPEL CARDINALS TO BLANKING OF HOOKS:

Alex Cornwell fired a season-high 6.0 scoreless innings in his first start since April 28 and Matt Lloyd went 2-for-3 and drove in 3 runs as the Cardinals shut out the Hooks for the second time this week defeating Corpus Christi 5-0 on Saturday night at Whataburger Field. Lloyd doubled and homered, the Cards' first since he homered at Hammons Field last Saturday against the Naturals, and Jacob Buchberger went 2-for-3 with a double and an RBI. Ryan Shreve and Matt Svanson completed the shutout with 3.0 scoreless innings of relief.



**DPPOSING STARTER:** Right-hander **Tyler Guilfoil** makes his 11th start (14th appearance) of the season for Corpus Christi...Started the series opener for the Hooks and allowed 1 ER on 4 H with 3 K and 3 BB over 4.1 IP in a 10-1 Hooks win...0-1 with a 4.40 ERA over 3 starts in June after going 2-2 with a 2.51 ERA in 6 appearances in May...Split the his first full season in 2023 between High-A Asheville (5 appearances) and Low-A Fayetteville (18 appearances) and went 3-6 with a 3.21 ERA over 23 total appearances (13 starts) overall...Made 7 appearances after being drafted in 2022 between the FCL and Fayetteville... Selected by the Astros in the 8th round of the 2022 draft out of Kentucky...Named 1st team All-American by Baseball America, NCBWA, and Perfect Game as a junior at Kentucky going 3-1 with a 1.59 ERA and 6 saves in 21 relief appearances...Spent his first 3 collegiate seasons at Lipscomb where he served as the Bison's closer saving 13 games from 2018-21...Grew up in Lexington, 1 mile from UK's campus...24 years

CARDINALS VISIT CORPUS CHRISTI TO CONCLUDE FIRST HALF: The Cardinals make their only trip to the Gulf Coast of Texas this season for their first of two matchups with the Corpus Christi Hooks (Double-A, Houston Astros). The Cards have not visited Corpus Christi since 2022 when they lost 4 of 6. In the only series between the two clubs in 2024, the Cardinals went 4-2 at Hammons Field from August 22-27.

#### CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to Southwest Missouri from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.

find themselves just a half-game behind the Arkansas Travelers for first place in the North Division of the Texas League. With the Travs starting in North Little Rock at 1:35 pm and first pitch in Corpus Christi at 5:05, the Cards will likely know whether or not they have a chance to win the first half by the time their game begins. The Cardinals' last 1st half title came in 2016 when they went 41-29 and won the division by 3.5 games over Tulsa. Springfield won the 2nd half title last season and lost in the Division Series to the Travelers.

DOWN TO THE WIRE: Entering the final day of the first half, the Cardinals

CARDS MAKE FRANCHISE HISTORY: In game one of their double-header on Thursday night at Whataburger Field in Corpus Christi, the Cooper Hjerpe and Andrew Marrero combined to throw the first no-hitter in Springfield Cardinals history in a 5-0 (7 innings) win over the Hooks. The Cardinals carried a no-hitter through 7 innings in the season opener on April 5 against Arkansas in a 6-1 win. Cardinals history dates back to 2005 when the franchise moved to Springfield from El Paso.

**HOME vs RDAD:** For a majority of the 2024 season, the Cardinals have had much more success on the road than at Hammons Field. After winning their first 8 games of the season at home, the Cardinals have dropped 18 of their last 23 games at Hammons Field, a stretch that includes a franchise record-tying 8-game home skid. Overall the Cardinals are 13-18 with a team ERA of 6.05 at home.

Road games, however, have been a much different story. The Cardinals have the best road mark in the Texas League at 23-14, and sport a 3.66 ERA which is the 2nd best in the circuit and tops in the North Division.

**GRINDIN':** Despite striking out a season-high 15 times on Friday night in Corpous Christi, simply put, the Cardinals don't strike out very much. The Cards have struck out the 2nd-fewest times in all of full-season Minor League Baseball with 482 whiffs in 68 games. The only team with fewer strikeouts than Springfield is the Wisconsin Timber Rattlers (460 K in 68 games). The Cards are averaging just 7.09 K's per game.


**BEGINNING OF A BREAKOUT?:** Lacking extra base juice in the month of June, the Cardinals enjoyed some pop in their 5-0 win on Saturday night at Whataburger Field. Springfield knocked 2 2B and a home run in the victory, the first time the Cards have had more than one extra base hit in a game since last Wednesday, June 12 at Hammons Field against NW Arkansas, spanning 8 games. It's the first time the Cardinals had 3 extra base hits since Saturday, June 8 (13 games). For the season, Springfield has 134 extra base hits this season, fewest in the Texas League. The San Antonio have the 2nd-fewest with 141 total. Despite having the most hits in the league, the Cardinals are tied for 8th in SLG at .357 and 6th in OPS (.707) despite having the highest OBP (.350). Springfield has the fewest doubles (92) and HR (34) in 2024. Over their last 12 games the Cards have 14 extra base hits, including the 3 on Saturday.

The Cardinals are on pace to hit 69 home runs, which would be the fewest in the Texas League since the 2015 Arkansas Travelers who hit 60. Springfield has also allowed 72 longballs, 2nd most in the league behind Amarillo (75). The Cardinals have hit just 8 HR since May 18 (32 games) and 3 over their last 23. The last time the Cardinals hit more than one HR in a game was May 21 when **Matt Lloyd** and **Nathan Church** both went deep in a 7-6 win over the Tulsa Drillers. Over their first 36 games the Cards hit 25 homers, good for 7th in the league.

**BIG INNINGS COSTLY:** Big innings have proven to be an issue for the Cardinals' pitching staff this season. The Cards have surrendered 48 innings of 3+ runs. All together, "big innings" have accounted for 189 of the 350 runs Springfield has allowed this season (54%). The Cardinals are 27-6 in games while they don't allow a "big inning", and 9-26 when their opponent scores 3+ runs in an inning.

**REDMOND ON DOORSTEP OF SPRINGFIELD HISTORY:** With his go-ahead two-run homer in the 8th inning on April 23 against Arkansas, Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** tied the franchise record for most home runs. His 59 career home runs in a Springfield uniform bring him even with **Xavier Scruggs** (2010-13). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 215.

Since tying the record, however, **Redmond** has gone 35 straight games without a home run.


