TONIGHT'S GAME

Round Rock and Salt Lake will square off in game four of six in the series on Friday night. Express LHP Cody Bradford is slated to start against Bees RHP Chase Silseth. First pitch at Smith's Ballpark is set for 7:35 pm. CT.

THURSDAY NIGHT DUB

The Express took game three from the Bees by a final score of 8-3 on Thursday. Round Rock struck first after back-to-back walks for CF Bubba Thompson and 3B Davis Wendzel put the pair aboard for RF Elier Hernandez. He blasted a threerun homer to give the E-Train a 3-0 advantage. In the home half, the Bees had three straight doubles to tie the game at three. In the fourth and fifth innings, Round Rock RHP Daniel Robert stranded five Salt Lake batters to keep the game tied headed into the sixth. Express 1B Blaine Crim singled Hernandez home to put the visitors up 4-3 in the sixth. The inning continued as 2B Dio Arias notched a single to score a run and Thompson drew a bases loaded walk to extend the lead to 6-3. The E-Train tallied two more in the seventh off a single and a sacrifice fly, which extended the lead to 8-3. The bullpen capped off their scoreless performance with a clean ninth to lock in the 8-3 win.

BACK TO BRADFORD

Express LHP Cody Bradford is slated to pitch on Thursday night against the Bees. Bradford is 7-1, with his only loss coming on the road against Reno on May 3. In his nine starts, only one has been a no decision. The lefty leads the Pacific Coast League in ERA (1.58) and WHIP (0.95). Bradford has shined in Friday games as he boasts a career 7-3 record when pitching on a Friday during his career.

NO SLOWING DOWN FOR ELIER

On Thursday, Express RF Elier Hernandez extended his hitting streak to 13 games dating back to May 24. Hernandez went 3-for-5 with a home run, three RBI and three runs scored to improve his season average to .321. The 13-game hitting streak is the second longest in the Pacific Coast League behind Oklahoma City INF Jahmai Jones (15). Hernandez has tallied five more hits than Jones despite his hitting streak being two games shorter.

REHABBERS ON THE MOUND

Texas Rangers rehabber RHP Joe Barlow made a relief appearance in Thursday's win and did not allow a run in his one-inning of work. He gave up two hits and struck out one. During his rehab assignment, Barlow has tossed 2.0 innings of scoreless baseball with two strikeouts.

THE OFFENSE IS EN FUEGO

In their last 20 games, the Express lead the Pacific Coast League in runs scored (167) and are averaging 8.3 runs per game. They are third in both doubles (42) and home runs (33) during that span and are averaging 6.1 walks per game through their last 20 contests.

WELCOME BACK, JONATHAN

RHP Jonathan Hernández made his 2023 Express debut in yesterday's seventh inning. In 1.2 scoreless innings, Hernandez walked two and struck out three. The righty appeared out of the bullpen to help Round Rock relievers with a scoreless performance. It marks the 10th time this year that the E-Train bullpen has not allowed a run.

SERIES UPDATE

Through three games in Salt Lake, Round Rock holds a 2-1 series lead. The Express increased their all-time advantage over the Bees to 46-28 after an 8-3 win on Thursday night. When the two teams face off in Salt Lake, Round Rock is 27-16. The last time that the E-Train played at Smith's Ballpark was during the 2021 season when Round Rock earned a six-game series sweep over Salt Lake. It was the first and only six-game series sweep the the Express have ever completed.

EXPRESS MANAGER DOUG DAVIS

The 2023 season marks Round Rock Express Manager Doug Davis's Pacific Coast League debut. Davis spent the previous two years as the manager for the Scranton Wilkes-Barre RailRiders, the New York Yankees Triple-A affiliate. Davis brings over 25 years of coaching experience to the Express dugout. Since he began coaching in 1995, he has led a minor league team for 10 total seasons and has accumulated a career 673-588 record. He spent the 2003-2004 seasons as the bench coach for the Florida Marlins, where he won the

In two seasons as the manager for Scranton Wilkes-Barre, Davis led the RailRiders to a combined record of 158-119. Last season, he helped oversee a pitching staff that led all Triple-A teams with a 3.89 ERA. Prior to his time as skipper, Davis spent three years in three different roles with Scranton Wilkes-Barre from 2017-2019. In 2017, he was the defensive coach before moving over to bullpen coach in 2018. In 2019, Davis was named the bench coach.

Before joining the New York Yankees organization, Davis spent 11 years in the Toronto Blue Jays system in a variety of roles. Before he was named manager of the RailRiders in 2021, Davis hadn't held a manager title since 2008. He has also been a minor league field coordinator for the Montreal Expos (2001) and Florida Marlins (2002, 2005). His coaching career began in the Yankees system in 1995.

A catcher and infielder in his playing days, Davis was a ninth-round selection by the California Angels in the 1984 MLB Draft. He played professionally for 11 seasons between the Angels, Rangers and Kansas City Royals organizations. He appeared in seven games in the big leagues and tallied six games in 1988 with the Angels, while appearing in one game for the Rangers in 1992. He is a native of Bloomsburg, Pennsylvania.
