JACKSONVILLE TAKES FINALE, 6-5

Jacob Berry notched three hits and three RBIs and Kemp Alderman homered in his Triple-A debut and Jacksonville held on to beat Rochester 6-5. Berry's first RBI single gave the Jumbo Shrimp a 1-0 lead in the first. After the Red Wings tied the score in the second, Berry registered a two-run single as part of a three-run second. Christian Franklin lined a leadoff homer in the third to make it 4-2 before Alderman's two-run shot in the fifth. Rochester scored once in the sixth and twice in the seventh, but could get no closer, as Josh White tossed a scoreless eighth and ninth.

DEFENSE AGAINST THE DARK ARTS

Jacksonville has yielded the fewest hits and second-fewest runs in Triple-A this season. The club has accomplished this despite ranking just 12th in strikeouts, meaning their defense has excelled throughout the campaign. The club ranks first in Triple-A in defensive efficiency, which simply measures how many batted balls put into play that are turned into outs, at .719. Second-place Durham (.709) is as close to seventh place Gwinnett (.699) as to Jacksonville.

MEN OF STEAL

Over the last three seasons, Jacksonville ranked 23rd, 21st and 29th, respectively, in Triple-A in stolen bases. The club's 273 this season not only lead the entire level, but they rank eighth in all of Minor League Baseball. Of the top 24 MiLB teams in steals, only two are Triple-A or Double-A teams (Jacksonville & Nashville, 266, T-9th). The Jumbo Shrimp's 265 steals are the most in a campaign for any Jacksonville team in the club's Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present). No Jacksonville club has finished in the top five in their respective level in steals since at least 2005.

BEHIND THE EIGHTEEN BALL

On the heels of winning 12 out of 13 games from July 27-August 10, the Jumbo Shrimp have lost 12 of their last 18 contests. Eight of their 12 losses during this stretch have come by three runs or fewer, with the club earning just three such victories of their five triumphs. Despite the 6-12 record, Jacksonville has only been outscored 94-86 during this run. The club's pitching, which had a Triple-A-best 3.57 ERA on the season through August 10, has posted a 4.96 ERA over the last 18 games.

YOUTH IS SERVED

Among position players on the club's active roster, only five Jumbo Shrimp (Maximo Acosta, Jacob Berry, Deyvison De Los Santos, Joe Mack and Jack Winkler) have played in more than half of Jacksonville's 131 games thus far in 2025. The other seven players have combined for a total of just 113 games in Triple-A this season. Six of those seven players have been called up from Double-A Pensacola since August 2, and none of the five have tallied more than 21 games thus far with the Jumbo Shrimp.

THIRTY, STURDY AND THRIVING

Jacksonville has broken the city's previous Double-A/Triple-A era (1962-present) record by using 30 different starting pitchers through 131 games this season. Jumbo Shrimp starters have totaled only 517.1 innings (3.9 per start, fourth-fewest in Triple-A) this season, just 10.0 more than last-place Oklahoma City in Triple-A. That said, the Shrimp's 3.98 starting pitching ERA is second at the level.

FORMULA ONE

With a 27-13 (.675) record in one-run games, Jacksonville is tied with Indianapolis for the most one-run victories in Triple-A, and across the 120 MiLB teams, ranking tied for third. The 27 one-run triumphs are the most for the Jumbo Shrimp since they went 27-18 in one-run games during the 2021 campaign. The last time a Jacksonville club had more than 27 one-run wins in a season was 2014, when the Suns went 35-17 (.673) in one-run triumphs. In 2025, the Jumbo Shrimp are 49-30 (.620) in games decided by three runs or fewer, meaning 63.6 percent of their 77 victories have come by those slim margins.

FOR IT'S ONE, TWO, THREE STRIKES, YOU'RE OUT

The Jumbo Shrimp have recorded double-digit strikeouts in 15 of the 24 games the club has played since August 5. During this stretch, Jacksonville has racked up 247 punchouts (10.3 per game), the second-most in Triple-A. Nine of the club's top 23 strikeout games this season have come in the last 24 games.

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville's eight steals on Sunday matched their most in a game (8/9 at NAS) in recorded club history (2005-present).
