SUGAR LAND SPACE COWBOYS (25-14) AT ALBUQUERQUE ISOTOPES (12-27)

RHP BLAIR HENLEY (1-2, 4.40) vs. RHP Peyton Battenfield (1-0, 5.25)

TODAY'S GAME: The Isotopes and Space Cowboys meet for the second of three series on the year including the second and final set in Albuquergue ... Peyton Battenfield is slated to take the hill for the Isotopes while Blair Henley is scheduled to start for Sugar Land.

SERIES SPLIT: Albuquerque claimed its second series split of the year (0-5-2), both coming at El Paso (also April 16-21).

THREE-BAGGERS: Michael Toglia tripled in the sixth frame Sunday, giving the Isotopes an MiLB-leading 19 three-baggers on the year. They've tallied a triple in 14 of 39 games, including their last two.

DOUBLE-DIGITS: The Isotopes scored in double-digits three times last series, including Sunday, the 10th time in 2024. Their last four victories have come when scoring 10 or more runs. In contrast, Albuquerque has been held to three or fewer runs in five of their last nine contests.

BB/K: The Isotopes pitching staff issued more walks (six) than stirkeouts (four) last night for the ninth time this year and the third time in the series at El Paso (last: May 11, seven walks and two strikeouts).

ON THE ROAD: The Isotopes set a team record by playing 12 consecutive away games in the same location. They were scheduled for back-to-back six-game trips to Sugar Land in September 2022, but two contests were rained out and cancelled.

CAUGHT STEALING: Drew Romo was caught stealing on the Isotopes lone attempt Sunday-the sixth time they have gone back-to-back games without a swipe in 2024.

BY WAY OF THE K: At the plate Sunday, the Isotopes struck out just four times, their fewest since Aug. 1, 2023 vs. Las Vegas (four).

LEFT ON BASE: Albuquerque left 13 runners on base Sunday to tie a season-high reached on three previous occassions, most recently May 7 at El Paso.

MORE DAY GAMES IN ELP: Over the last two seasons, Albuquerque has won seven of eight day games in El Paso, outscoring the Chihuahuas, 62-36.

KNOCKS: The Isotopes finished with 16 hits Sunday, tied for their third-most in a contest this year (also: March 31 vs. El Paso, April 25 vs. Oklahoma City). It was their second-most knocks in a road game during the campaign (most: 17 May 8 at El Paso)

BIG MIKE: Michael Toglia is 7-for-21 with five extra-base hits (a triple and two homers) and 11 RBI over his last five games with four multi-RBI games ... Has an extra-base hit in six of the 12 games he's played for Albuquerque this season.

SAM I AM: Sam Hilliard's homer Sunday was his 70th in an Isotopes uniform, nine away from tying Mike Busch (79, 1992-95) for most by an Albuquerque Triple-A player. He went 2-for-4, recording his 16th multi-hit game of the campaign, tied with Coco Montes for the club lead Montes for the club lead.

TONY: Drew Romo went 3-for-5 with a double and solo homer Sunday, his fifth game with at least three knocks this season Romo has produced a slash line of .429/.432/.659 with 10 doubles, a triple, three homers and 16 RBI over his last 22 games, with 13 multi-hit performances during the stretch.

FAN FAVORITE: Tallied 16th multi-hit game of the year Sunday, including his fifth in his last eight contests.

GRANNY: Grant Lavigne tallied his second three-hit game of the season Sunday (also: May 7 at El Paso). He recorded at least one base hit in four of five contests played against the Chihuahuas last week

TAKE FLIGHT: Jimmy Herron registered a single Saturday and has a hit in 23 of 25 games played in 2024, including nine of his last 10 ... Since June 25, 2023, has reached base in 68 of his last 75 games.

REAL SLIM SCHUNKY: Aaron Schunk recorded a double Sunday and has a modest five-game hitting streak. Is 9-for-23 duirng the span with three doubles, two RBI and two homers.

BIG WILLIE STYLE: Willie MacIver went 2-for-4 Sunday and has registered three consecutive multi-hit performances for the first time since May 22-24, 2019 for Low-A Asheville. He is 7-for-11 with a homer and four RBI during the stretch.

STOVIE: Hunter Stovall played the outfield Sunday for the first time since May 23, 2023, vs. Round Rock.

PCL LEADERBOARD: Drew Romo is 1st in average (.365) and T-7th in doubles (11) and hits (42) ... Aaron Schunk is T-2nd in doubles (13) ... Coco Montes is T-4th in OBP (.429), 7th in average (.331) T-7th in walks (24) and hits (42) ... Sam Hilliard is T-3rd in XBH (20), 4th in total bases (83), 6th in hits (44) and OPS (1.006), T-6th in triples (3), runs (30) and homers (8), 8th in slugging (.597) and 9th in OBP (.409) ... SKIPPER: Pedro Lopez enters his 20th year as a minor league manager and second guiding the Isotopes, the eighth manager in club history ... Spent 2021 as Albuquerque's hitting coach and 2022 as its bench coach ... Notched his 1,000th career managerial victory June 4, 2023 at Salt Lake, 7-1. Managed in the Texas Rangers (2001-05, 2007) and New York Mets (2011-19) organizations while claiming the 2014 Eastern League Championship with Double-A Binghamton. Lopez was drafted in the 21st round by the San Diego Padres in the 1988 MLB Draft and spent 13 years in the minor leagues, reaching Triple-A on four occasions.

HOMETOWN KID: Jordan Pacheco begins his third season as the Isotopes hitting coach ... An Albuquerque native and 2004 graduate of La Cueva High School, Pacheco then attended the University of New Mexico (2005-07), where he was one of the most prolific offensive players in school history (.384, 59 2B, 25 HR, 145 RBI) ... Drafted by Rockies in the 9th round in 2007 and made his MLB debut with Colorado in 2011.

CHRIS MICHALAK: Begins his second season as Isotopes pitching coach ... Pitched for the Albuquerque Dukes in 2000, followed by stints with the Isotopes in 2004 and 2008 ... Started second-to-last game in Dukes history, giving up two runs in 6.0 innings during Game 4 of a PCL First Round playoff series at Memphis Sept. 9, 2000 ... Appeared in 61 Major League games (24 starts) over five season with the Arizona Diamondbacks (1998), Toronto Blue Jays (2001) Texas Rangers (2001-02) and Cincinnati Reds (2006) ... 12th round selection by the Athletics in 1993 ... Has been in the coaching ranks since 2009, including stops as the pitching coach for the Hagerstown Suns (2010-11), Potomac Nationals (2012-13) and Harrisburg Senators (2018-20 and coached in the Washington Nationals organization from 2021-22.

MICHAEL RYAN: Enters his first year with the Rockies organization as the Isotopes bench coach ... It's his second stop in Albuquerque after the former outfielder played in 33 games for the club and hit nine homers during the 2008 campaign. He and Michalak were teammates on that squad for four days in late July ... Entered the coaching ranks in 2012 as a coach for the Double-A Altoona Curve (Pirates). He then managed in the Pirates organization at three levels for seven seasons with stops at Single-A West Virginia (2013-14), High-A Bradenton (2015-16) and Double-A Altoona (2017-19), while winning the Florida State League in 2016 and Eastern League in 2017. Ryan compiled a 221-197 managerial record with Altoona—the most wins for a manager in Curve history ... He also managed in the Cubs organization (High-A South Bend, 2021 and Double-A Tennessee, 2022-June 2023) ... A 5th round draft pick by the Minnesota Twins in 1996, played in 149 MLB games over parts of five seasons with the Twins (2002-05) and Angels (2010) ... Last Angels player to wear 27 prior to Mike Trout's call-up in 2011.

SPLIT-SEASON PLAYOFF FORMAT: For the second-straight year, the Pacific Coast League will use a split-season format to determine playoff participants. With one 10 team division, the first half winner (concluding June 23) will host the second half winner (beginning June 25) in a three-game set. The winner will then face the International League champion for the Triple-A Championship in Las Vegas, NV, Sept. 28.

BALLS AND STRIKES: The Automated Ball-Strike System (ABS), now in its third year in the Pacific Coast League, will be used for all Monday-Thursday games while the Challenge System, second year in the PCL, will be used for all Friday-Sunday contests. Each team has three challenges per game, retaining one for each successful challenge.
