NOTES AND NUGGETS

STARTED FROM THE BOTTOM, NOW WE'RE HERE

After an 0-4 start to the season, the Storm Chasers have won 9 of their last 12 games, including their last two series.

Last season, the Storm Chasers won just 6 of 27 series played ... after winning 4 of 6 games from Buffalo from March 31 to April 5, the Chasers won 3 of 5 in Iowa last week ... Omaha has won the first 2 games this week against Indianapolis.

DÉJÀ VU ALL OVER AGAIN

The Chasers have seen more success in recent years against Indianapolis than any other International League club, with a 55-30 record in 85 games since 2021.

A .647 winning percentage vs. Indianapolis is Omaha's best among the 7 opponents the Chasers have seen at least 20 times since 2021.

Among 54 IL matchups that have happened at least 20 times since 2021, Omaha's .647 winning percentage against Indianapolis is the 4th-best.

CAUGHT CLEAN-HANDED

The Omaha Storm Chasers own the 2nd-best fielding percentage in the International League at .987, committing just 7 errors in 16 games, trailing only Rochester (.991) and tied 6th among the 120 full season Minor League teams.

The clean play extends throughout the roster - of Omaha's 11 qualified fielders at a single position in the IL this season (min. 40.0 inn), 7 have a perfect 1,000 fielding percentage, with just 4 position players charged with an error ... **Kevin Newman** (91.0 innings), **Abraham Toro** (85.0 innings), **Peyton Wilson** (83.1 innings) and **Connor Kaiser** (59.1 innings) have been errorless in the infield, while **Kameron Misner** (125.1 innings) and **Gavin Cross** (98.1 innings) have been flawless in the outfield.

Toro and **Josh Rojas** have each participated in 9 double plays - Omaha's 17 double plays turned as a team rank 2nd-most in the International League.

CHALLENGING THE SYSTEM

The Omaha Storm Chasers have been the best team in Triple-A at converting ABS challenges in their favor in 2026.

Omaha's 64% win rate on challenges ranks tied 3rd at the Triple-A level ... 29 successful challenges are tied for the 2nd-most converted challenges (1st: Buffalo, 30), while 47 total challenges rank tied 3rd in Triple-A.

The Storm Chasers' success is driven largely by how aggressive their catchers have been ... **Elias Diaz** and **Luca Tresh** have challenged at a 3.6% rate, the highest among all 30 Triple-A clubs, yet have won 18 of 29 defensive challenges (62%), combining for a level-leading 6 strikeout flips and 4 walk flips.

At the plate, Omaha hitters have challenged at a 4.8% rate and converted 11 of 18 (61%), with 7 of the team's 11 challengers going a perfect 1-for-1 ... 5 strikeouts flips from the hitters rank tied for 2nd while 2 walk flips are tied 4th in Triple-A.

MISNER ON A MISSION

Outfielder **Kameron Misner** has been the heart of Omaha's offense to open the 2026 season.

Misner has reached base safely in 13 of 15 games this season, with hits in 12 of 15 ... he produced a league-best 11-game hitting streak from March 28 to April 10, going 13-for-37 (.351) with 3 doubles, 2 homers and 14 RBI ... his 17 RBI rank 4th in the International League and tied 7th among all Minor League hitters.

Misner has driven in a run in 10 of 15 games ... prior to last Saturday, he had driven in runs in 6 straight contests, a stretch (April 4 to 10) where he hit .409 (9-for-22) with 10 RBI ... he homered the first two games of last week's series, April 7 and 8.

CLOSING TIME

Eric Cerantola has been Omaha's most reliable relief arm to open the season, leading the International League in saves (4) and tied for the team lead in appearances (7).

The righty has not allowed a run in any of his 7 outings, tossing 8.1 scoreless innings while holding opponents to a .179 average (5-for-28) ... he has struck out 13 of the 33 batters he has faced (14.04 K/9) ... 8.1 scoreless innings are tied for the 3rd-most scoreless innings in the IL, with the 3rd-best strikeout rate among 10 IL pitchers with at least 7.0 scoreless innings this year.

Additionally, lefty **Andrew Pérez** earned a save in Game 1 of Omaha's doubleheader sweep last Friday in Iowa ... he has yet to allow a hit over 4.2 innings of work over 5 appearances.

Sanchez has played parts of 8 Major League seasons with Toronto (2014-19), Houston (2019), San Francisco (2021), Washington (2022) and Minnesota (2022) ... he has also played parts of 7 years in Triple-A and Omaha is his 6th Triple-A team.
- ✓ Sanchez has faced Indianapolis twice before, both as a member of the St. Paul Saints in **2023** ... he threw 5.0 scoreless innings at Victory Field on April 14, then 4.2 innings at CHS Field on May 13.

THE SANCH FACTOR

- ✓ **ROAD BACK TO THE SHOW:** Sanchez last appeared in the Major Leagues 1,290 days ago on October 4, **2022** with the Minnesota Twins, as he worked 1.2 innings of relief ... he has since pitched 39 games (37 starts) in the Minor Leagues, but has not pitched in the Majors the last 3 years.
- ✓ **ROTATION MAINSTAY:** Sanchez has largely pitched as a starter in his professional career, with 113 of 174 Major League outings coming as starts as well as 142 of 162 Minor League appearances ... his last relief appearances came with the St. Paul Saints in June and July, **2023**.
