THE UPSIDE DOWN: The Patriots spent the beginning of their series in Portland in the Upside Down, going on a season-long three-game losing streak, which was just their second losing streak of the year. They combined to score just 9 runs over first 4 games of their series in Portland, before returning to normalcy by posting 9 runs on Saturday and 12 runs on Sunday, behind a season-high 5 home runs. The Patriots had 2 hits with RISP over the first 4 games of the series, before they put together 8 hits with RISP in the final 2 games of the series. After the Patriots were held without a stolen base for 4 straight games, they answered with 3 on Saturday and 4 on Sunday.

HOME SWEET HOME: Today's Patriots starter Sean Boyle has fared significantly better in his home ballpark than on the road. In 3 starts on the road, Boyle is 1-2 with a 10.05 ERA and 1.60 WHIP with 16 ER over 14.1 IP and 18 K. In 4 starts at home, Boyle has no decisions with a 2.14 ERA and 0.81 WHIP with 29 K over 21.1 IP.

BIRTHDAY BASH: On Sunday, OF Elijah Dunham celebrated his 24th birthday by going 4-for-4, including a HR, 3 RBI, 2 R and a walk. After a hitless game in the series opener, Dunham had hits in the final 5 games vs. Portland--the longest active hit streak on the Patriots. Over this 5-game rampage, Dunham is 10-for-20 with 3 HR, 6 R, 5 RBI and 3 SB (.500/.545/1.000). Dunham now ranks 7th in the Eastern League with a .531 SLG this season. His showing on Sunday was the Patriots 4th 4-hit performance and their 2nd straight day with one, after Anthony Volpe had 4 hits on Saturday.

BOMBS AWAY: On Sunday, the Patriots hit a season-high 5 home runs in Portland. It was their 9th game with 3+ home runs, having gone 8-1 in those games. In games where Somerset has hit 2+ home runs, it's 15-2. The Patriots are also 20-2 when outhitting their opponent this season. The Patriots now lead the Eastern League with 64 home runs. Only 10/62 home runs have been 3 or 4 RBI homers.

UN-BULL-IEVABLE: Over the past 7 games, Patriots bullpen has given up just 2 ER over its last 31.1 IP (0.57 ERA).

SPREADING THE LOVE: Mickey Gasper's first homer of the season on Saturday made it so that every active batter on the Patriots roster has hit a HR this season. On Sunday, the 2-6 batters in the Patriots order each had homers (Lockridge, Breaux Chaparro, Dunham, Rosario).

- In two consecutive starts this season (5/4 vs. NH and 5/12 @ALT), Boyle struck out a career-high nine batters. On 5/4, he struck out the final eight that he faced.
- Pitched for all four Yankees full-season affiliates in 2021. Partook in two no-hitters for two different teams last season, both in the second game of a double-header and both in his first start at each respective level: Hudson Valley 7/10/21: in his High-A debut, Boyle started a combined no-hitter with five hitless innings. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre 8/19/21: in his Triple-A debut and his first start above High-A, Boyle pitched a seven-inning individual no-hitter. Note: Yankees Minor League affiliates pitched five no-hitters in 2021.
- Began 2019 season in Rookie-level Pulaski (11g, 28.2 IP, 32 K, 5 BB, 1.88 ERA), before earning promotion to Short-Season Staten Island and pitching in five games.
- Collegiately, played (2015-16) at Suffolk County Community College and posted the 8th-best ERA (1.64) in the nation at the NJCAA Division III level and was ranked the No. 21 prospect in the state of New York by Baseball America. Transferred to Dallas Baptist University for his junior and senior seasons (2017-18), where he posted a 3.60 ERA over 21 appearances his senior year.
- Long Island native grew up a Mets fan and played high school (Newfield High School) and junior college ball in Long Island, college summer ball in Albany.

COACHING STAFF



DAN FIORITO



MANAGER

Born and raised in Yonkers, NY, Dan Fiorito enters his sixth season with the Yankees organization and his first as Somerset's manager. Fiorito is also the Yankees' Roving Upper Level IF/OF Instructor. He served as the manager of High-A Hudson Valley in 2021, after making his managerial debut in 2019 with the GCL Yankees East. Fiorito also had been slated to manage the Yankees' former short-season Single-A affiliate, Staten Island in 2020, before the minor league season was canceled due to the COVID-19 pandemic. He served as the defensive coach at the Yankees' former Single-A Charleston affiliate in 2018, after making his professional coaching debut as defensive coach with the Yankees' former Rookie-level Pulaski affiliate in 2017.

His playing career began when he was signed by the Yankees as a non-drafted free agent in 2012. Over four seasons as an infielder in the Yankees system, he batted .240 (264-for-1102) with 107 runs, 52 doubles, six triples, seven home runs and 98 RBI in 322 career minor league games. Fiorito played three years at Manhattanville College (Purchase, NY) and is a 2008 graduate of Fordham Prep (Bronx, NY).



GERARDO CASADIEGO ★ **PITCHING COACH**

Gerardo Casadiego will begin his first season in Somerset and 10th in the Yankees organization. He held the same position in Hudson Valley last season, where the Renegade staff ranked second in the High-A East division in strikeouts (1,308, sixth in MiLB) and third in ERA (4.12). The Venezuela native has also previously served as the pitching coach for former Rookie-level Pulaski (2017-2019), DSL Yankees 1 (2014-2015) and DSL Yankees 2 (2016).

JAKE HIRST ★ **HITTING COACH**

Jacob Hirst will serve as hitting coach in his first season with Somerset and fourth with the Yankees organization. He was the hitting coach for Hudson Valley in 2021, when the Renegades' batters ranked second among High-A East clubs in triples (33) and OBP (.341), third in doubles (217) and fourth in home runs (156), batting average (.255), slugging percentage (.446) and OPS (.787). The Iowa native served the same role with the GCL Yankees West (2019-2020).



AARON BOSSI ★ **DEFENSIVE COACH**

Aaron Bossi begins his first season with Somerset after making his coaching debut in the same role with Hudson Valley in 2021. His prior experience for the organization was assisting rehabbing players at the minor league complex from 2017-2019. The St. Louis, MO native was signed as a non-drafted free agent by the Yankees on June 24, 2016 as a catcher/infielder. He played in 22 games for the GCL Yankees East in 2016.
