Against the Storm Chasers: Ortiz has made one career appearance against Omaha on Sept. 8, 2022. He yielded a pair of unearned runs and three walks while striking out nine in 6.0 no-hit innngs.

IL Pitcher of the Week: Last season, in Ortiz's lone appearance against the Storm Chasers, his outing earned him International League Pitcher of the Week honors (9/11/22). He was the first Indians pitcher to receive this honor since Mitch Keller in 2019.

Miscellaneous: Signed by PIT as a non-drafted free agent on 10/2/18 ... Finished the 2021 season ranked second in the Low-A Southeast in strikeouts (113) ... Tossed the fourth immaculate inning in Altoona's franchise history on 8/9 at Binghamton ... Pittsburgh's No. 4 rated prospect by Baseball America.
