LAST GAME

The Bowie Baysox were shut out for the first time this season on Sunday when they fell to the Harrisburg Senators, 8-0, in the series finale. The Baysox mustered just two hits on the afternoon, as Harrisburg starter Jackson Rutledge fired six shutout frames with five strikeouts. The Senators struck first in the second inning, as Jack Dunn delivered a sacrifice fly off Baysox starter Carlos Tavera, who would go just three innings, after conceding another sacrifice fly RBI to Blake Rutherford in the third before Donovan Casey notched an RBI double to extend the Harrisburg lead to 3-0. The Senators would add on another run in the fourth on a Brady Lindsly RBI single, before blowing the game open in the fifth, as Rutherford belted a grand slam off Bowie right-hander Houston Roth. Right-hander Malvin Pena recorded the final nine outs for Harrisburg to pick up the save. The loss was Bowie's fifth of the six-game set with Harrisburg this past week.

TODAY'S OPPONENT

The Altoona Curve enter the week with a record of 15-16. Altoona currently sits fifth in the Southwest division standings, but are only a game and a half out of first. The Curve are coming off a series in which they lost four of six games to the Akron RubberDucks at home. Altoona took four of five games played against the Baysox last month at Peoples Natural Gas Field. The Curve are led by C Henry Davis, as the No. 3 Pirates prospect and No. 48 overall prospect (per MLB Pipeline) ranks top five in the Eastern League in OPS (1.100 - 1st), on-base percentage (.452 - 1st), slugging (.648 - 2nd), batting average (.308 - 4th), home runs (8 - 4th), and extra-base hits (14 - 4th). Davis' on-base percentage also leads all of Double-A, while his OPS is second. Davis is one of six prospects in the MLB Pipeline Top 30 for the Pirates, alongside INF Liover Peguero (No. 6 PIT), RHP Jared Jones (No. 11 PIT), OF Matt Gorski (No. 16 PIT), RHP Kyle Nicolas (No. 19 PIT), and OF Matt Frazier (No. 22 PIT).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

The Curve look to kick off the series by sending right-hander Jared Jones to the mound. The No. 11 prospect in the Pirates' system, per MLB Pipeline, Jones has only made one start since a season-high five innings of one-run baseball against the Baysox back on 4/20 in Altoona, due to a brief stint on the injured list following his start against Bowie. Jones made his return to the mound this past Wednesday against Akron, where he only went 2.1 innings, allowing an earned run on two hits, throwing 37 pitches. Jones has climbed above 70 pitches in each of his remaining three starts this season. He allowed a season-high seven hits to Bowie last month, but left six runners stranded on base. A second round pick of the Pirates back in 2020 out of La Mirada High School in Whittier, California, Jones' power fastball has climbed to 96-99 mph through his professional career, and is accompanied by a curveball with depth and a sweeping slider, along with a changeup that sits in the high-80s, and can even climb into the low-90s at times.

HAIL CESAR

Despite his 10-game hitting streak coming to an end on Sunday, INF Cesar Prieto continues to pace the Eastern League with 47 hits and a .392 average - 63 points above the next highest qualified average. Prieto has hit a scorching .455 in the month of May with a .489 on-base percentage. He has collected multiple hits in 8 of his 11 starts this month, and has 15 multi-hit games in his first 30 contests of 2023. The No. 17 O's prospect also ranks third in the league in on-base percentage (.434), along with fourth in slugging (.550) and OPS (.984).

HOBBLING AT HOME

The Baysox enter this week sporting the worst home record in the Eastern League at 5-12. Bowie has been outscored 95-69 at Prince George's Stadium this season. The struggles stem, in part, from the pitching staff, who sports a 4.92 ERA at home - third worst in the league. Bowie arms have also surrendered the second-most long balls in home contests this season. 28 of the staff's 38 home runs have been conceded at home.

TANDEM TROUBLES

Bowie's abundance of starting pitching experience is leading to a statistical split based on when each pitcher enters the game. Bowie has had eight different pitchers start multiple games this season, and those pitchers sport a 3.25 ERA with 149 strikeouts in 133 innings when they start their respective games. When those same pitchers enter games as relievers, they sport a collective 6.71 ERA, with only 46 strikeouts in 51 innings.

CAREER NOTES

- 4th most strikeouts (126), 3rd most innings (117.0), and 2nd most starts (22) across the Orioles' system in 2022.
- Named an Orioles Organization All-Star in 2022 after successful stints in High-A Aberdeen and Bowie. Pitched to a 3.69 ERA in 14 appearances/10 starts across 63.1 innings for the Baysox, including a 2.08 ERA in August with a .137 BAA.
- Named Mountain West Pitcher of the Year in 2021.
- Nearly quit baseball before when only team offering him a roster spot out of high school was Division III Pacific Lutheran, "I honestly almost gave up baseball at the end of my high school career, I didn't really know if I loved it, but then I got that one opportunity ... and kind of found this new passion toward baseball."

NOTES BY OUTING

- Baysox Opening Day starter. Allowed two singles in the first inning, and was saved from allowing a run with an outfield assist. Allowed one base hit in every inning besides the third, but never worked with multiple runners on base.
- Allowed first run of the season in the fourth inning after a double and a single. Walked the first two batters of the fifth inning and was lifted.
- Allowed runners into scoring position in three different innings, but none reached third base. Mixed six flyouts and four groundouts.
- Third pitch thrown was hit for a solo home run. Walked and hit a batter later in the frame, but did not see another runner in scoring position. Left game tied at one, bullpen allowed six runs.
- Allowed three consecutive batters to reach in the first inning, and again in the second. An error and a walk lead to another run in the fifth inning.
- Allowed a solo home run to the third batter of the game. Only other runner to reach scoring position was a stolen base with two outs in the fifth.
