### TODAY'S GAME

The Round Rock Express and Sugar Land Space Cowboys (Houston Astros) are set for a Sunday afternoon rubber match, closing out their three-game series to kick off the 2026 season. Sugar Land evened the series at one game apiece on Saturday night. Round Rock RHP Josh Stephan allowed just two runs and two hits in his 5.0-inning start. LF Kellen Strahm played hero for the Space Cowboys in the bottom of the 10th. The former Round Rock outfielder muscled a single through the left side, sending 1B CJ Alexander home for a 3-2, Sugar Land victory.

### FOSS BOMB

INF Justin Foscue is one of 22 players in the PCL with four or more hits in the first two games of the year. He is 4-for-10 with a homer, an RBI and two runs scored. In 275 games with Round Rock since 2023, he is slashing .267/.380/.474/.854. He is three home runs away from becoming just the eighth player in club history with 50 or more home runs.

### CAULEY POWER

INF Cam Cauley has reached base six times in nine plate appearances to begin his Triple-A career. He is 3-for-9 with an RBI, a run scored, two walks and two strikeouts. Cauley was drafted in the third round (73rd overall) in the 2021 MLB Draft out of high school and grew up 56 miles from Constellation Field in Mont Belvieu, Texas.

### ON-BASE OSUNA

Saturday snapped a 16-game on-base streak for OF Alejandro Osuna with the Express dating back to 2025. Osuna reached base in all 15 games with Round Rock last year, and extended the streak on Opening Night. Of the six balls Osuna has put in play in his nine plate appearances, three of them have an exit velocity of 97.7 miles per hour or harder. His 109.1 mph double on Friday is the fourth-hardest hit ball in the PCL this year.

### BULLPEN BRILLIANCE

In two games, Round Rock relievers have a 1.69 ERA (2 ER/10.2 IP) with six walks and 16 strikeouts. On Saturday, RHP Marc Church, LHP Robby Ahlstrom, RHP Alexis Díaz and RHP Michel Otañez each delivered a scoreless inning. Round Rock's bullpen has an average fastball velocity of 95.1 mph which is tied with Oklahoma City for the second highest in the PCL.

### HOME OPENER ON TUESDAY

The Express will open the 2026 home slate at Dell Diamond on Tuesday, March 31 at 7:05 p.m. against the Gwinnett Stripers (Atlanta Braves). The Stripers have dropped their first two games of 2026 to Memphis and look to salvage the series today. It will be the second consecutive year the Express open at home against an International League opponent (Toledo Mud Hens).

### TEXAS TIES

The roster features five players born in Texas. RHP Ryan Brasier (Wichita Falls), INF Cameron Cauley (Houston), RHP Josh Stephan (DeSoto), RHP Trey Supak (Bryan) and RHP Mason Thompson (Round Rock). Cauley won the 2021 5A UIL State Championship at Dell Diamond for Barbers Hill High School.

### ON THIS DAY IN NOLAN RYAN HISTORY - FRIDAY, MARCH 29, 1968

The Mets lost to the Cardinals, 1-0, and legendary sports columnist, Red Smith wrote, "The pitcher was a tall Texan of 21 named Nolan Ryan. The Mets got him in the free agent draft of June, 1965, and soon discovered he could throw harder than most people. He can throw so hard that in 1966, when he pitched for Greenville, N.C., Williamsport, Pa., and briefly in New York, he struck out 313 batters in 205 innings. Last year he got a sore arm and was able to pitch only seven innings for the Jacksonville farm, yet in that space he struck out 18 guys, leaving only three put-outs for the rest of the team. The Cardinals are champions of the world but they couldn't hit him. Before Flood tripled, Ryan struck out Lou Brock. After Flood was retired, he struck out Dick Simpson. In the second inning he struck out Orlando Cepeda, John Edwards, and Mike Shannon in order. He worked four innings and allowed no runs."
