LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones dropped the series opener in Wilmington on Tuesday, 5-3...Brooklyn brought the tying run to the plate in the eighth and ninth innings, but could not complete the comeback...SS Wilfredo Lara reached base twice with a double and a hit-by-pitch...LF Karell Paz also reached base twice, registering a double, a walk, and an RBI...RHP Jack Wenninger took the loss in his Brooklyn and High-A debut, allowing five runs on eight hits in 4.2 innings...RHP Jonathan Pintaro allowed an inherited runner to score, but tossed 3.1 innings of spotless relief...1B Joe Naranjo picked up two hits and drove in two, while CF Jeremy De La Rosa clubbed a solo home run for Wilmington...RHP Jarlin Susana yielded two runs on four hits in 5.0 innings, earning the win in his Blue Rocks debut. Rocks debut.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES HISTORY: On July 10, 2010, RF Cory Vaughn blasted two home runs — a two-run shot in the first and a solo blast in the seventh — and drove in four, in a 9-3 win vs. State College...In 2016, in the top of the eighth inning, the Cyclones turned the first triple play in franchise history in a 4-3 win vs. Hudson Valley...C Dan Rizzie, SS Colby Woodmansee, and 2B Nick Sergakis combined on the triple play (2-6-4)...It was the first triple play by a Brooklyn baseball team since the Dodgers accomplished the feat on April 26, 1949, against the Boston Braves...The Dodgers turned the triple play from Gene Hermanski to Jackle Robinson to Gil Hodges...In 2019, SS Branden Fryman went 4-for-5 with a double and two RBI, while RHP Frank Valentino (6.0 IP), RHP Jared Biddy (2.0), and RHP Matt Mullenbach (1.0) combined on a four-hit shutout in a 9-0 win vs. Mahoning Valley.

LARRUPIN' LORUSSO: INF Nick Lorusso was transferred to Double-A Binghamton on Wednesday...During his time in the South Atlantic League, the 23-year-old was tied for eighth in total bases (123), ninth in walks (40), and 10th in OPS (.834)...Lorusso also dominated at Maimonides Park...The former Maryland Terrapin hit .367/.444/.661 with a 1.105 OPS in 30 contests on Coney Island...Lorusso led the SAL in home batting average (.367) and on-base percentage (.444), while trailing only Greenville OF Brayan González in slugging (.661) and OPS (1.105)... The Connecticut native is the 12th Cyclone to join the Rumble Ponies in 2024.

ROSTER MOVES: With Lorusso joining Double-A Binghamton, OF **Donovan Antonia** has been transferred from the Florida Complex League...In a corresponding move, RHP **Douglas Orellana** was placed back on the 7-day injured list....Antonia was acquired by the Mets from the Cincinnati Reds in the Minor League phase of the Rule V Draft in December 2023...In 42 games between the FCL and Single-A St. Lucie, the 20-year-old is hitting .158/.252/.221 with a .472 OPS, a home run, and 11 RBI...Orellana made just three starts after returning from the injured list on June 23, allowing three runs (two earned) on seven hits in 2.1 innings.

THE TONG SONG: RHP Jonah Tong tied a career-high with 11 strikeouts over 6.0 innings of one-run ball in a no-decision last Wednesday night in Aberdeen and threw 5.0 spotless innings to earn the win on Tuesday vs. Hudson Valley...Over his last three starts since June 20, the 21-year-old is 2-0 with an 0.56 ERA (1 ER in 16.0 IP), allowing only five hits and six walks (10.0 BB%), while striking out 25 (41.67 K%)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native leads the circuit in strikeouts (63)...He is also tied for second in batting average against (.194), third in ERA (3.02), and fifth in WHIP (1.22)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 60.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is third in FIP (2.18), fifth in strikeout rate (36.3%), eighth in strikeout-to-walk rate (26.0%), and tied for 10th in strikeouts (99).

**TRAVELING CIRCUS:** Starting with the June 25 game in Aberdeen, the Cyclones have just six home games in 28 days...Brooklyn's next full six-game home series will take place from July 23-28 vs. Rome...So far, Brooklyn is 4-9 in the stretch...The Cyclones played three games at home vs. Hudson Valley from July 1-3 and will play another three vs. Jersey Shore from July 19-21 immediately following the All-Star break...The stretch also includes a 12-day run without a day off (June 25-July 6), the longest of the season for Brooklyn.

WIZARD OF PAZ: OF Karell Paz is in the midst of one of his best offensive stretches of the 2024 season...Since clubbing a go-ahead two-run home run in the ninth inning on June 30 at Aberdeen, the 24-year-old is 9-for-26 (.346) at the plate in seven games...Paz has scored three runs and picked up three doubles, a home run, five runs batted in, and a pair of stolen bases...His OPS is .947 during

that span. **TALK 2 'EM:** RHP **Kade Morris** has started to find his stride at the High-A level... Since his start on June 21 vs. Jersey Shore, the 22-year-old holds a 1-1 record with a sparkling 1.96 ERA (4 ER in 18.1 IP)...He has yielded just 11 hits and eight walks

vs. WILMINGTON: After a two-day break, Brooklyn travels south for a six-game series against the Nationals' High-A affiliate...The Blue Rocks boast three of Washington's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP Jarlin Susana (10), OF Jeremy De La Rosa (23), and INF T.J. White (25)... The Cyclones took 4-of-6 from Wilmington in the first meeting on Coney Island (April 23-28), but the Blue Rocks swept the season-opening series at Frawley Stadium (April 5-7) winning the last two games in walk-off fashion... Brooklyn was 9-9 at home and 7-5 on the road against the 'Rocks in the 2023 for a 16-14 record...Since 2021, the Cyclones are 46-44 all-time against Wilmington (.511).

(10.67%) while striking out 19 (25.33 K%)...Since June 20, Morris and RHP **Jonah Tong** have been two of the best arms in the South Atlantic League...In that span, Tong is second in the circuit in ERA (0.56) and Morris (1.96) is eighth...Tong and Morris are also first (25) and tled for seventh in strikeouts (19), respectively...Additionally, Kade is third in innings pitched (18.1), sixth in batting average against (.169), and seventh in WHIP (1.04)...Since making his SAL debut on May 22, Morris is fourth in the league in batting average against (.223), tied for fourth in innings pitched (42.0), seventh in WHIP (1.24), and eighth in ERA (3.86).

MORABITO FUEL: OF Nick Morabito has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The 2I-year-old is tied for 10th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (36)...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito is third in the circuit in stolen bases (25), tied for third in hits (57), and eighth in runs scored (36)...On the year, the former second-round selection is ninth in the league in batting average (.282) and stolen bases (25)...The 2I-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.314), on-base percentage (.415), and stolen bases (36)...He is also second in hits (38), tied for second in runs scored (50), tied for fourth in triples (4), and fifth in OPS (.819) and walks (41).

OMAR-I-GONE: OF Omar De Los Santos rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still sixth in the South Atlantic League with 29 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT Jaylen Palmer's (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (66) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos has led the South Atlantic League (66) and is fifth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (138) in swiped bags (138).

ZILCH, ZERO, NADA: RHPs Kodai Senga (2.2 IP) and Kade Morris (6.1) combined on a four-hit shutout, as the Cyclones blanked the Renegades, 4-0, last Wednesday...A night before, RHPs Jonah Tong (5.0 IP), Ben Simon (3.0), and Jake Stevenson (1.0) combined on a two-hitter in a 7-0 triumph vs. Hudson Valley...Cyclones pitching threw 20.1 consecutive scoreless innings between OF Garrett Martin's solo home run in the eighth inning on July 1 and DH Omar Martínez's three-run blast in the first inning on July 4...Brooklyn's longest scoreless stretch of the year is 23.2 frames from June 1-5 at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park... The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively...Brooklyn now has 10 shutouts, the second most by a South Atlantic League pitching staff in 2024 trailing only Rome (13)...It is also tied for fourth most throughout Minor League Baseball...The Cyclones' single-season shutout record is 11 set during the 2023 campaign.

LOCATION, LOCATION: The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024...0F Nick Morabito loves his time on the road...He is hitting .317/.407/.429 with a .836 OPS, adding two home runs, eight RBI, and 23 stolen bases in 31 road contests...He is third in the circuit in road batting average (.317) and, since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old has had the most road hits (40) and stolen bases (23) in the circuit...In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .224/.289/.250 line with a .539 OPS, two extra-base hits, two RBI, and two stolen bases over 18 games...INF Junior Tilien has thrived at Maimonides Park, posting a .309/.366/.455 mark with a .821 OPS, three home runs, and 14 RBI in 31 games... On the road, Tilien is hitting 172/.270/.246 with a .516 OPS, a home run, and seven runs batted in over 34 contests...C Chris Suero is hitting .250/.418/.442 with a .860 OPS, three home runs, and 11 RBI in 16 games on Coney Island...The 20-year-old is batting .173/.297/.245 with a .542 OPS, a home run, and 12 RBI in 28 affairs in visiting ballparks.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to Baseball America and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have five of the Top 30 per BA: INF Jesús Báez (9), RHP Jonah Tong (15), RHP Kade Morris (23), RHP Jack Wenninger (26), and Calvin Ziegler (29)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list and Ziegler is on the full-season injured list...Plus five of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (20), Báez (22), Ziegler (23), Wilfredo Lara (24), and OF Nick Morabito (26).

**LAST TIME OUT:** Earned his third win at the High-A level last Tuesday night vs. Hudson Valley...Did not allow a run on one hit over 5.0 innings...Walked two and struck out seven...Tossed 88 pitches and 57 strikes (64.77%)...Relieved by RHP **Ben Simon** to start the top of the sixth inning with Brooklyn leading, 6-0...Tong, Simon (3.0 IP), and RHP **Jake Stevenson** (1.0) combined on a two-hit shutout, as the Cyclones blanked the Renegades, 7-0.

**PROSPECT RADAR:** Tong is considered the New York Mets' No. 15 prospect in 2024 according to *Baseball America* and No. 20 by MLB Pipeline...The 20-year-old is the consensus highest-rated pitching prospect on the Cyclones' roster.

**THE TONG SONG:** Over his last three starts since June 20, the 21-year-old is 2-0 with an 0.56 ERA (1 ER in 16.0 IP), allowing only five hits and six walks (10.0 BB%), while striking out 25 (41.67 K%)...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native leads the circuit in strikeouts (63)...He is also tied for second in batting average against (.194), third in ERA (3.02), and fifth in WHIP (1.22)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 60.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is third in FIP (2.18), fifth in strikeout rate (36.3%), eighth in strikeout-to-walk rate (26.0%), and tied for 10th in strikeouts (99).

**JONAH'S WHALE OF A START:** The 21-year-old earned his first High-A and South Atlantic League victory on May 26 vs. Hudson Valley, tossing a career-high 6.2 innings of one-run ball...The 6.2 innings of work is the longest by a Brooklyn starter this year...It was the longest start by a Cyclone since RHP **Jordany Ventura** tossed 6.2 innings of one-run, one-hit ball in a win vs. Aberdeen on August 9, 2023...The 20-year-old's stretch of innings to start the year without allowing an earned run came to a close on May 8 at Rome at 26.0 frames.

**2023:** After he did not pitch in 2022 after being drafted, Tong started the campaign and made his professional debut in the Florida Complex League...Registered an 0-1 record with a 6.39 ERA (9 ER in 12.2 IP), 13 walks, and 25 strikeouts in seven appearances (five starts)...Transferred to Single-A St. Lucie on August 22...Composed an 0-1 mark with a 5.40 ERA (5 ER in 8.1 IP), nine walks, and 13 strikeouts in three starts...Returned to the FCL Mets on September 7.

**TRAVELING MAN:** A native of Canada, Tong's journey to professional baseball has included a lot of travel...After attending Bill Crothers Secondary School in Unionville, Ont., Tong moved on Georgia Premier Academy in Statesboro, Ga. for his final high school season... Prior to the 2022 draft, Tong participated in the MLB Draft League as a member of the Frederick (Md.) Keys...Accumulated an O-1 record with a 10.80 ERA (14 ER in 11.2 IP), 10 walks, and 14 K's in four outings (three starts)...Was a teammate of Aberdeen's RHP **Zach Fruit**, teammate RHP **Jonathan Pintaro**, and former Cyclones and current Double-A Binghamton RHP **Jordan Geber**, whose rotation spot he took...He was also committed to North Dakota State University before signing his professional contract.
