LAST TIME OUT

The Bowie Baysox walked off the Altoona Curve by a 5-4 final in 10 innings at Prince George's Stadium on Friday night. Down 4-3 heading into the bottom of the tenth, Billy Cook tied the game up on an RBI single to right-center. After a TT Bowens infield single, John Rhodes singled in the winning run with a fly ball off the bottom of the left field wall to score Cook. The Orioles No. 23 prospect delivered the first walk-off win of the season for Bowie in the team's first extra-inning game of the season.

SEASONING FROM BEYOND THE WALL

The Curve sport a well-seasoned roster to open 2024, with 20 players who share previous Double-A experience with Altoona. The Curve are 4-4 to open the series after taking three of five from their opening home series against Harrisburg last week. Altoona's roster includes seven of the Pirates' top 30 prospects (two Top 100), per MLB Pipeline - LHP Anthony Solometo (No. 4/No. 75), RHP Bubba Chandler (No. 5/No. 85)), RHP Thomas Harrington (No. 6), RHP Braxton Ashcraft (No. 7), IF Tsung-Che Cheng (No. 9), OF/1B Jase Bowen (No. 20), OF Tres Gonzalez (No. 27).

TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

RHP Braxton Ashcraft is set to get the ball tonight for Altoona. The 24-year-old right-hander returns for his second season with Altoona in 2024 after an impressive opening stint at Double-A last year. The Pirates No. 7 prospect posted a 1.35 ERA in eight Double-A starts last season, striking out 23 batters over 20 innings while allowing only five walks. Ashcraft, who is on the Pirates 40-man-roster, recovered from Tommy John surgery in 2022 and possesses a mid 90s fastball with a sharp slider, curveball, and changeup.

TAKE ME HOME, COUNTRY RHODES

After starting out the season just 4-for-30 at the plate, OF/1B John Rhodes put together his best game of the season at the plate last night, going 3-for-4 with a double, walk and the game-winning RBI single in the 10th to win the game for Bowie. It's the first three-hit game for the Orioles No. 23 prospect since August 10, 2023 at Richmond. Rhodes also leads the team in walks with nine.

TERRY HITS TATERS

OF/1B TT Bowens is off to a solid start in his second season at Double-A. The 25-year-old first baseman leads the league in slugging percentage (.722), is tied for the league lead in RBI (14), second in the league in OPS (1.147) and is fourth in total bases (26). The Connecticut native is also on a 10-game on-base streak, which is tied for the longest active streak in the league with Dylan Beavers and Portland's Marcelo Mayer.

LEAVE IT TO BEAVERS

OF **Dylan Beavers** is swinging the ball well in his second stint with the Baysox. The Orioles No. 7 prospect extended his on-base streak to ten consecutive games on Thursday, which is tied for the longest active on-base streak in the league with TT Bowens and Portland's Marcelo Mayer. During this on-base streak, Beavers is slashing .368/.444/.526 with 14 hits in 38 at-bats. The 2022 firstround pick hit his first homer of the season on Tuesday in the first inning.

BASALLO BLASTS

Orioles No. 2 prospect and No. 17 overall prospect (MLB Pipeline) Samuel Basallo hit his first Double-A homer on Tuesday with a line drive shot in the seventh to put Bowie ahead for good. The 19-year old is coming off a monster season in 2023 where he finished fifth amongst Orioles minor leaguers in batting average (.313), and on-base percentage (.402), and second in slugging (.551) and OPS (.953) across three levels. Basallo took home MVP honors in the Single-A Carolina League last season, after hitting .299 with 12 home runs in 83 games.

READY, FREDDY

IF Frederick Bencosme has enjoyed his start to life in Double-A. Bencosme has hits in nine of his first 12 Double-A contests, including six multi-hit contests. Although his six-game hit streak ended yesterday, the middle infielder is still batting .354 (17-for-48) with two homers and 10 RBI and has only struck out six times. Only 21 years old, Bencosme was signed by the Orioles as an international free agent out of Moca in the Dominican Republic in August of 2020.



Arsenal: 4-Seam FB, Curveball (best secondary), Slider, Changeup Ranked the Orioles No. 16 prospect, via MLB Pipeline Enters second season with Baysox

2023: Began first full season in minors in High-A Aberdeen. Made 22 appearances (18 starts) and struck out 127 batters in 82.2 innings. Led IronBirds in strikeouts. Finished four in South Atlantic League in strikeouts. Punched out a career-high 10 batters in just 3.1 innings in 2023 season debut against Wilmington. Posted a 5.04 ERA in the first half but pitched better in second half of season, posting a 3.55 ERA with 62 strikeouts over 38 innings. Earned promotion to Double-A Bowie on August 22. Made Double-A debut on August 26. Struck out five over four scoreless innings against Erie on the road. Went at least four innings and struck out at least four batters in each of his first four Double-A appearances. Completed first Double-A stint with a 2.12 ERA in 17 innings over 20 strikeouts.

2022: Debuted professionally with FCL Orioles. Assigned to Single-A Delmarva on August 27. Struck out three over three shutout innings in Delmarva debut against Lynchburg. Finished first professional season with a 1.86 ERA in 9.2 innings.

College: Pitched three seasons at Auburn. Best season was his junior year in 2022 where he struck out a career-high 94 batters in 80.2 innings over 18 appearances (17 starts). Led team in starts, innings and strikeouts. Was only Auburn pitcher to start all 17 weekends of the season. His 94 strikeouts were fourth most by an Auburn pitcher since 2000. Helped Auburn reach Men's College World Series and earned the win in Tigers first CWS win since 1997.

Personal: Drafted in the 5th round of the 2022 MLB Draft by the Baltimore Orioles out of Auburn. Highest drafted pitcher signed by Baltimore that year after not coming to terms with third round pick Nolan McLean. Full name is Bob Ike Bright. Grew up an Orioles fan because he has family that lives in Havre de Grace.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

CHESAPEAKE BAYSOX

On Sunday, May 26, the Bowie Baysox will take the field as the "Chesapeake Baysox." This alternate identity was created to celebrate and learn about the conservation of the nearby Chesapeake Bay. The uniform tops are detailed with stencilized outlines of local wildlife, design, and architecture around the Chesapeake Bay.

In addition to activities around Prince Geroge's Stadium promoting the conservation of the Chesapeake Bay, the jerseys will be auctioned off following the May 26 contest, with proceeds benefitting the Chesapeake Bay Foundation.

BOWIE PIT BEEF

The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Bowie Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland. The Baysox will take the field as the Bowie Pit Beef on both June 23 and August 4.

Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s

Manager

The 17th manager in Baysox franchise history, Mercado spent each of the past two seasons as the manager of the High-A Aberdeen IronBirds. He was honored with the Orioles organization's Cal Ripken, Sr. Player Development Award following his first season with Aberdeen in 2022. Prior to the start of his professional career, Mercado spent 17 years on the coaching staff at New Britain High School in Connecticuthe began as an assistant coach in 2004 before being promoted to head varsity coach in 2011. In addition to coaching the New Britain baseball team, Mercado served as the Dean of Students for over 18 years. He also spent Itime as an assistant coach of the Yarmouth Dennis Red Sox in the Cape Cod Baseball League from 2014-2022 and was a coach in the Goodwill Series, where high school baseball players from the United States competed overseas in both Australia and New Zealand in 2017 and 2018.

Pitching Coach

Meine has also worked on staff at the Premier Pitching and Performance facility in Missouri. He pitched collegiately at Lindenwood University.

He played three seasons in the Independent Frontier League following a collegiate playing career at Saint Louis University.
