LRST TIME OUT

Charlotte, NC (May 18, 2023) - The Scranton/Wilkes-Barre throttled the Charlotte Knights 17-4 Friday evening at Truist Field. The RailRiders hit six home runs, bringing their series tally to 18 over four games, en route to scoring a season-best 17 runs.

Scranton/Wilkes-Barre jumped on Charlotte starter Daniel Ponce de Leon in the top of the first. With one out and Oswald Peraza at first, Elijah Dunham doubled to right. Clint Frazier mishandled the ball on the warning track, allowing Peraza to score to open the scoring. Kole Calhoun worked a 3-1 count before hitting a 392-foot blast for a 3-0 lead.

The RailRiders plated six runs in the second to build a 9-0 advantage. Jesus Bastidas hit his fourth home run of the season to extend the lead to 5-0. After Calhoun singled in a pair of runs, Franchy Cordero's first home run with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, a 391-foot shot with an exit velocity of 112.7, ran the margin to nine runs.

The Knights scored a run on three hits off RailRiders starter Tanner Tully in the bottom of the second on three singles, but Peraza hit his first home run of the series to build a 12-1 edge. It was the 16th of the series for the Scranton/Wilkes-Barre, matching the six-game series mark set last season at Omaha in August. Leading 12-2 after three, the RailRiders scored once in the fourth on an RBI-single by Peraza and once again in the fifth without the benefit of a base hit.

In the sixth, Estevan Florial and Peraza went back-to-back for a 16-2 lead. Florial's was his fourth of the series and his eighth of the season. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre added another run without the benefit of a base hit in the seventh to cap their night; 17 runs on 17 hits by the time the game ended. Victor Reyes and Yolbert Sanchez hit solo home runs for Charlotte in the eighth and ninth innings, respectively.

Tully (3-1) pitched five innings with five strikeouts for the win, allowing two runs on seven hits. Ponce de Leon (1-4) surrendered the first nine runs and took the loss. Seven of nine players for Scranton/Wilkes-Barre had at least one hit and eight out of nine in the lineup scored at least one run. Peraza led the RailRiders with five runs batted in, while Calhoun drove in four over the first two innings. Both Florial and Peraza each finished with four hits over five at-bats and walked once apiece.

NEWS & NOTES

HOMER HEAVEN- Last night, the RailRiders hit six homers to total eighteen in the series thus far. This was their second game this week launching a half a dozen homers in one contest. SWB has homered more in one week in four games they then have in any other series, topping the 16 they hit last season against Omaha. Andres Chaparro leads the team after hitting his 11th of the summer, placing him 6th in the International League. The team is now first homers hit in all of Triple-A with Albuquerque dropping to second with 70 hit this summer. SWB is also first in long balls in all of Minor League Baseball and fourth in all of baseball. Tampa Bay leads the way with 87 in 47 games.

RUN SCORING RAMPAGE- The last time SWB scored 15 or more runs was on April 28, 2022 versus Lehigh Valley. The RailRiders have plated 14 runs three different times this season, but have not gotten past that. With their 17 runs in yesterday's win the team has now plated 232 runs this summer. They have only allowed 213 to cross on their watch.

STARTERS STAYING IN- The RailRiders have really been able to rely on their starters the past two weeks. Starters have surpassed relievers now for innings pitched for the team, totaling 193 frames and lowering their cumulative earned run average down to 5.13. Not counting Luis Severino in rehab, the team has compiled 14 straight starts from six different pitchers of at least five innings or more with three earned runs or fewer.

WINNING WAYS- SWB has now matched their highest win streak of the season with four straight wins in a row for the second time this summer. The RailRiders have not won more than four games in a series so with a win today or tomorrow could mark their fifth victory in one week. Scranton/Wilkes-Barre is also one game under .500 for the first time this month. They have not had an even record since they were 7-7 in the middle of April.

PITCHING TOGETHER- The starters and relievers have combined for a 4.41 earned run average putting them sixth in the International League. The bullpen's twelve save ranks them tied for third in the IL with Greg Weissert having four of them.

WHO'S ON FIRST- The RailRiders have had six different first basemen this season. Billy McKinney leads the way with fifteen starts, while Andres Chaparro has made twelve starts there. Mickey Gasper and Jake Bauers have also played their hands at first base this season. Last night, Rodolfo Duran played his first ever professional contest in the corner infield position. Every defensive player at first, except Gasper, has made at least one error in the position. Carlos Narvaez, in just his third Triple-A contest, got his initial start at first.

ANOTHER YEAR DOWN- On May 4, Andres Chaparro turned 24 years old and the RailRiders will celebrate five more birthdays to come this May. Mitch Spence turns 26 on 5/6. Deivi Garcia turns 24 on 5/19. DJ Snelten turns 31 on 5/29, while Elijah Dunham turns 25 the same day. Matt Bowman turns 32 on 5/31.

ATOP THE YANKS FARM - The RailRiders will showcase top prospect Elijah Dunham (#16 per MLB prospect rankings in the Yankees system) in his first Triple-A season. Will Warren (#7), Randy Vasquez (#12) and Sean Boyle (#28) are set to be essential parts of the starting rotation after also making their debuts with Scranton/Wilkes-Barre.

SHIPPED OUT, SHIPPED IN: The Yankees traded Ken Waldichuk, JP Sears and Hayden Wesneski prior to the 2022 trade deadline, all SWB pitchers. When Sears was traded he was slated to pitch on August 2 for the RailRiders. With those moves, Mitch Spence was called up from Somerset (Double-A) to make his Triple-A debut.

DAY GAME EXPERIENCE: Mitch Spence threw five games during the day last season. His record is 1-1 with a 6.49 ERA in 18.2 innings. He's allowed three home runs. In games beginning before 5PM, he has had 13 walks and 15 strikeouts.

CHANGE IT UP, LITERALLY: At USC-Aiken, Spence only threw a fastball and a slider. He now throws five pitches after spending over three years in the system (view repertoire right). He says he feels "like (he's) completely changed what kind of pitcher (he is)."

PERSONAL/CAREER:

- 2022: Combined with Double-A Somerset and Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre to go 6-7 with a 4.70 ERA (130.1IP, 138H, 73R/68ER, 42BB, 127K, 17HR) in 27 games (25 starts)...ranked among Yankees farmhands in games started (tied for third) and strikeouts (sixth)
- Became a starter in 2021, spending the entire season in Hudson Valley and posting a 3-4 record and 5.29 ERA over 23 appearances. His 20 starts, 105 IP and 118 K led the Renegades.
- Worked solely as a reliever in 2019 with Pulaski, making 16 appearances out of the bullpen, tying for 2nd on the team, going 3-2 with a 3.54 ERA, 4 saves and 29 K over 28.0 IP.
- Attended the University of South Carolina-Aiken, where he started out as solely a reliever with all 16 of appearances coming out of the bullpen as a freshman in 2017. After posting a 7.56 ERA that year, Spence became a starter for the final two seasons (2018-19) of his college career, starting 28/31 appearances. He set career-best college marks as a sophomore with a 3.03 ERA and 117 strikeouts.
- Born in Kirkland, WA, claims Cary, NC as his hometown.
- Attended Green Hope High School in Cary, where he became the school's all-time leader in ERA and saves.
- Avid Carolina Hurricanes fan. Grew up a Seattle Mariners and Seahawks fan, Ken Griffey Jr. his favorite player.
