LUG-NOTES

Streaking: Jake Reinisch enters today on a 40-game on-base streak, batting .301 with a .459 OBP and a .526 slugging pct. during the streak, with 40 base hits and 37 walks. It is the longest active streak in the minors behind only Jose Cerice's 46-game streak for Quad Cities. The longest in MLB history was Ted Williams' 84 games (July 1-Sept. 27, 1949).

Roll Call: The Lugnuts have suited up 54 different players this year, 26 position players and 28 pitchers (plus one scoreless inning from Gunner Gouldsmith).

Diametrically Opposed: The Nuts have lost 13 of their last 16 road games while winning 13 of their last 16 home games.

No Place Like Home: The Lugnuts lead the Midwest League in fewest strikeouts at home (464, 7.9/game), ranking 3rd in home OBP (.370), RBIs (338), and walks (331), and 4th in runs (359, 6.1/game). The Nuts have hit 50 home runs in 59 home games, compared to a league low 32 homers in 65 games on the road.

Two for the Price of One: The Lugnuts lead all of High-A in turning double plays, 120. Fort Wayne is in second with 112 double plays.

Moving On Up: The Lugnuts have seen above-average roster movement, with 18 players moving to the upper levels of the minors...

- 2026 Nuts Ryan Magdic, Jake Garland, Devin Taylor and Davis Diaz have reached Triple-A Las Vegas.
- Nathan Dettmer, Jay Dill, Steven Echavarria, Jackson Finley, Ben Hansen, Blaze Pontes, Zane Taylor, Logan Sauve, Bobby Boser, Ali Camarillo, Jared Sprague-Lott, Nate Nankil and Pedro Pineda are with Double-A Midland.
- Kyle Robinson was traded to Pittsburgh, then swapped again to the Angels at the deadline; he is now with Double-A Rocket City.

Welcome Back, Z! Pitcher Chen Zhong-Ao Zhuang tossed two innings on Sunday in an MiLB rehab appearance. The Taiwanese right-hander, affectionately nicknamed "Z Man," posted a 2.56 ERA in nine appearances spanning 31 2/3 innings with the Lugnuts in 2024, with a remarkable 3:29 BB:K ratio. He spent all of 2025 in Double-A Midland (6-11, 4.08 ERA, 145 K in 145 2/3 IP) and was added to the A's 40-man roster entering 2026. But Zhuang landed on the 7-day IL from May 4-30 and was designed for assignment on July 31, going back on the Injured List (right elbow) on August 6.

Major League Lugnuts: Ten former Nuts have made their MLB debuts this season: Daniel Susac for the Giants, Junior Perez for the White Sox, Eduardo Rivera for the Red Sox, Jack Weisenburger with the NY Mets, and Henry Bolte, Gage Jump, Kade Morris, Joshua Kuroda-Grauer, Tommy White and Yunior Tur for the Athletics. In all 48 Lugnuts have appeared in a Major League game this season.

Playoff Perspective:

- While the Lugnuts and TinCaps play out the string, the Great Lakes Loons are up 1.5 games in the Midwest League East Division on West Michigan and 2.5 games on Lake County entering the day. The division champion will face the Dayton Dragons in East Division Final.
- In the California League, Stockton (31-30) trails Fresno (32-29) by 1.0 game for the final remaining North Division playoff berth.
- In the Texas League, Midland (28-30) trails first place Amarillo (34-24) by 6.0 games.
- And in the PCL, defending champion Las Vegas (32-26) is already in the postseason after winning the first half and is now waiting to see whom it will play in the championship series.

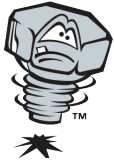

SEPTEMBER 2 IN LUGNUTS HISTORY

2013: The Lugnuts wrapped up the season with a 61-78 record, scoring eight runs in the bottom of the sixth to beat the West Michigan Whitecaps, 9-4.

2015: Rehabbing Blue Jays ace Marcus Stroman pitched 4 2/3 hitless scoreless innings, striking out seven and walking one, but the Great Lakes Loons rallied for seven runs with two outs in the ninth, including a three-run homer by Justin Chigbogu ("shi-BAH-goo") to hand the Lugnuts a 7-4 loss at Cooley Law School Stadium.

2019: In the final game of the Lugnuts' 24th season, Sean Wymer tossed an 85-pitch (63 strikes) nine-inning complete game and Yorman Rodriguez, Otto Lopez and Griffin Conine all hit solo home runs in a 3-1 victory at Fort Wayne. The game lasted two hours and 14 minutes. Wymer allowed four singles, one run, one walk and two HBPs with two strikeouts.
