SECOND HALF PATS: The Somerset Patriots secured their second straight walk-off win, scoring three runs in the bottom of the ninth inning to win 4-3 on Roc Riggio's two-run single. Entering Friday, Somerset was 0-35 this season when trailing after eight innings. The Patriots have now won back-to-back games under that circumstance, improving to 2-35 when trailing after eight. On Friday, Somerset picked up its fourth win this season when being

out-hit, improving to 4-31 in such games.

THE ROC IS COOKIN': Roc Riggio ended his career-best four-hit performance on Saturday with a two-run walk-off single in the bottom of the ninth inning. Riggio became the second Patriot this week and fourth this season to amass a four-hit game (T. Hardman - 4/29 @RIC, S. Jones - 6/20 @NH, B. Jones - 7/3 @REA). Riggio is 8-for-19 (.421 AVG) during this week's series and leads the Eastern League this week with 7 RBIs, 4 2B and 5 XBH, while ranking T-2nd with 8 H, 5 R and 15 TB, 4th with a 1.289 OPS and 5th with a .789 SLG.

LET IT ROC: Since Riggio debuted in Double-A on 6/3, Riggio leads the EL with 8 HR and 16 XBH. Riggio is tied for the EL lead with 61 TB. Riggio also ranks second in RBI (23), tied for third in R (20), SLG (.592), seventh in OPS

(.931) and tied for eighth in H (29).

NEW SHADE OF INDIGO: Indigo Diaz threw 1.2 scoreless innings on Saturday to earn his team-best seventh win of the season and his second of this series. Since 5/11 @AKR, Diaz has thrown 20.1 IP over which he has allowed 6 H, 1 R, 8 BB and recorded 19 K. In this stretch, Diaz has posted a 0.44 ERA, a 0.69 WHIP and a .094 BAA. His 0.44 ERA since 5/11 is the second-best mark in the Eastern League among pitchers with 20+ IP (A. Magno - ERI, 0.38 ERA)

RAFA RAKES: Rafael Flores picked up his 25th multi-hit game of the season on Wednesday, continuing to lead the Patriots in that category. He has collected multiple hits in eight of his last 15 games, dating back to 6/19 @NH, over which he is 21-for-57 (.368/.424/.667) with 9 R, 11 XBH (8 2B, 3 HR), 14 RBI, 7 BB, and a 1.091 OPS. In this stretch, Flores has collected a hit in 12 of the 15 games played. Flores is tied for the Eastern League lead with 37 XBH and ranks 2nd in with 153 TB, 88 H, 53 RBI and 23 2B.

2025 SOMERSET PATRIOTS COACHING STAFF

RAUL DOMINGUEZ: Manager (3rd year)

Raul Dominguez enters his third consecutive season as manager for the Somerset Patriots, 11th overall as a manager and 19th coaching in the Yankees organization. He led the 2023 Patriots to a Double-A best record of 84-53 and a +211 run differential, which ranked first among all MiLB teams. Under his leadership, the Patriots finished with the Eastern League's top record in both halves of the season and clinched their second straight playoff berth. In 2024, Dominguez led the Patriots to their third consecutive playoff berth and their second appearance in the Eastern League Championship Series with an overall record of 75-62. Dominguez's Patriots erased a 6.0-game deficit in the final 30 games of the regular season by going 22-8 to end the campaign and clinching the Eastern League Northeast division's second half title with a second half record of 43-25. Before joining Somerset, Dominguez spent the prior two seasons (2021-2022) as a defensive coach for Triple-A Scranton/Wilkes-Barre. He previously served as defensive coach for Trenton (2018-2019) and Tampa (2017). He gained prior managerial experience with the GCL Yankees East (2016), DSL Yankees 1 (2011-15) and DSL Yankees 2 (2009-10). An outfielder during his playing career, Dominguez spread four minor league seasons for with the Yankees between the DSL and the GCL. He began his coaching career in 2008 with the DSL Yankees 2, after spending 2007 as a Yankees' tryout scout in the Dominican Republic.

MIKE FRANSOSO: Hitting Coach (1st year)

Hitting coach Mike Fransoso enters his first season as a Double-A coach in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past five years as a member of the Seattle Mariners organization, most recently with the Double-A Arkansas Travelers as the team's hitting coach. On 8/13/24, Fransoso took over as the Travelers' interim manager and led the team to clinch a second-half playoff berth en route to winning the 2024 Texas League Championship. He also previously served as the hitting coach for High-A Everett (2023), Class-A Modesto (2022) and the AZL Mariners (2021). During his playing career, Fransoso played for the Somerset Patriots in 2018 and 2019 when the team was independent. Prior to his stint playing for the Patriots, he spent three seasons in the Pittsburgh Pirates organization after being a 27th round pick of the team in 2013 MLB Draft out of the University of Maine.

PETER LARSON: Pitching Coach (1st year)

Pitching coach Peter Larson enters his first season in Somerset and with the Yankees organization. He spent the past six seasons as a member of the Minnesota Twins organization, including the last two with the Triple-A St. Paul Saints (2023-2024). For Minnesota, Larson also previously served as the pitching coach for Double-A Wichita (2022) and Low-A Fort Myers (2019). In 2020, he was slated to be the pitching coach for Low-A Cedar Rapids, before the Covid cancellation of the minor league season. His first season with the Twins, he served as the minor league rehab pitching coach (2019). Prior to his professional career, Larson worked as a pitching coach at the collegiate level for Fordham University (2018) and the University of Albany (2017). He also served as an assistant coach for Siena College (2016) and King University (2015).

DEREK WOODLEY: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Derek Woodley enters his first season in Somerset and his third with the Yankees organization. He spent the last two seasons as the defensive coach for High-A Hudson Valley (2023-2024). Following the 2024 season, he represented the Yankees at the Arizona Fall League as an extra coach for the Salt River Rafters. Prior to joining the Yankees organization, Woodley spent 30 seasons as a college baseball coach, racking up over 300 wins and most recently as the head coach for Defiance College for 15 seasons from 2008-2022. He also served as the school's athletic director from 2019-2022.

UZIEL VILORIA: Defensive Coach (1st year)

Uziel Viloria enters his first season in Somerset and in the Yankees organization. He began his coaching career in 2024 as a coach in the Phillies organization. During his playing career, Viloria signed with the Phillies as an international free agent in 2019 and went on to play 112 games in four seasons as an infielder in the organization (2019-2023), making it as high as High-A Jersey Shore.

Began season on Somerset 7-day IL, activated by Patriots on 5/16 after a two-game rehab stint between the FCL Yankees and Single-A Tampa.

2024

Assigned to Double-A Somerset to start the 2024 season without any pitching experience at any level of the Yankees minor league system. Named Eastern League Pitcher of the Week after his 3rd career start on 4/19/24 vs. HFD: 7.2 hitless IP, before being lifted at 100 pitches in a scoreless game. Patriots won 1-0 on a Ben Rice leadoff, walk-off home run in the bottom of the ninth inning for a 1-0, one-hit win (Kevin Stevens allowed only hit to next batter after Vrieling left game). Named the Eastern League Pitcher of the Month for April following his first month of professional baseball with Somerset. First four career starts, Vrieling ranked among the Eastern League leaders with a 1.88 ERA (4th), 0.75 WHIP (1st) and .145 BAA (3rd).

2022-23

Did not pitch following the 2022 MLB Draft, Yankees shut him down and put him on a weight-training and diet routine to become stronger. After being drafted at 195 pounds, Vrieling put on weight to become 230 pounds. Spring Training of 2023, he sustained a stress fracture in his pitching elbow and wound up spending the entire 2023 regular season on the 60-day Injured List. Started ramping up in July through September 2023, but by the time he was able to pitch, the regular season had ended. Made professional debut pitching for the Mesa Solar Sox in Arizona Fall League, after missing all of 2023 regular season with stress fracture in pitching elbow (5 GS: 10.2 IP with 15 K, 6 BB and a 5.06 ERA).

College

Appeared in 42 games over three seasons at Gonzaga from 2020-2022, going 5-7 with a 4.31 ERA and 178 strikeouts in 137.2 innings. Vrieling worked primarily out of the bullpen his first two seasons, including in 2021 when he made 20 of his 22 appearances in relief and was a WCC All-Conference Honorable Mention. In 2022, he transitioned to the starting rotation, when he went 4-4 in 15 starts.

Personal Notes

Born in Lewiston, ID and moved to Kennewick, WA when he was 5-years-old. Attended Kamiakin High School (WA), where he took basketball more seriously than baseball to begin with. As a senior on the mound, he posted a 0.56 ERA with 63 strikeouts in 55 IP and was named MCC Pitcher of the Year and First Team pitcher. Averaged 15 PPG on the hardwood in HS, then stopped playing as a junior, after he broke his ankle. Played basketball growing up with Hall of Famer John Stockton's son and Anton Watson (former Gonzaga star, now on the Knicks). In high school, pitched against fellow Yankees farmhand Trent Sellers, who attended his rival school (Kennewick).

Career Notes

Selected by the Yankees in the 3rd round of the 2022 MLB Draft, signing on July 25, 2022 for a slot value bonus of \$611,400. Ranked by MLB.com as the No. 71 Draft prospect in 2022.
