TODAY'S GAME: The Curve are in the midst of their 25th anniversary season, continuing a 6-game set with Erie.

LAST TIME OUT: Altoona dropped their July 4th matchup, 6-4, to Erie. Matt Gorski homered twice in the defeat.

MULTI-MATT: Outfielder Matt Gorski became the fifth different player this season to swat two homers in a game this season on Tuesday, July 4, joining Andres Alvarez, Henry Davis, Mason Martin and Liover Peguero. These times in team history the Curve have had seven different players record a multi-homer game in a season, last done so in 2005.

PEGUERO IS LEA-OH-VING: Infielder Liover Peguero was promoted to Triple-A following Altoona's game at Harrisburg on July 3. In 69 games with Altoona this season (210 total), Peguero batted .260/.333/.453 with 20 2B, 1 3B, 11 HR and 34 RBI with 19-22 SB. His 32 Extra base hits ranked 4th in the Eastern League at the time of his promotion and he ranked 8th with 74 hits.

MASONRY: First baseman Mason Martin homered in three straight games at Harrisburg beginning on Friday, June 30. It is the fourth time in his career that he's homered in three consecutive games, he previously homered in five straight games while playing for Greensboro in April of 2019 and homered in four straight games for Altoona in July of 2021.

THE BIG LEFTY: Altoona welcomed lefty Anthony Solometo to their roster on Saturday, June 17 and he promptly struck out seven in 5.0 innings in his Double-A debut at Somerset. <u>At 20 years, 6 months and 15 days, he is the 2nd-youngest player in</u> the Eastern League behind Somerset's Jasson Dominguez (20 years, 4 months and 10 days), however, Solometo struck him out three times in their matchups on June 17. Solometo has a 1.20 ERA in 3 starts for the Curve, tossing 11.0 consecutive scoreless innings. His 18 strikeouts since his debut rank 4th in the Eastern League. He leads all Pirates minor leaguers with a 2.08 ERA and 86 strikeouts.

JUNE SWOON: Altoona finished off the month of June with an 11-15 record, a month in which they were 9th in team batting average and 10th in team ERA. Liover Peguero led the Curve with 7 home runs in 24 games during June with a .969 OPS and a .308 average. On the mound, **Nick Dombkowski** turned in his finest month of the campaign with a 2.04 ERA (4 ER/17.2 IP) in 6games, 2 starts.

OUR NEW LEADERS: Diamond Baseball Holdings (DBH) announced its intent to acquire the Curve from long-time owners Joan and Bob Lozinak on Wednesday, June 28. Mr. Bob and Joan who brought the team in Altoona to begin play in 1999 owned the team for 18 of their 25 years as a franchise.

NEED A CLUTCH KNOCK: The Curve are last among Double-A teams when batting with a runner in scoring position at two outs, hitting just .194.

FATHER ABRAHAN: In place of the promoted Henry Davis, Altoona welcomed C Abrahan Gutierrez to the roster for their series at Richmond. Gutierrez has reached base safely in 16-of-21 games played. Altoona catchers have a .805 OPS this season, good f<u>or 5th-best among Double-A teams this season.</u>

STRIKEOUTS ARE ALL THE RAGE: Throughout the 2023 season, Altoona has been one of the league's most-difficult teams to strike out. Entering play on Tuesday, July 4, Altoona has struck out 602 times, still the fewest among Double-A teams and 5thfewest in minor league baseball.

THE 'WOLVES OF THE SEA: Managed by Gabe Alvarez, the SeaWolves host several top prospects according to MLB Pipeline: No.4 RHP Wilmer Flores, No. 5 RHP Ty Madden, No. 8 INF Wenceel Perez, No. 14 C Dillon Dingler, No. 15 RHP Dylan Smith, No. 21 LHP Brant Hurter, No. 25 RHP Tyler Mattison, No. 26 RHP Austin Bergner, No. 28 INF Gage Workman, No. 29 INF Danny Serretti and No. 30 RHP Keider Montero.

A WOLF TOSSER: Ty Madden takes the ball tonight, looking to bounce back from his last start against Altoona on April 15 when he lasted just 1.0 inning and walked 3 with 3 strikeouts. Madden faced Altoona on 9/9/2022 and struck out 5 in 4.0 innings, allowing 2 unearned runs. The 32nd overall pick in the 2021 draft out of the University of Texas, Madden attended Cypress Ranch HS where Orioles prospect Colton Cowser patrolled Center Field and White Sox prospect Matthew Thompson (2nd round, 2019) shared the pitching staff.
