Reading continues its final home series, and penultimate series, of 2023 with a visit from the Portland Sea Dogs. Reading leads the season-series 11-8 over Portland after taking two-of-three from the Sea Dogs in July and four-of-six in Portland at the end of June. The teams will resume last night's suspended game in the top of the fourth, down 5-0. Then play a seven-inning second game after the first game concludes.

Reading and Portland split a doubleheader Friday night. Reading won the first game 5-2, thanks to home runs from Carlos De La Cruz, Baron Radcliff and Madison Stokes. David Parkinson pitched 4.2 innings in the resumption in his ninth win and Orion Kerkering earned his sixth save. Portland took the second game 6-0 as Reading was shut out for the fourth time this season and were held to just three hits.

Vlick Abel stayed hot with six-shutout innings Wednesday night. Over his last three starts (dating back to Aug. 23) Abel is 1-0 with a 1.00 ERA, with just five hits allowed and 15 strikeouts. He owns a WHIP of 0.72 and opponents are hitting just .091 against Abel. After last night, Abel qualities for a variety of Eastern League leaderboard ranks: ERA (10th), Strikeouts (T10th), BAA (1st) and WHIP (4th).

Diver Dunn matched a season-high Wednesday night with three walks. He has now reached base in 15-straight game. He now has 80 walks on the eason, which puts him in sole possesion of first place in the Eastern League in walks. Dunn also has the following Eastern League ranks is various ther categories: AVG (4th), HR (T5th), RBI (T2nd), OBP (1st), SLG (2nd), OPS (1st), Hits (T5th), 2B (2nd), 3B (T4th), XBH (1st), TB (2nd) and Runs (T6th).

Orion Kerkering picked up his sixth Double-A save Friday night, as he threw a scoreless ninth inning. Kerkering has now converted on his last six save oppurtunities and hasn't allowed a run in his last six outings and 13 of his last 14. Dating back to July 26 (14 apppearneces) Kerkering is 6/6 in saves, with a 1.29 ERA and 18 strikeouts.

The Phillies beat the Marlins last night 8-4 as Kyle Schwarber hit his 42nd home run of the season. Lehigh Valley fell 3-2 to Buffalo last night as Matthew Kroon tripled. The IronPigs sit one game back of Durham with 13 games to play. Jersey Shore split a doubleheader last night with Hudson Valley. The BlueClaws trail Brooklyn by one game heading into the seaosn's final time. Jersey Shore must win and have Brooklyn lose to make the playoffs. Clearwater fell to Palm Beach 9-8 and begin their postseason next week after today's regular season finale.

September 10, 2015: At Binghamton, the Fightin Phils and B-Mets are rained out after less than an hour rain delay and with radar showing clearing skies. ELDS Game 2 would be pushed back a day.

Portland enters tonight with a 29-32 record in the second half, which is third in the Northeast Division and six-games back of Binghamton. Overall, the SeaDogs are 69-61 after narrowly missing out on the first half title. Last week, Portland won two-of-six against Somerset and close the regular season against Hartford at home next week. Portland has the following Red Sox top prospects on its team: Marcelo Mayer (1), Roman Anthony (2), Kyle Teel (4), Nick Yorke (6), Wikelman Gonzalez (9), Blaze Jordan (12), Nathan Hickey (15), Angel Bastardo (16) and Chase Meidroth (20).

Hunter Dobbins will get the start for Portland today in the second game. He made his Double-A debut against Reading on June 23 in Portland and earned the win, allowing just one run over five innings. Overall, Dobbins is 5-5 with a 4.52 ERA over 11 games/10 starts for Portland (61.2 IP, 64 H, 24 BB, 64 SO). He pitched last Sunday against Somerset, earning the win, while allowing three-earned runs over 5.1 innings, with four strikeouts. He began the season with High-A Greenville, where he went 4-1 with a 2.63 ERA over seven starts. Dobbins spent all of 2022 with Single-A Salem and was 0-5 with a 5.22 ERA over 17 starts. Boston drafted him in the eighth round of the 2021 draft out of Texas Tech.
