### **Leading Off**

Tonight, the Reading Fightin Phils continue a six-game series at home against the Harrisburg Senators. It is the fourth of 12 matchups between the teams this season; one series in Reading and another series in Harrisburg from Aug. 22-27. In 2022, the Fightin Phils went 4-8 against the Senators, including dropping five-of-six games at home in April and split the six-game series in Harrisburg in August.

#### **Looking Back**

Harrisburg scored seven runs, all with two outs in the top of the ninth, after trailing 5-2 to win 9-5. Brett Schulze allowed six-earned runs in the inning to suffer the loss. Offensively, Nick Podkul had a three-run homer and double, while Johan Rojas added a double and triple.

### **Shutout Streak**

Through 41 games this season, Reading has yet to be shut out. The Fightin Phils are one-of-two teams in double-A (Arkansas) and one-of-11 in all of Minor League Baseball who have yet to be blanked. Reading's pitching has also not yet thrown a shutout this season either.

#### Elite Defender

Johan Rojas continues to play elite defense in center field for the R-Phils. He has two outfield assists on the season, which leads Reading outfielders. Rojas has nine defensive runs saved this season, which is tied for the most amongst minor league center fielders.

### A Look at the Bullpen

In wins, Reading's bullpen has been flat-out dominant, posting a 2.39 ERA over the Fightin Phils' 15 wins. In Reading's 26 defeats this season, the bullpen has posted a 7.56 ERA. In innings 1-5 of games, Reading has a +20 run differential, but it's -40 in innings 6-9 of contests.

#### Gettin' On Base

Both Nick Podkul and Carlos De La Cruz have been on-base machines as of late. Podkul has now reached base in 13-straight games and De La Cruz in 12 consecutive. Reading's season-high on-base streak in 2022 was 21 games from Logan O'Hoppe.

### Around the Organization

The Philadelphia Phillies fell to the Atlanta Braves last night 8-5 to open a weekend series. Lehigh Valley fell to Buffalo 12-2 to drop to 23-24 on the season. Jersey Shore had a 5-2 win over Aberdeen to improve to 20-19 on the year. Clearwater and St. Lucie's matchup was suspended in the first inning last night and will be resumed tonight, before a doubleheader tomorrow with the Mets and Threshers.

#### This Day in Baseballtown History

May 26, 2008: At Binghamton, the R-Phils rally for three in the top of the 9th to beat the Mets, 8-7. Down to the final out, Mike Eylward draws a bases-loaded walk to force in the tying run. Michael Spidale follows with a 2-run single to provide the go-ahead and insurance runs.

### Coming from the Capital

This is the first series of the season between Reading and Harrisburg, The Senators sit alone in first place in the Eastern League Southwest standings at 22-19 on the season. Last week, the Senators split a six-game series at home against Erie, winning the last two games like the R-Phils. Next week, Harrisburg stays on the road for a six-game series at Bowie.

### On the Hill for Harrisburg

Righty Jackson Rutldege gets the start tonight for the Senators. In 2023, he is 4-1 with a 2.72 ERA over seven starts. Rutledge has 37 strikeouts and 14 walks allowed over 39.2 innings. Against Bowie 12 days ago, he went six innings, and allowed two hits and no runs, with five strikeouts. The Nationals 11th-ranked prospect spent all of 2022 with single-A Fredericksburg, going 8-6 with a 4.90 ERA over 20 starts.
