## YESTERDAY'S RECAP

The Chesapeake Baysox dropped their Saturday night contest with Akron by a 5-1 score. The Baysox managed four hits on Saturday, with the lone RBI coming on a sacrifice fly from Adam Retzbach. Right-hander Alex Pham made his first start for the Baysox since late April, allowing a pair of runs in four innings and striking out four. Felow righty Levi Wells tossed three innings of relief for the Baysox, allowing three runs (two earned), but setting a career high with eight strikeouts. The loss was the tenth in a row for Chesapeake.

## **ROAD RETZ**

After enduring an 0-for-24 and 1-for-29 stretch entering play Thursday, C/1B **Adam Retzbach** has gone six for his last 10 and reached base seven times over the past three games. Friday night, Retzbach finished a triple shy of the cycle and tallied his fourth three-hit game of the season and the fifth such game of his professional career. Retzbach has been one of the Baysox best hitters in 2025 - particularly away from home. On the road this season, Retzbach is hitting .309 with an .888 OPS (both 4th in the EL - min. 150 PA). 13 of Retzbach's 16 doubles and 18 of his 28 extra-base hits have been on the road this season.

## SMOOTH LIKE BUTTER

IF **Brandon Butterworth** has adjusted to his new scenery just fine. Part of the return in the Ryan O'Hearn/Ramon Laureano trade, Butterworth has reached base in his first seven games since joining the Orioles organization and immediately being promoted to Double-A. Butterworth had the sixth-most extra-base hits (35) and most triples (7) in the Midwest League during his time with High-A Fort Wayne (SD).

## **SOMEWHERE OVERN THE RAINBOW**

OF **Austin Overn** made his Double-A debut with Chesapeake on Tuesday afternoon. Overn leads the Orioles farm with 47 stolen bases this season between High-A and Dobule-A, after swiping three bags on Thursday. Overn hit safely in each of his first three games with the Baysox. Friday night saw his 19-game on-base streak, dating back to his time with Aberdeen, end. During that streak, Overnhit .328, with a .455 OBP and a .996 OPS.

## **BULLPEN TROUBLES**

The bullpen has been one of the strengths for Chesapeake in 2025, posting a 3.39 ERA. However, Baysox relievers have struggled as of late. In the last 10 games, the Chesapeake bullpen has allowed 26 earned runs accross its last 40 innings (6.08 ERA - 2nd-highest in Double-A).

## **CLOSE GAMES AND FREE BASEBALL**

Chesapeake has won 21 games in one-run fashion - which is the most in the Eastern League and is the second most in all of Double-A. Chesapeake has 11 extra inning wins, which is the most in full-season MiLB. The Baysox have played 38 one-run games this season, which is second-most in all of Double-A.

## WHERE THE RUBBER MEETS THE ROAD

The Akron RubberDucks - Double-A affiliate of the Cleveland Guardians, currently sit at 19-19 in the second half and third in the Southwest division. This comes after the RubberDucks narrowly missed out on the first half title. Akron is led by the 2024 No. 1 overall pick Travis Bazzana (No. 13 OVR prospect, per MLB.com). This is the back-half of a two-week homestand for Akron, who split with Erie last week. The Baysox enter with the third-highest road winning percentage (.571) in the league this season.

## TODAY'S OPPOSING STARTER

Right-hander Dylan DeLucia is set to start for Akron on Sunday. DeLucia pitched for the RubberDucks on Tuesday against Chesapeake, tallying 5.1 scoreless innings with two hits allowed, despite walking four batters. It was the third start for DeLucia of at least five shutout innings in his last four starts. DeLucia was a sixth round pick of the Guardians in 2022 out of Ole Miss. He played for the Surprise Saguaros in the Arizona Fall League this past offseason, where he was managed by Baysox skipper Roberto Mercado. DeLucia was also teammates with Doug Hodo and Creed Willems.

Traded from Toronto to Baltimore on July 31, 2025 while Fisher Cats were visiting Baysox at Prince George's Stadium

2025: Struck out six in 4.0 innings but allowed 6 R (5 ER) on 6 H and 2 BB in Baysox debut on 8/3 vs NH. T-11th in MiLB in K (121). Acquired by Orioles from Blue Jays in exchange for RHP Seranthony Dominguez on 7/31. Walked along Prince George's Stadium concourse to Baysox clubhouse after hearing he had been traded since Fisher Cats were visiting Baysox that week coincidentally. At time of trade, T-2nd in TOR system in K (115) and 6th in IP (89.0). Started season in High-A Vancouver. In eight starts, recorded a 3.62 ERA in 37.1 IP with 62 K/12 BB. Departed High-A as the team-leader in Ks (62) and T-2nd in IP (37.1) and starts (8). Promoted to Double-A New Hampshire on 5/20. In 11 starts, posted a 3.48 ERA over 51.2 IP with 53 K/26 BB. Delivered first Double-A quality start in just his second Double-A outing on 5/30 @ HFD. Fanned a Double-A high eight batters in 4.2 IP on 6/18 vs SOM. Tossed longest pro outing on 7/25 in final Fisher Cats start with 7.0 IP vs HFD, his first win since June 5.

2024: Split first full season in minors between Single-A Dunedin and High-A Vancouver...Led Blue Jays system in K (131), BB (60) and 6th in IP (103.0). Went 3-5 in 12 starts for Dunedin with a 3.43 ERA, allowed 22 ER in 57.2 IP with 74 K to 29 BB and a 11.5 K/9 ratio... Boasted a 2.91 ERA in June with 7 ER and 23 K across 21.2 IP, including 9 K in 6 IP vs Single-A Daytona on 6/19... Assigned to Vancouver on 6/30 and made his first start on 7/4 @ High-A Everett... Went 1-6 for the C's with a 6.35 ERA in 9 starts...Struck out 5+ batters in each of his 9 starts for High-A Vancouver...

Career Notes: Did not pitch in '23 upon being drafted.

College: Spent two seasons at Long Beach St. before transferring to Oklahoma State in 2023. Suffered a shoulder injury during senior year of HS and redshirted freshman year at Long Beach St. Threw the first complete game no-hitter in LBSU program history on 5/8/22 vs UC Riverside with 16 Ks, one K shy of the single-game program record. Named a Freshman All-American and Honorable Mention All-Big West Conference in 2022. At Oklahoma State in '23, his 124 total strikeouts were the most in the Big 12 and were the 10th most by a Cowboys pitcher in a single season. His 13.55 K/9IP ranked 6th in the NCAA. Oklahoma St. head coach is Josh Holliday, uncle of former Baysox and now current Orioles INF Jackson Holliday.

**Personal**: Drafted by the Blue Jays in the 3rd round of the 2023 Draft out of Oklahoma State. Native of Visalia, Calif. A three-sport athlete in high school, playing quarterback in football, basketball and baseball all four years at Hanford High School (Calif.)...

For select home games, the Chesapeake Baysox will take the field as the Chesapeake Oyster Catchers as a tribute to the Chesapeake Bay's rich heritage and thriving ecosystem.

Inspired by the American oystercatcher, the prominent patterned shorebird can be found along the Chesapeake Bay year-round. With its bold black-and-white plumage, orange beak, and knack for hunting shellfish, the oystercatcher is a symbol of strength and ingenuity—qualities that define both the Chesapeake region and its passionate baseball fans.

The Oyster Catchers name also pays homage to the Chesapeake Bay's rich maritime traditions and oyster restoration efforts, celebrating the region's deep connection to its waters.

## **CANGREJOS FANTASMAS DE CHESAPEAKE**



The Cangrejos Fantasmas De Chesapeake (Chesapeake Ghost Crabs) are a part of MiLB's "Copa de la Diversión™" or "Fun Cup™"- a season-long event series specifically designed to embrace the culture and values that resonate most with Minor League Baseball™ teams' local U.S. Hispanic communities.

Boasting a desire to better represent the Chesapeake Bay area, Bowie's "Cangrejos Fantasmas de Chesapeake" identiy came to light after research presented the existence of the small, yet active Atlantic Ghost Crab species in the bay.

## **BOWIE PIT BEEF**



The "Bowie Pit Beef" is an alternate identity of the Chesapeake Baysox that pays tribute to the culinary culture of Maryland.



Pit Beef consists of top round cuts of beef, thinly sliced and prepared over a charcoal fire. The meat is cooked quickly at high temperatures and has a slight smoked flavor. The sandwich got its name on Baltimore's east side in the 1970s, before being popularized by the 1980s.
