THIS DATE IN HISTORY

On June 10, 2016, The Sounds and Oklahoma City Dodgers played at Chickasaw Bricktown Ballpark. Nashville scored one in the third, two in the fourth, three in the fifth, and four in the sixth en route to a 10-0 win. Chad Pinder, Bruce Maxwell, and Jaycob Brugman all homered in a 15-hit effort. Dillon Overton tossed six scoreless innings in the win.

Tonight's Game: The Nashville Sounds and Norfolk Tides play game four of the series tonight at First Horizon Park. Norfolk has won the first three games in the series, including a doubleheader sweep last night. Right-hander Caleb Boushley goes for his seventh win for the Sounds, facing left-hander DL Hall.

Caleb Boushley: 28-year-old Caleb Boushley starts for Nashville this evening. The right-hander is 6-2 with a 3.53 ERA (58.2 IP/23 ER) in 11 starts this season. He earned his third straight win in his last outing on June 3 at Durham. Boushley allowed just two runs on three hits and three walks in 7.0 innings, striking out two. The Hortonville, Wis. native spent most of 2021 with Triple-A El Paso, going 3-8 with a 5.85 ERA in 16 games (15 starts). He was drafted by the Brewers in the Triple-A Phase of the 2021 Rule 5 Draft from San Diego. Boushley was originally drafted by San Diego in the 33rd Round of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of the University of Wisconsin at La Crosse.

DL Hall: 23-year-old DL Hall starts for the Tides tonight. The left-hander is 1-1 with a 4.57 ERA (21.2 IP/11 ER) in six starts for Norfolk this season. He also went 0-1 with a 4.91 ERA in one start for Double-A Bowie in 2022. Hall picked up his first Triple-A win in his last outing on June 5 vs. Jacksonville. He yielded a couple of runs on two hits and two walks, striking out nine. Hall is currently rated as the No. 5 prospect in the Orioles system, according to MLB Pipeline. He went 2-0 with a 3.13 ERA in seven starts with the Bowie Baysox last season. The lefty was selected by Baltimore in the First Round (21st Pick) of the 2017 MLB First-Year Player Draft out of Valdosta (GA) High School.

Superlatives: Yesterday the Sounds fell to 26-7 when scoring first...18-9 at First Horizon Park...9-7 against left-handed starters...28-9 when scoring 4+ runs and 4-17 when getting out-hit by the opponent.

Comfortable at the Top: With a current five-game losing streak, the Sounds enter play today with half-game lead over second place Columbus in the International League West Division standings. Nashville took over first place the night of May 4 with a win vs. Norfolk. The team has spent the last 36 days in first place.

Wisconsin's Finest: Tonight's starter, Caleb Boushley, enters play among International League leaders in innings pitched (58.2, 2nd), wins (6, T-2nd), batting average against (.218, 4th), WHIP (1.11, 5th) and ERA (3.53, 6th).

June Swoon: After leading the International League in ERA in the months of April (2.61) and May (3.60), the Sounds pitching staff is last in the league with a 7.31 ERA (64.0 IP/52 ER) in the month of June.

Outstanding Otero: Andy Otero tossed 5.0 scoreless innings in relief on Wednesday, allowing a couple walks while striking out three. The lefty has a 1.23 ERA (14.2 IP/2 ER) and is holding opponents to a .047 average (2-for-43) since joining Nashville in mid-May.

The Nashville List: Last Friday's win for Rick Sweet was his 181st as manager of the Nashville Sounds. It's the sixth-most managerial wins in franchise history. Pete Mackanin is fifth on the list with 186 wins.

He Gets On Base: Jonathan Davis has reached base safely in a team-best 21 consecutive games. During the 21-game streak, Davis is hitting .301 (25-for-83) with 14 runs, 5 doubles, 3 home runs, 10 RBI, 15 walks and 6 stolen bases. It's the 4th-longest active streak in the International League.

Earn It: Despite the recent June struggles, the Nashville pitching staff still leads Triple-A with a 3.68 ERA. Indianapolis checks in with the second-best ERA at 3.98.

How Sweet It Is: Sounds manager Rick Sweet is in his third season overall and second consecutive season at the helm of the Nashville club. Sweet led the Sounds to a 70-58 record in 2021 and a 77-67 record in 2014. He has served as the manager for Milwaukee's Triple-A club since the 2014 season.

The Future Brew Crew: Nashville has four players on the roster who are listed on MLB Pipeline's Top-30 Milwaukee prospects. Infielder Brice Turang is the No. 4 prospect, catcher Mario Feliciano is the No. 20 prospect, right-handed pitcher Alec Bettinger is the No. 22 prospect and right-handed pitcher Dylan File is the No. 24 prospect.

AGAINST OPPONENT: Boushley's last (and only) appearance against Norfolk came on May 5 at First Horizon Park. In a no decision, he allowed three runs (all earned) on seven hits and a walk in 4.2 innings. Boushley threw 82 pitches in the outing with 50 strikes.
