**TONIGHT'S GAME:** Good evening and welcome to LoanMart Field, as the Quakes host the Lake Elsinore Storm (SD) in game two of a brief three-game set. Tonight, fans will enjoy post-game Fireworks. Get tickets at rcquakes.com.

**VS THE STORM:** This is the 23rd of 30 match-ups and the eighth of 15 here at LoanMart Field during the regular season. The Quakes are 8-14 against the Storm in 2024, 5-2 here at home, but 3-12 at The Diamond. Last season, the Quakes won the season-series (17-13), going 11-7 here at home.

**LAST GAME:** The Storm raced to an early eight-run lead in the second inning, then went on to dominate in a 15-5 win over the Quakes on Friday night at LoanMart Field. A sold-out crowd of more than 4,800 fans saw an eight-run second, highlighted by a grand slam from Jacob Campbell, put the Storm ahead to stay. Rancho starter Alex Makarewich (0-3) was charged with six runs on six hits, while recording just three outs. Lake Elsinore's Wyatt Hoffman had four hits and four RBIs, while Storm reliever Will Varmette (3-2) got the win with two perfect innings of relief. Rancho's Sean McLain (4) popped a two-run homer, while Jose Meza and Wilman Diaz each recorded an RBI hit. The loss for the Quakes brings a two-game winning streak to an end and moves them into a three-way tie for first in the South.

**SERIES WIN!:** The Quakes won five of six in last week's series against Stockton, marking their first series win since they took four of six from Inland Empire in the opening days of the second half. It's the second series win they've taken from Stockton this year, after winning three of four at LoanMart Field in the opening home stand of 2024.

**MCLAIN NAMED PLAYER OF WEEK:** Sean McLain was named the league's Player of the Week this past Monday, after destroying Stockton pitching last week. In six games, McLain hit .538 (14-for-26) with two homers and ten RBIs, and an OPS of 1.575. McLain is hitting .299 in 20 second-half games, after only hitting .148 in 32 games in the first half. He enters this series with an average of .211 with three homers and 23 RBIs over 52 total games in 2024.

**FUTURE BOYS:** A former Quake and a current Quake participated in last Sunday's annual All-Star Futures Game in Arlington Texas, a 6-1 victory for the National League. 2023 Quakes catcher Thayron Liranzo (0-for-1 with a walk) and 2024 Quakes infielder Jeral Perez (1-for-2 with a run scored) came off the bench while representing the Los Angeles Dodgers. Liranzo, who's currently in the High-A Midwest League playing for the Great Lakes Loons, is ranked as the Dodgers' eighth best prospect, while Perez is ranked 17th.

**LUKE FOX:** Left-hander Luke Fox makes his fifth appearance for the Quakes and second against the Storm. In his lone outing against the Storm, he allowed one run on two hits over four innings in a no-decision on June 29. Fox joined the Quakes in late-June from the Arizona Complex League, where he was 0-0 with an ERA of 0.00 over four games (two starts). He allowed just one unearned run on six hits with one walk and seven strikeouts over seven innings of work. In his last start overall, he allowed one hit with three walks and six strikeouts over three scoreless innings in a no-decision at Stockton on July 12. Fox was a 17th-round selection out of Duke in the 2023 draft.

**TOM COSGROVE:** Padres' left-handed reliever Tom Cosgrove will make his first appearance for the Storm, as part of a Major League rehab assignment. Cosgrove has been on the Injured List since June 16 with a left hamstring strain. For the Padres this season, he's 0-1 with an 11.66 ERA over 18 games and 14.2 innings pitched. The 2017 12th-round pick of the Padres pitched for Lake Elsinore in 2019, going 1-4 with a 6.21 ERA across six starts and 29 innings. Cosgrove is expected to go just one inning tonight and then be backed up by originally scheduled starter Miguel Mendez. Mendez will be making his 15th appearance (14th start) and his fifth against Rancho. Against the Quakes, he's 0-0 with a 3.00 ERA across four starts, allowing four runs on ten hits over 12 innings.
