**YESTERDAY:** The Flying Squirrels held off the Hartford Yard Goats, 4-3. **Brandon Martorano** opened the scoring with a two-run triple in the bottom of the second inning and later scored on a double by **Jacob Heyward** to give Richmond a 3-0 lead. Hartford scored its first run in the third on a groundout. **Frankie Tostado** bounced into a bases-loaded double play to bring home a run in the third and extend the Flying Squirrels' lead to 4-1. The Yard Goats closed the score to 4-2 in the top of the fourth with a sac fly by Aaron Schunk. Ezequiel Tovar closed the gap to one with an RBI double in the eighth, but **Chris Wright** got a strikeout to strand the bases loaded. Hartford loaded the bases again in the ninth, but **Ryan Walker** entered from the bullpen and got a groundout on his first pitch to end the game.

**TODAY'S GAME:** The Flying Squirrels play the third of a six-game series against the Hartford Yard Goats, Double-A affiliate of the Colorado Rockies. This series marks the only meetings between the two clubs this season. Richmond does not travel to Hartford this year. This series is also the first of the year for the Flying Squirrels against a team from the Eastern League's Northeast Division.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** lost four-of-six in last week's road series in Altoona, just their second series loss of 2022. The previous week, the Flying Squirrels won four-of-six at Harrisburg. The Flying Squirrels have won four series, lost two and split one this year. They won the season-opening set at Bowie from April 8-10, won their first home series against Altoona from April 12-17, lost a series at Erie from April 20-24, won five-of-six against the Baysox at home from April 26-May 1, split a home series against the RubberDucks from May 3-8 and won last week's road series against the Senators. Sunday's loss dropped the Flying Squirrels out of a tie at the top of the Southwest Division with Akron and back to second place. Richmond is now tied for second in the division with Erie, two games behind Akron.

**THE YARD GOATS** have won seven-of-their-last-nine games. They are currently in second place in the Eastern League Northeast Division, 1.5 games behind first-place Somerset. Last week in Bowie, they won five-of-six, including the final two games of the series on Saturday and Sunday at Prince George's Stadium. The Yard Goats are playing the back half of a two-city, 12-game road trip, which is tied for their longest this year. They will play a second 12-game road trip to Reading and Somerset from August 2-14. Hartford's roster features seven of MLB.com's top-30 Rockies prospects, including SS Ezequiel Tovar (6), OF Brenton Doyle (7), 1B Michael Toggia (8), 3B Aaron Schunk (19), RHP Noah Davis (26), RHP Gavin Hollowell (27) and RHP Karl Kauffmann (28).

**FOR RICHMOND:** Right-hander **Kai-Wei Teng** makes his ninth start of the season. He last pitched on Friday at Altoona and allowed career highs in hits (8) and runs (7) over 3.2 innings in a loss. After working five scoreless innings in his Double-A debut on April 9 at Bowie, Teng has allowed at least two runs in each of his last seven starts. He has allowed two-or-fewer earned runs in five of his eight starts. Teng spent the entire 2021 season with the High-A Eugene Emeralds, going 5-6 with a 4.33 ERA in 21 starts. For the season, Teng led the High-A West with 142 strikeouts, ranked tied for second with 21 games started, tied for first with one complete game and sixth with 95.2 innings pitched. He also ranked fourth in the Giants system in strikeouts. Teng was originally signed by the Minnesota Twins out of Taiwan in 2017. During his second season in 2018, he was traded to the Giants along with outfielder Jaylin Davis in exchange for right-handed pitcher Sam Dyson. **For more on Teng, see page two.**

**FOR HARTFORD:** Right-hander Michael Baird makes his second start of the season and his sixth overall appearance. He made his first start of the season on Friday at Bowie and pitched two scoreless innings with three strikeouts. On the year, he has pitched multiple innings in four-of-his-five outings, twice throwing three innings (April 20 and April 24, both against Somerset). Baird was selected by the St. Louis Cardinals in the 23rd round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Southern Illinois. He was released by the Cardinals during the canceled season on May 27, 2020 and signed with the Rockies entering the 2021 season. Last year, he made 12 appearances, including three starts for the Yard Goats and went 1-3 with a 7.27 ERA.

**LOPSIDED:** On the year, the Flying Squirrels have the worst run differential in the Southwest Division at -26 runs. In their last 11 losses dating back to April 27, the Flying Squirrels have fallen by an average of 7.0 runs. Of those 11 losses, four have been by 10-or-more runs, including a 10-0 shutout to the Baysox on April 27, a 12-1 loss at Harrisburg on May 15, a 12-2 loss at Altoona on May 17 and a 19-8 loss on Sunday at Altoona, which tied the franchise record for runs allowed in a game. Richmond has scored two-or-less runs in six of their last 11 losses. On the other hand, the Flying Squirrels' last 14 wins in the same time frame have come by an average of 2.5 runs, including six one-run games.

**PACKING THE HOUSE:** This season, the Richmond Flying Squirrels are leading all of Double-A in average attendance (6,034) and total attendance (120,683). Richmond is 10th of the 120 MiLB teams in average attendance. The 9,810 fans at The Diamond on Opening Night is the largest crowd in all of Double-A this year and the largest of all non-Triple-A teams this season.

**POWER SURGE:** The Richmond offense has hit 50 home runs this season, which is second in the Eastern League behind Somerset (53). **Sean Roby** is tied for third in the league with nine homers on the season, with seven coming at The Diamond. Last year, the Flying Squirrels set a franchise record with 127 homers, surpassing the previous record of 109 from 2013. This year, the Flying Squirrels are on pace to hit 168 home runs.

**MARTY PARTY:** Over his last 11 games played since May 11, **Brandon Martorano** has hit .317 (13-for-41) with four homers, three doubles, two triples and 12 RBIs. On May 11 at Harrisburg, he clubbed the second grand slam of his career. He returned to the lineup two days later and lifted the Flying Squirrels to a 6-5 win in extras with a sac fly in the 10th inning. On May 14 at Harrisburg, he homered twice for the first time in his career, knocking a go-ahead, three-run homer in the sixth and a solo shot for an insurance run in the ninth inning. He added a solo homer in Sunday's series finale at Altoona. On Wednesday, he picked up a two-run triple with a ball that missed leaving the yard in dead-center by inches.

**SHANE TRAIN:** In the month of May, **Shane Matheny** is batting .329 (23-for-70) with five homers, four doubles, a triple and 15 RBIs. He has picked up a pair of two-homer games, one on May 1 at The Diamond against Bowie and another on May 12 at Harrisburg. They were the second and third multi-homer games of his professional career and his first since 2019. Matheny is currently riding a 10-game hitting streak dating back to May 14, during which he is batting .394 (13-for-33). On the season, he is ranked seventh in the Eastern League in OBP (.413), eighth in SLG (.538) and sixth in OPS (.951). He is also ranked eighth in wOBA (.419) and tied for eighth in wRC+ (164).

**TOASTY:** **Frankie Tostado** is batting .346 (37-for-107) with five homers, seven doubles and 17 RBIs over his last 17 games since April 22. From April 22-May 4, he posted a 10-game hitting streak, which was tied for the longest in the league this year at the time. On May 11, he tied a career high with four hits against the Senators. On the year, he has picked up at least one hit in 31 of his 37 games played. In the Eastern League, Tostado is ranked tied for first in batting average (.324), third in hits (47) and tied for fifth in total bases (72).

**IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS:** **Frankie Tostado** is ranked tied for first in batting average (.324), third in hits (47) and tied for fifth in total bases (72). **Sean Roby** is tied for third in home runs (9). **Shane Matheny** ranked seventh in the Eastern League in OBP (.413), eighth in SLG (.538) and sixth in OPS (.951). **Brandon Martorano** is 10th in SLG (.509). **Mike Gigliotti** is tied for eighth in stolen bases (10). **Ryan Walker** is first in wins (6) and **Solomon Bates** is tied for second (4). **Chris Wright** is tied for fifth in saves (4). **Jake Dahberg** is eighth in inning pitched (40.2) and tied for fifth in winning percentage (.667).

**WHERE THE GOATS RANK:** In the Eastern League, Ezequiel Tovar is ranked eighth in batting average (.314), tied for third in home runs (9), tied for sixth in RBIs (27), fourth in SLG (.582), fifth in OPS (.972), tied for first in hits (47), tied for first in extra-base hits (21), first in total bases (89) and tied for third in stolen bases (14). Willie MacIver is tied for fifth in home runs (8). Michael Toggia is ninth in RBIs (25). Issac Collins is seventh in stolen bases (11). Riley Pint is tied for first in games pitched (17) and PJ Poulin is third (16). Gavin Hollowell and Nick Kennedy are tied for fifth in saves (4).

**PROSPECT WATCH:** The Flying Squirrels have seven players ranked in *Baseball America's* Top-40 Giants prospects, including **Kyle Harrison** (2), **Will Wilson** (14), **R.J. Dabovich** (17), **Tyler Fitzgerald** (34), **Diego Rincones** (36) and **Kai-Wei Teng** (40). **Franklin Labour** is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Harrison is rated by *Baseball America* as having the "Best Slider" in the organization. MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospect list includes Harrison (2), Dabovich (17), Wilson (22) and **Brett Auerbach** (28).
