- The Blue Jays couldn't overcome an early-game deficit and dropped the first game of the series with Daytona, 6-2 on Tuesday.
- Cade Doughty, in the first at bat of his second rehab stint of the season with the D-Jays, poked an opposite field solo home run to right field in the top of the first to open the scoring.
- Daytona quickly erased the lead, scoring four runs on three hits and two errors in the top of the second to take a 4-1 lead.
- Jays' starter Jorge Bautista bounced back to retire six straight in the third and fourth, but surrendered two more runs in the fifth.
- Victor Arias got Dunedin back on the board with a two-out, RBI single in the seventh, but the Jays left men on the corners.
- Juanmi Vasquez and Jordan Powell each threw two scoreless innings out of the Jays' bullpen.

HELLO, JOEY

17-year MLB first baseman, six-time All-Star, and 2010 National League MVP Joey Votto joins the Dunedin lineup today on a rehab assignment. Votto suffered a severe ankle sprain during Spring Training after signing with Toronto on March 8. The Toronto native has logged two rehab games with the FCL Blue Jays, going 0-4 with an RBI and strikeout. Votto is MLB's active walks leader with 1,365, and his 356 home runs are third most among active players.

JUARON WHIFFS BROWN

Blue Jays starter Juaron Watts-Brown leads all of Single-A in whiffs, drawing 144 in 47 innings - an average of over 3 per frame. Watts-Brown's whiff rate is the fifth-best in Single-A among pitchers with over 400 pitches. Perhaps more importantly, Watts-Brown has walked just two batters in his last two-starts - his lowest amount in a two start stretch this season.

OFFENSIVE OUTAGE

After a 10-run outburst in Friday's win over Bradenton, the Blue Jays offense has slowed down. Across the last three games, Dunedin is hitting .144 with a .508 OPS and just four extra base hits.

REHAB CITY, USA

With Joey Votto's start today, Dunedin has now hosted 11 MLB/MiLB rehab players this season. Yesterday, infielder Cade Doughty rejoined the Jays' roster for his second rehab stint of the season and homered in his first at-bat. Notable rehabs include Alek Manoah, Damiano Palmegiani (AAA), and Riley Tirotta (AAA).

FIRST HALF FINISH

With two games remaining in the first half, Dunedin's record stands at 32-32. While eliminated from playoff contention, a win would clinch the Jays' best first half record since 2019, when the D-Jays went a whopping 41-24 in the FSL North. Dunedin went 32-34 in the first half last season.

MISTAKES AT A MINIMUM

Dunedin committed two errors last night, marking the first time in 14 games the Jays committed more than one. The Blue Jays committed just one error in last week's series with Bradenton. Dunedin's 58 errors are the third fewest in the FSL this season, and the team's .975 fielding percentage is second-best in the league.

SERIES SUCCESS

With Friday night's win, the Blue Jays clinched five straight sets with a split or better. Across that stretch, Dunedin has earned three splits and two series wins. Dunedin has split three of its last four series.

KAI'S KS

After struggling in May (8 app, 10.24 ERA, 9.2 IP, 14 BB), Kai Peterson has found his footing out of the Jays' bullpen in June. Across Peterson's last six outings, the lefty has struck out 28 batters in 12.1 innings of work. In his last three outings, he's struck out five or more without allowing an earned run.

DEFENDING HOME TURF

Dunedin has lost just one series at home this season: April 16-21 vs Clearwater. In five sets at TD Ballpark, the Jays have split three times and won twice.

TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

With Sunday's 4-3 loss, Dunedin has played 22 one-run games this season, going 10-12 in those contests. 43 of the Blue Jays 64 games this season (67%) have been decided by three or fewer runs. Dunedin has a 21-22 record in those games.

- Selected by the Blue Jays in the 3rd round of the 2023 draft out of Oklahoma State... Did not make pro debut in 2023.
- Grew up in Hanford, CA; located west of Visalia and south of San Jose. Same hometown as 1996 National League MVP Ken Caminiti.
- Throws a four pitch mix that features a low-90s fastball, slider, curve and changeup. Mid-80s slider has been considered his best pitch by scouts. Slider is occasionally identified as a cutter by Statcast does not throw a cutter.
- Was a three-sport star at Hanford High School... was the school's starting varsity quarterback and also played basketball.
- Was originally committed to Texas Tech out of high school, but Red Raiders pulled offer after a football injury suffered his senior year.
