JUMBO SHRIMP WINNING STREAK HALTED AT FIVE

Valente Bellozo fanned seven in 5.0 innings, but Indianapolis beat Jacksonville 4-1 on Thursday. The Indians started the scoring with back-to-back homers from Gilberto Celestino and Grant Koch in the second. Tristan Grav lashed an RBI double in the fifth to get the Jumbo Shrimp on the board, but that was their only source of offense throughout the night. In the sixth, Liover Peguero's solo shot made it 3-1. Indianapolis added to its lead in the ninth when Koch walked with the bases loaded to make it 4.1

STARTING FROM SCRATCH

Jacksonville starting pitchers have tossed scoreless outings in four of the last five games heading into play on Friday. During this stretch, Jumbo Shrimp lid-lifters have ceded only two runs, both earned, on 14 hits (5.9 H/9) in 21.1 innings for a 0.84 ERA. Jacksonville starters have combined for 17 strikeouts against seven walks during this stretch. Not coincidentally, the Jumbo Shrimp are 4-1 in this run.

GRIFFIN-DOR, WHERE DWELL THE BRAVE AT HEART

In eight games from April 26-May 5, Jacksonville outfielder Griffin Conine suffered through a 2-for-30 (.067) stretch with 12 strikeouts. In the 31 games since, however, the former Duke Blue Devil has gotten hot. Conine is 33-for-hislast-104, slashing .317/.415/.692/1.107 with six doubles, 11 home runs, 29 RBIs, 18 walks and 23 runs scored. He's homered in five of his last eight games entering play on Friday. Among the 126 qualified hitters in the IL, Conine ranks 10th in HR/FB (29.2 percent). The 26-year-old has has driven in at least one run in 19 of those 32 games, with multiple RBIs in eight contests.

ROAD IS WHERE THE HEART IS?

Jacksonville's 13-23 (.361) home record is the worst such mark in the IL, while the club's 17-13 (.556) road record is one of only seven winning away records in the circuit this year. On the road, the Jumbo Shrimp have scored 160 runs in 30 games (5.3 per game), more than a full run better than what they average at home (fifth-fewest) 140 runs in 36 games, 3.9 per game). The Jumbo Shrimp have surrendered 187 runs (12th-most in Triple-A) in 36 home games (5.2 per game) compared to 135 (third-fewest) on the road (4.5 per game).

FRIENDS CLOSE, ENEMIES CLOSER

A remarkable 43 of Jacksonville's 66 games (65.2 percent) in 2024 have been decided by three runs or fewer, including 25 of the club's last 35 contests. After beginning the year 12-3 (.750) in these narrowly-decided contests, the Jumbo Shrimp have suddenly struggled in games determined by no more than three runs; Jacksonville has lost 21 of its last 28 games decided by three runs or fewer for an overall record of 19-24 (.442) in these affairs.

X MARKS THE SPOT

In 2023, Xavier Edwards registered one of the most illustrious seasons in Jacksonville's Triple-A/Double-A history (1962-present). His .351 batting average was the best in club single-season history, with his .429 on-base percentage ranking second. After an injury scuttled the beginning of his season, Edwards has picked up right where he left off in 2024. The Coconut Creek, Fla., native has hits in 12 of his first 15 games with the Jumbo Shrimp, compiling a remarkable seven multi-hit contests. In all, he is 20-for-60, slashing .333/.375/.433/.808 with four doubles, one triple, three RBIs, four walks and four runs scored.

LITTLE GUY, BIG RESULTS

Over his first 11 games in Triple-A, Javier Sanoja was just 6-for-39 (.154) at the plate. However, the 5-foot-7 Venezuelan struck out in only two plate appearances. His contact ability has manifested itself in a huge way of late; Sanoja has reached base safely in 29 of his last 33 games, notching 15 multi-hit contests. During this span, he is 47for-132 (.356/.405/.523/.928) with 10 doubles, three triples, two home runs, 23 RBIs, 13 walks and 19 runs scored. Among the 216 IL hitters with at least 110 PA, Sanoja has posted the highest opposite-field rate (50.9 percent) and the fourth-lowest swinging-strike rate (4.0 percent).

SHRIMP BITES

Jacksonville's home run streak ended Thursday at eight games. It was their longest such streak since going yard in 13 straight contests from July 1-18, 2023... Over his last five starts, Max Meyer has posted a 4.86 ERA with 23 strikeouts (12.4 K/9) against nine walks in 16.2 innings. In his first three Triple-A starts, he had registered a 9.90 ERA with 11 strikeouts (9.9 K/9) against three walks in 10.0 innings.

ABOUT MAX

-Selected by the Marlins with the third overall pick of the 2020 draft, Meyer tied Hall of Famer Paul Molitor (No. 3 to the Milwaukee Brewers in 1977) as the highest pick in Minnesota Golden Gophers history. Meyer is one of four Minnesotans to be pick in the top five in the draft, along with Molitor, Joe Mauer and Dave Winfield. Prior to Meyer, the last time the Gophers had a pitcher taken in the first round of the MLB draft was left-hander Glen Perkins, who was selected 22nd overall by the Minnesota Twins in 2004.

-During his junior season at Minnesota in 2020, Meyer was tabbed as a consensus Preseason All-American and made four starts in a shortned season due to the pandemic. He finished fifth in the nation with 46 strikeouts and a team-best 1.95 ERA in 27.2 innings. Meyer has slashed .185/.214/.222 with one double, two runs scored, four RBIs and a stolen base while playing infield for the Gophers.

-As a sophomore in 2019, Meyer was named an All-Big Ten Second Team Selection. He made 16 appearances on the mound, including 11 starts, and went 5-3 with a 2.11 ERA and two saves 76.2 innings. He fanned a team-high 87 batters. Meyer also played in 35 games, including 30 starts, on the infield, batting .256/.323/.314 with four doubles, one home run, 12 RBIs and 15 runs scored.

-A native of Woodbury, Minn., Meyer played hockey at Woodbury High School, lettering for three seasons as a forward. He was selected by the Minnesota Twins in the 34th round of the 2017 draft, but opted to pitch collegiately at the University of Minnesota.

-Both of Max's parents, Kathy and Kent, played collegiately while attending St. Olaf College (Northfield, Minn.). Kent was a member of the Oles' football team while Kathy played on the school's women's soccer team.

2024 SEASON

-Optioned to Jacksonville on April 15.

2023 SEASON

-Did not pitch while recovering from Tommy John Surgery.

2022 SEASON

-Meyer made his major league debut for the Marlins on July 16 by throwing 5.1 innings with five strikeouts in a game against the Philadelphia Phillies at loan Depot park. He made two starts before undergoing Tommy John surgery on August 9.

-Meyer needed just 53 pitches (38 strikes) to strike out eight in 5.0 perfect innings before departing with a calf cramp on April 12 at Durham.

2021 SEASON

-Meyer was promoted to Jacksonville on September 23 from Double-A Pensacola. With the Blue Wahoos, he led Double-A South in both ERA (2.41) and batting average against (.226) while ranking second in both strikeouts (113) and WHIP (1.23) and fourth in IP (101.0).

-Meyer's 10 strikeouts in his Triple-A debut on September 24 against Memphis were the most for any Jacksonville pitcher in a level debut since at least 2005.

-Selected to the SiriusXM All-Star Futures Game, Meyer threw just seven pitches to two batters, getting Adley Rutschman (Baltimore Orioles) to fly out to left before walking Nick Pratto (Kansas City Royals).

ADDITIONAL CAREER NOTES

-Meyer competed for the USA Collegiate National Team in both 2018 and 2019. In 2018, he picked up seven saves with a 3.38 ERA in eight appearances, striking out a team-leading 15 batters in 8.0 innings. In 2019, he appeared in four games, including three starts, and recorded a 0.64 ERA across 14.0 innings with 12 strikeouts. He was named Outstanding Pitcher of the 2019 USA vs. Cuba International Friendship Series.
