- The Blue Jays pushed their win streak to six by taking the series opener in Bradenton Tuesday night, 6-4.
- Cristian Feliz opened the scoring with a 2-run home run in the top of the second inning.
- The lead grew to 4-0 with RBIs from Manuel Beltre and Edward Duran in the fourth inning.
- The Marauders scored their only run against Connor O'Halloran on a fourth inning solo homer. The lefty finished with a line of 5 innings, 4 hits, 1 ER, and 6 Ks.
- Bradenton got within one with a two-run seventh inning, but the Blue Jays scored in both the eighth and ninth innings to provide some cushion for an eventual two-run win.
- Jean Joseph went 2-5 to extend his on-base streak at 19, while Jays pitchers kept Esmerlyn Valdez off the bases, ending his on-base streak at 19 games.
- Blue Jays pitchers held Bradenton to 1-11 with runners in scoring position in the win.

### CALL IT EVEN

Last night's victory put the Blue Jays back at the .500 mark for the first time in nearly a month, when the team was 9-9 on April 25th. Dunedin dove as far as six-games below the .500 mark (13-19, 14-20).

### GOING STREAKING

The Blue Jays have won six games in a row for the second time this season, after winning six consecutive games following their opening day loss. Since the first six-game win streak, Dunedin picked up a nine-game losing streak from April 19-28.

### LATE MAGIC

Dunedin continued its trend of scoring late runs last night, scoring runs in the eighth and ninth innings. The Blue Jays have scored in the seventh inning or later in 13 straight games, and 17 of their last 18 games. The Blue Jays hold a +15 run differential in the final three innings this season (73 runs scored, 58 runs allowed).

### JAYS JUICE

With Cristian Feliz's two-run home run last night, the Blue Jays have homered in eight of their last nine games. Across that stretch, seven different players have gone deep. Dunedin is tied third in the Florida State League with 26 homers. Both Dunedin and Bradenton have homered 15 times this month - tied for the most in the league.

### STRONG FIRST IMPRESSION

Blue Jays outfielder Jean Joseph is off to a strong start in Single-A, having reached in all 19 games he's played with Dunedin. The on-base streak is Dunedin's longest streak of the season and now tied for the longest on-base streak in the Florida State League this year, as Esmerlyn Valdez's 19-game stretch was broke last night. Joseph is hitting .288 with a .905 OPS this month.

### SWING, BATTER BATTER, SWING... AND MISS

Juaron Watts-Brown struck out a season-high nine batters in his start last Wednesday, drawing a whopping 20 swings and misses, the most in all of Single-A on May 15. Watts-Brown's whiff rate of 39% leads the Blue Jays and is 12th in all of Single-A among pitchers who have thrown at least 200 pitches.

### TOO CLOSE FOR COMFORT

28 of the Blue Jays 40 games this season have been decided by four or fewer runs. Dunedin has an 13-15 record in those games. Each of the Blue Jays' last four wins have required saves.

### BACK IN THE SERIES WIN COLUMN

Last week's series victory was the Jays' first set win since April 9-14 at Tampa, when the team took five of six games. Dunedin's five game win streak is the team's longest since they won six straight from April 6-12.

### GAINING LITTLE GROUND

Despite winning five straight games last week, the Blue Jays made little progress in the FSL-West standings, as first-place Clearwater also won five games. However, with last night's win and Threshers loss, the Jays picked up a game in the standings and are situated 7 games back of first.

- Selected by the Blue Jays in the 3rd round of the 2023 draft out of Oklahoma State... Did not make pro debut in 2023.
- Grew up in Hanford, CA; located west of Visalia and south of San Jose. Same hometown as 1996 National League MVP Ken Caminiti.
- Throws a four pitch mix that features a low-90s fastball, slider, curve and changeup. Mid-80s slider has been considered his best pitch by scouts
- Was a three-sport star at Hanford High School... was the school's starting varsity quarterback and also played basketball.
- Was originally committed to Texas Tech out of high school, but Red Raiders pulled offer after a football injury suffered his senior year.
