SOD PODDLES TWO-DUT BARRAGE SINKS CARDS: The Amarillo Sod Poodles socred seven times with two outs to overcome an early three-run deficit as the Cardinals fell 9-6 on Saturday night at Hodgetown. Nathan Church went 4-for-5 with a home run and 3 RBIs and Chandler Redmond slugged a two-run homer, his 58th career with Springfield, one short of the franchise record held by Xavier Scruggs (59). Aaron McKeithan added three hits for Springfield, who has dropped three of the first five games of the six-game series in Amarillo.



DPPOSING STARTER: Right-hander Jamison Hill makes his third start of the season for Amarillo... Surrendered 7 R (all earned) on 9 H with 4 BB and 0 K in 3.1 IP in the series opener on Tuesday night... Allowed home runs to Jimmy Crooks and Matt Lloyd, back-to-back, in the 3rd inning...Spent all of the 2023 season with the Sod Poodles, going 7-6 with a 4.35 ERA, allowing just 95 hits in 118.0 IP but also walking 74 with 104 K...Opponents batted .218 against him...In two starts against the Cardinals in 2023 went 1-0 with a 3.60 ERA...Made his Double-A debut in 2022 when he went 1-0 with a 6.30 ERA in 5 appearances (4 starts)...Also made 21 starts at High-A Hillsboro (7-7, 4.35) and one appearance with Low-A Visalia in 2022...Signed by the Diamondbacks as a in July 2021 after going undrafted out of Fresno State...As a senior in 2021, went 5-3 with a 5.23 ERA in 12 starts...Led Bulldogs with 72.1 IP...Step-grandfather is Garry Templeton who was a two-time All-Star with the Cardinals (1977 & 1979)...Played with St. Louis from 1976-81 as part of a 16-year MLB career (3x All-Star, 2x Silver Slugger)...Also played for the Padres and Mets...25 years old

RED-HOT CARDS HEAD TO LONE STAR STATE TO TAKE ON DEFENDING CHAMPS: The Cardinals make their first trip of the season to Texas, starting a six-game series against the Amarillo Sod Poodles (Double-A, Arizona Diamondbacks) starting on Tuesday at HODGETOWN. Springfield went 5-7 in 12 games against the Sod Poodles in 2023.



CARDINALS CELEBRATE 20 YEARS IN SPRINGFIELD

The 2024 season is a special one at Hammons Field, as it represents the 20th anniversary of the return of Cardinals baseball to Springfield. The franchise moved to the Queen City of the Ozarks from El Paso in 2005 and boast one Texas League title in 2012 and two North Division championships (2007 & 2012) since. The first iteration of the Springfield Cardinals spanned from 1931-46, an era that saw the Redbirds bring home five league titles.





The Cardinals opened the season with a 9-game winning streak, the longest in franchise history.

REDMOND INCHING CLOSER TO SPRINGFIELD HISTORY: Cardinals slugger **Chandler Redmond** hit his 58th career home run with Springfield on Saturday night, bringing him to within one longball of the Cardinals' franchise record held by **Xavier Scruggs** (59). **Redmond** already holds the Springfield record for career RBIs with 202.

BIRDS' BATS TOP TEXAS LEAGUE EARLY: Springfield's lineup sits atop the league in several offensive categories. Through 11 games the Cardinals lead the Texas League with a .291 batting average, a mark that also leads all of Double-A; the Bowie BaySox are next with a .279 average. The Cards also lead the Texas League in OBP (.388), OPS (.800), RBIs (84) and runs scored (91). Springfield has also been particularly prodcutive hitting situationally, with a league-high 9 sacrifice flies this season.

WE'RE GOING STREAKING!: With a ninth-inning double on Satruday night, Cardinals utility man **Noah Mendlinger** extended his hitting streak to nine games. **RJ Yeager** had his 11-game hitting streak snapped with an 0-for-5,

GRINDIN': Perhaps the Cardinal offense's greatest attribute is their ability to grind out at bats. The Cardinals have struck out just 99 times in 14 games, the 2nd-fewest total in MiLB. The Fresno Grizzlies have K'd the fewest times in the minor leagues (97), but have also done it in just 12 games, two less than Spring-field. The Cards are averaging just 7.07 K's per game.

VICTIMS OF THE LONG BALL: Despite an overall solid season so far in which the Cardinal pitching staff has posted a 4.17 ERA, the Birds have fallen victim to the home run ball early in the 2024 season. Springfield pitchers have allowed 17 HR so far this year, second most in the Texas League behind the Amarillo Sod Poodles, who have allowed 19.

TAKE ME TO CHURCH: Cardinals outfielder **Nathan Church** has been on a tear to begin the seaosn. The UC Irvine product leads the Texas league in RBIs (15) and hits (21), and is in the top five in batting average (3rd, .362), HR (t5th, 3), total bases (t2nd, 31) and runs scored (t4th, 12). **Church** has hit safelly in 11 of his 12 games so far.

YEAGER BOMBS: Through his first 12 games, **RJ Yeager** finds his name littered across the league leaderboard in several run production categories. The Mississippi State product's 12 RBIs is tied for the 2nds in the Texas League and **Yeager** finds himself tied for 5th in home runs (3). He had a season-opening 11 game hitting streak snapped with an 0-for-5 showing on Saturday night.

TORRES AT TOP OF LEADER BOARD IN HITTING, BAGS: After going 1-for-3 on Friday night and leaving the game early with an apparent injury, Cardinals OF Bryan Torres is 1nd in the Texas League in batting average among qualified hitters with a mark of .381. His 7 SB is tied for 2nd in the league lead behind Jakob Marsee of the San Antonio Missions and Emmaunel Rodriguez of the Wichita Wind Surge. Torres racked up 71 bags for the Milwaukee Milkmen of the American Association in 2023. Torres is also tied for 3rd in the circuit in OBP with a mark of .462.

FAMILIAR FACES: Of the 28 players on the Cardinals' Opening Day roster, 13 donned a Springfield uniform in 2023. Of the newcomers, only two Cards, Bryan Torres (Richmond, 2021) and Matt Lloyd (Chattanooga, 2021-22), have Double-A experience. Slugger Chandler Redmond returns for another season in Springfield after coming up one home run shy of the Springfield franchise record in 2023 with 31 longballs. Redmond also sits two home runs shy of Springfield's franchise career record of 59 by Xavier Scruggs.




