FRES-NOTES

PEREZ, GRIZZLIES PINCHED BY STORM THURSDAY: The Fresno Grizzlies (13-20, 51-47) stumbled to the Lake Elsinore Storm (19-14, 51-46) 4-1 Thursday evening from Chukchansi Park. Fresno saw their three-game winning streak against Lake Elsinore come to an end, dropping just their second contest over their last nine home affairs versus the Storm. With the setback to open August, the Grizzlies have now moved to 0-5 (includes one double-header) on the first day of a month. Fresno has scored one run in two of those five games and have a -14 run differential overall. The Grizzlies offense scattered seven hits with two of them landing for doubles. Four of their two hits led off an inning, with only one run scoring. Ben McCabe smacked a leadoff single in the bottom of the third and trotted home on a Nolan Jones RBI single to center. Jones, who is on Rockies MLB Rehab, had the only multi-hit game and RBI for Fresno. Over three games with the Grizzlies, Jones has provided at least one RBI on two of his three hits. Tevin Tucker and Andy Perez each whacked doubles while Felix Tena extended his hit streak to six games. Fresno righty Bryan Perez (4-5) suffered the tough-luck loss despite a quality start. Perez chucked six innings of two-run ball, allowing a pair of hits and walks while fanning six. Unfortunately, Perez beamed four batters as well, tying a Grizzlies franchise record for most hit-by-pitches in a game. Mike McMullen had the previous record set on July 18, 2000 at Beiden Field. Perez was not even born yet when that record was established, and Grizzlies OF Brad Cumbest was just five days old. Despite all the hit-by-pitches and free passes, the Storm didn't record a hit or a run until the top of the sixth inning. B.Y. Choi roped his first extra-base hit and RBI for Lake Elsinore with a double to the gap. It was followed by a Ryan Wilson RBI triple to put the Storm ahead 2-1. That frame also had the record-breaking hit-by-pitch to Colton Vincent. Lake Elsinore notched two insurance runs, one in the eighth and another in the ninth. An error plated Oswaldo Linares and a Choi RBI single netted Jose Sanabria.

GRIZZLIES VS. STORM: The Fresno Grizzlies and Lake Elsinore Storm (San Diego Padres Single-A affiliate) continue their six-game series tonight at Chukchansi Park. This is the second of two series between the clubs in 2024 and the only regular season series in Fresno. In 2022, the Storm won the California League crown after sweeping the Grizzlies 2-0 in the Championship Series, celebrating on Fresno's field. Lake Elsinore joined the California League in 1994 and are one of four teams in the Southern Division. The Storm are affiliated with the San Diego Padres organization and have been since the start of the 2001 season. Prior to that, the team had ties with the California Angels from 1981-2000. Lake Elsinore has gone through a couple name and location changes in their club history. In 1979, they were known as the Santa Clara Padres. From 1980-85, they were named the Redwood Pioneers and from 1986-1993, they were the Palm Springs Angels. Since 2004, Lake Elsinore have been known as the Storm and have called their home at Lake Elsinore Diamond or just, The Diamond. It takes five hours and 25 minutes on average to drive from Chukchansi Park to The Diamond via car.

NOJO IN FRESNO FOR MLB REHAB: The Colorado Rockies have sent OF Nolan Jones to the Grizzlies for a rehab assignment (lower back strain, 10-Day IL). This is the second time this season that Fresno will be graced with a rehabber from Colorado. RHP Gerardo Márquez started for Fresno on June 16 versus Rancho Cucamonga. Jones enters his ninth professional season and his second with the Rockies. He was dealt to Colorado from the Cleveland Guardians on November 15, 2022 for former Grizzlies INF Juan Brito. In 2023, Jones finished fourth in National League Rookie of the Year voting after becoming the first rookie in Major League history to have at least 20 home runs, 20 stolen bases and 19 outfield assists in a season. Jones led the Majors with 19 outfield assists in 93 games in 2023, a franchise record surpassing Dante Bichette's 17 assists in 144 games in 1999. Welcome to Growlifornia Nolan Jones!

CALAZ JOINS THE GRIZZLIES: Rockies #11 overall prospect Robert Calaz has been assigned to the Grizzlies as of August 2. The Dominican outfielder has dominated in his two years since signing as an international free agent on January 15, 2023 for \$1.7 million (17 years old at the time). Calaz, who is now 18, is coming off a MVP season down with the ACL Rockies, where he led the league in Triple Crown categories (HR, AVG, RBI). Before joining Fresno, Calaz led the ACL in seven different statistical categories over 49 games; batting average (.349), homers (10), RBI (45), OBP (.462), slugging percentage (.651), OPS (1.113) and total bases (112). Calaz has been compared to former Grizzlies OF Yanquiel Fernandez. Welcome to Growlifornia Robert Calaz!

FARM GROWN: Tonight, the Grizzlies hand the ball to RHP Jace Kaminska. Kaminska was selected by the Rockies in the 10th round (Pick 292) of the 2023 MLB Draft out of Nebraska. Kaminska made 14 starts for the Cornhuskers in 2023, going 7-3 with a 4.13 ERA and 114 WHIP. Prior to Nebraska, Kaminska pitched for Wichita State and Caney Valley High School in Caney, Kansas.

NO WALKS WHEN YOU FACE JACE: Grizzlies RHP Jace Kaminska has issued one walk over his last seven outings (June 9-July 24), spanning 39 innings. Kaminska has allowed 42 hits and fanned 48 batters in that stretch. He has also not permitted a walk in four straight games (June 30-July 24), spanning 23 innings. Kaminska has scattered 20 hits and struck out 27 batters in that stretch.

ANDY IS DANDY: Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez ranks among the Top 10 in eight different California League categories. Perez ranks first in hits (109), first in total bases (170), first in extra-base hits (37), tied for first in triples (6), tied for second in doubles (21), third in RBI (61), sixth in batting average (.286) and 10th in slugging percentage (.446).

ANDY PEREZ JOINS THE GRIZZLIES CAREER RECORD BOOKS: Grizzlies' INF Andy Perez joined the Grizzlies record books after logging his 13th career triple with two outs in the top of the first June 29 at San Jose. He is now tied with Juan Melo and Roger Kieschnick for ninth all-time with those 13 triples. Up next for Perez are Clay Timpner and Jason Ellison, who have tallied 14 triples apiece.

MORE RECORDS FOR ANDY PEREZ: Andy Perez's triple on June 29 at San Jose was his sixth triple of 2024, putting him one triple shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Records AGAIN. Perez (2023), Preston Tucker (2017), Nate Schierholtz (2007), Jason Ellison (2004) and Calvin Murray (1999) each recorded seven triples in their respective seasons. The Cuban native would become the second Grizzlies player (Nate Schierholtz, 2007-08) to join the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Triples list twice.

NEW MAN AT THE TOP OF THE LINEUP: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has relished his role as the team's leadoff hitter. When Hobson has been plugged into the leadoff spot, he has reached base 68 times in 179 plate appearances (38 games; 38% he is reaching base in the leadoff spot). In 11 of those 38 games, Hobson has made it on base three or more times, combining to score 33 runs. Part of Hobson's success is in his first plate appearance of the game, where he is 9-for-30 (.300) with a double, seven walks and one hit-by-pitch (17-for-38, 45% of the time he reaches base in first plate appearance). Eight of his nine hits have been singles with three of them landing as bunt singles. Hobson has also swiped 18 total bags as a leadoff hitter, picking up two stolen bases in five of those leadoff games (30/34 in stolen bases on the season).

RUNNING CLOSER TO THE RECORD BOOKS: Grizzlies' OF Caleb Hobson has swiped 30 bases this season. Hobson is currently five stolen bases shy of joining the Grizzlies Top 10 Single-Season Records in that category. Tyler Graham (2010), Darren Ford (2014), Jonathan Villar (2015) and Myles Straw (2018) are tied for ninth all-time with 35 stolen bases.
