**PODKUL'S THREE RBI DAY LEADS FISHER CATS TO SERIES VICTORY:** Nick Podkul drove home three runs and reached base four times as New Hampshire survived a late Portland surge to win the series finale, 7-6. Five different Fisher Cats recorded a run batted in as Maximo Castillo moved back into a tie for the league lead in wins, picking up his eighth. Emerson Jimenez earned his first save of the season in the win.

**JULY:** The Fisher Cats finished the month 12-13, spending all but one day in July in third place behind Somerset and Portland. New Hampshire hit .257 for the month with 16 homers and 112 runs scored. The team ERA was 4.20 with 109 runs allowed.

**TRADE DEADLINE:** Two Fisher Cats were involved in a deadline deal between the Blue Jays and Twins. The Blue Jays traded 2020 overall #5 pick Austin Martin and RHP Simeon Woods Richardson for Jose Berrios. Martin slashed .281/.424/.383 in 55 games for the Fisher Cats. Woods Richardson, who Toronto had acquired from the Mets in the Marcus Stroman deal, is currently with the US Olympic team in Tokyo. He went 2-4 with a 5.76 ERA in 11 starts for New Hampshire. Woods Richardson impressed with 67 strikeouts in just 45.1 IP. The pair have been added to the roster of Double-A Wichita Wind Surge.

**UP NEXT:** The Fisher Cats will head on their second 12-game road trip of the season following this week. They will first visit Harrisburg (Washington Nationals) before heading to Hartford to close out the season series with the Yard Goats.

**BOB LIPMAN'S THIS DATE IN FISHER CATS HISTORY:** August 3, 2017—The Fisher Cats shut out Bowie 3-0 in Manchester behind Ryan Borucki. Borucki went seven innings to pick-up his first Double-A win. He allowed six hits, did not walk a batter, striking out seven. All three runs were scored in the fifth. Tim Lopes singled and Emilio Guerrero doubled him home. Gunnar Heidt reached on an error and Richard Urena doubled them home.

**MANCHESTER BOSTON REGIONAL AIRPORT FLIGHT TO THE MAJORS:** The Blue Jays opened a series at home against Cleveland with a 5-2, 10-inning loss. Vladimir Guerrero Jr. tied the game at 2-2 in the bottom of the sixth with his 34<sup>th</sup> home run. Jose Ramirez homered in the Indians tenth off Brad Hand....Triple-A Buffalo stats a series at Lehigh Valley trailing first-place Scranton/WB by two games.

**RECENT ROSTER MOVES:** August 2: Otto Lopez promoted to Triple-A Buffalo and Vinny Capra returned from the Bisons. Pitchers Adrian Hernandez and Brandon Eisert added from Adv. A Vancouver.

## STARTERS:

Reilly Hovis will get the start for the Fisher Cats in the opening game of the series today. Hovis, signed out of independent ball in June, is coming off of his first win of the season. Last time out, Hovis went five innings, giving up four hits and one unearned run as the Fisher Cats won game one of the doubleheader with Portland. In Hovis' last three starts, he has gone five innings in each and only allowed two total earned runs.

For Hartford, David Hill will make his second start of the season against New Hampshire. Hill was on the injured list the last time these teams met, and this will be his third start since returning from injury. He has a record of 1-2 on the season in Double-A with a WHIP of 1.43. In his one start against the Fisher Cats, he gave up one run on four hits and struck out seven.
