YESTERDAY: The Flying Squirrels were handed their sixth straight loss, falling to the Bowie Baysox, 6-1. Bowie posted three runs in the first inning with a sac fly by Patrick Dorrian and a two-run homer by Toby Welk. In the third, Cadyn Grenier extended the lead to 4-0 with an RBI single. **Will Wilson** grounded into a force out in the fifth that scored **Shane Matheny**, giving the Flying Squirrels their only run. The Baysox added a run in the seventh when Kyle Stowers scored on a wild pitch and Greg Cullen hit a solo homer in the ninth to push the lead to 6-1. Caleb Kilian allowed a career-high four runs over 4.0 innings in his start.

**TODAY'S GAME**: The Flying Squirrels play the second of a six-game series against the Bowie Baysox, Double-A affiliate of the Baltimore Orioles. This series is the third of the season between the Flying Squirrels and Baysox. The Flying Squirrels lost four of six in Bowie's first trip to The Diamond from May 18-23. Richmond won four of six at Prince George's Stadium from July 6-11.

**THE FLYING SQUIRRELS** have lost six straight games, the longest losing streak of the season, after winning 12 of the previous 16. They are in fifth place in the six-team Double-A Northeast Southwest Division, 7.0 games behind first-place Akron. For the season, the Richmond offense is ranked ninth in the league with a .235 batting average. The pitching staff is ranked fourth in the league with a 3.97 ERA for the season.

THE BAYSOX have won five of the last six games and nine of the last 12. They won four of six in last week's home series against Hartford. Bowie's offense is ranked sixth in the league with a .246 batting average and the pitching staff is eighth with a 4.22 ERA. Bowie's roster includes six of MLB.com's top-30 Orioles prospects, including C Adley Rutschman (No. 1/No. 2 overall), RHP Grayson Rodriguez (No. 2/No. 18 overall), LHP D.L. Hall (No. 4/No. 53 overall), 2B Terrin Vavra (No. 10), OF Kyle Stowers (No. 22) and SS Joseph Ortiz (No. 29).

FOR RICHMOND: Right-hander Sean Hjelle makes his 13th start of the 2021 season. He last pitched on Thursday at Akron and allowed four runs over 5.0 innings in a loss. He has faced the Baysox three times this year, combining to go 0-0 with a 2.13 ERA (3 ER/12.2 IP). Hjelle went 1-1 with a 2.49 ERA over six starts from June 4-July 16 before surrendering four runs in his most recent start at Akron last week. In 2019, Hjelle climbed three levels in the Giants' system. He began the year with Single-A Augusta for nine starts, made 14 starts with A-Adv. San Jose and joined the Flying Squirrels for five starts at the end of the year. Hjelle finished the year ranked fourth in the Giants organization in strikeouts (139) and fifth in ERA (3.32). He entered the 2021 season rated by Baseball America as the Giants' No. 13 prospect. Hjelle was drafted in the second round in 2018 out of the University of Kentucky. For more on Hjelle, see page two.

FOR BOWIE: Right-hander Grey Fenter makes his sixth start and his 14th overall appearance of the season. He last pitched last Wednesday against Hartford and allowed two unearned runs in 1.1 innings. Over his last four games (three starts) since July 1, Fenter has gone 1-0 with a 3.68 ERA. He has faced Richmond three times this year, combining to go 1-1 with a 7.59 ERA (9 ER/10.2 IP). Fenter was selected by the Orioles in the seventh round of the 2015 MLB Draft. He spent the 2019 season with the Low-A Delmarva Shorebirds, going 8-2 with a 1.81 ERA in 22 games (17 starts).

POWER SURGE: Over the last 19 games since July 6, the Flying Squirrels have hit 27 home runs, which is the fourth-most in the Double-A Northeast. Vince Fernandez has hit six homers during that stretch. Heliot Ramos hit four homers in that span before his promotion to Triple-A. Diego Rincones and Frankie Tostado have hit three. Sandro Fabian, Will Wilson and Brandon Martorano have two homers. Andres Angulo, Luis Basabe, Andy Sugilio, David Villar and Simon Whiteman have each hit one homer in that span. For the season, the Flying Squirrels rank tied for eighth in the circuit with 78 home runs. The team is on pace to hit 128 home runs this season in 120 games. The franchise record for the most home runs in a season is 108 in 2013. In 2019, the Flying Squirrels hit 84 homers in 139 games. Fernandez leads the team with 13 home runs this season. In 2019, **Gio Brusa** led the Flying Squirrels with 12 home runs for the season. This year, the team has combined for a .390 slugging percentage, which is 11th in the league but would be the highest in the franchise's history.

SWINGING FOR THE VINCE: In his last 18 games since June 30, Vince Fernandez is batting .333 (22-for-66) with six home runs, four doubles and 17 RBIs. Fernandez is ranked first on the team with 12 homers this season and second with 33 RBIs. In his last six games since July 18, Fernandez is batting .120 (3-for-25) with 11 strikeouts.

SIMON SAYS: Simon Whiteman is batting .342 (13-for-38) over his last 11 games since July 15 with four doubles, one homer and five RBIs. Whiteman leads the team with 12 stolen bases this season, which is tied for fourth in the Double-A Northeast. For the ear, Whiteman has picked up a total of 29 steals in 32 attempts, which includes his time with High-A Eugene, where he played 28 games to begin the season.

BREAKING OUT: David Villar has hit .313 (40-for-128) with six homers and 15 RBIs over his last 34 games since June 16. For the season, Villar is second on the team with 11 homers and third with 31 RBIs.

GO, DIEGO, GO!: Diego Rincones homered in three straight games from July 17-20, including a go-ahead homer on July 17 against Somerset in the eighth inning and a game-tying home run at Akron last Tuesday. He went on a seven-game hitting streak from July 17-25, which was snapped on Tuesday. Over that streak, Rincones hit .320 (8-for-25) with three homers, one double, one triple and 10 RBIs.

LEFT ON BASE: In the current six-game losing streak, the Flying Squirrels have hit .098 (5-for-51) with runners in scoring position and have left 56 runners on base. For the year, Richmond has hit .130 (7-for-54) with the bases loaded, which is the lowest mark in all of minor league baseball this season.

IN THE LEAGUE LEADERS: Vince Fernandez is ranked tied for eighth with 13 home runs. Frankie Tostado is ranked tied for eighth with 45 hits. Simon Whiteman is tied for fourth with 12 stolen bases. Frank Rubio (26/4th), Joey Marciano (25/T-5th) and Raffi Vizcaino (24/T-7th) are in the top-ten in the league in games pitched. RJ Dabovich, Norwith Gudino and Patrick Ruotolo are tied for seventh in the circuit with five saves. Caleb Kilian is ranked second in ERA (2.43), fourth in BAA (.221), second in WHIP (0.94), first in compete games (2) and first in shutouts (1).

WINNING WAYS: The Flying Squirrels' 38-35 record is tied for the second-best record in team history through 73 games, even with the 2011, 2015 and 2018 seasons. The only season with a better start was 2014, when the team went 42-31. Richmond is looking for its first winning season since 2015, when the team went 72-68.

PROSPECT WATCH: The Flying Squirrels have four players included in Baseball America's Top-30 Giants prospects: Will Wilson (10), Tristan Beck (13 - on IL), Sean Hjelle (14) and Jose Marte (30). Simon Whiteman is rated by Baseball America as being the "Fastest Baserunner" in the Giants system, Hjelle is rated as having the "Best Control" and Diego Rincones is rated as having the "Best Outfield Arm." Four players, including Hjelle (11), Wilson (12), Beck (20) and Caleb Kilian (30) are also ranked in MLB.com's Top-30 Giants prospects. RICHMOND
