BACK IN THE SADDLE

MANAGER MIKE GUERRERO returns to the Shuckers dugout for 2026 after 2 seasons as a Roving Infield Instructor with the Brewers organization... Guerrero enters his 9th season with the Shuckers, 10th in Double-A and 31st in the Brewers organization.

- Guerrero has managed 71 of the 82 former Shuckers who have gone on to make their MLB debuts, including RHP Corbin Burnes, RHP Freddy Peralta, OF Jackson Chourio, LHP Josh Hader and 2B Brice Turang.
- After reaching 1,400 career wins during the 2023 season, Guerrero needs 55 wins during the 2026 season to reach 1,500... His 1,445 wins are the sixth-most among active managers in Minor League Baseball.

MADE FOR THE BIG STAGE

SS/2B JESÚS MADE (muh-DAY) enters the 2026 season as the top-ranked Brewers prospect and the 3rd-ranked overall prospect by *Baseball America*.

- Made is the 4th Brewers player to enter the season as a Top-5 prospect and the 9th player to enter the season as a Top-10 prospect since *Baseball America* began their Top-100 rankings in 1990.
- Made joins Jackson Chourio (2023), Rickie Weeks (2005) and Ben Sheets (2001).
- Made earned a Non-Roster Invite to Spring Training... In 19 appearances, he went 9-for-29 (.310) with a triple, walk and 2 stolen bases.

IT'S A PLAYOFF PARTY

In 2025, the Shuckers reached the playoffs for the second consecutive season, the first time the team had reached the playoffs in back-to-back seasons since 2018 and 2019... Since 2015, the Shuckers have reached the playoffs 5 times, including trips to the SLCS in 2015, 2018 and 2019.

- A Brewers Double-A affiliate has reached the playoffs 25 times, including the most recent outright league championship by the 1994 El Paso Diablos (Texas League).

ONE FINAL TUNE-UP

The Shuckers welcome the Pearl River Wildcats for a 7-inning exhibition game, the team's final tune-up before Opening Day... Today marks the 4th consecutive year the Shuckers have welcomed Pearl River for an exhibition game... The Shuckers had previously played against William Carey University in an exhibition game from 2017-2019 and 2022.

PROSPECT-PALOOZA

The Shuckers have 4 Top 30 prospects on their initial roster, including 1 Top-100 prospects and 2 Top-10 prospects.

- The 4 are: **SS/2B JESÚS MADE** (No. 1, No. 3 overall), **RHP BISHOP LETSON** (No. 7), **RHP TYSON HARDIN** (No. 13), **1B BLAKE BURKE** (No. 18).

THE YOUNG AND RESTLESS

The average age of the Shuckers roster is 23.0 years old, including an average age of 22.6 for pitchers and 23.4 for hitters... **SS/2B JESÚS MADE** (18y-328d on Opening Day) is the youngest player on the roster... **RHP MANUEL RODRIGUEZ** (20y-236d on Opening Day) is the youngest pitcher.

NEW FRIENDS AND OLD

15 of the 27 players on the Shuckers Opening Day roster made at least one appearance with the team in 2025... 18 of the 27 players made at least one appearance in Double-A in 2025, including organizational newcomers **OF DASAN BROWN**, **OF JORDYN ADAMS** and **OF DAMON KEITH**.

ON TOP OF THE WORLD

Former Shuckers **OF JACKSON CHOURIO** became the 1st former Shucker to win a World Baseball Classic title as Venezuela beat the USA, 3-2, in the finals... Chourio and **SS BRICE TURANG** (USA) became the 4th and 5th Shuckers to reach the World Baseball Classic final.

TIME TO GET FAMILIAR

The Shuckers begin the 2026 season with 33 consecutive games against the same 3 opponents; the Rocket City Trash Pandas (LAA), Pensacola Blue Wahoos (MIA) and Columbus Clingstones (ATL)... The Shuckers play 45 of 69 games in the first half against those 3 opponents, including 24 games against the Clingstones.

TODAY'S STARTING PITCHER

RHP JARON DeBERRY (2026 Debut) makes his final Spring Training appearance... In 2025, DeBerry held a 3.62 ERA (15er, 37.1ip), with 34 strikeouts across 7 starts with the Shuckers... DeBerry held left-handed batters to a .189 average (14-for-74) with a 23.1% strikeout rate across 100.2 innings at three levels.
