**ABOUT LAST NIGHT...** A three-run fifth spurred the Vancouver Canadians to a 6-1 win over the Hillsboro Hops (Diamondbacks) Wednesday night as the C's won their seventh consecutive game to move into a tie for first place in the High-A West League.

After trading blows in the first, Vancouver and Hillsboro were locked in a 1-1 tie to start the fifth. After two quick outs, Hops starter Ryne Nelson (L, 0-1) issued a walk to Tanner Kirwer after retiring 13 of the last 14 batters he faced. Up stepped Phil Clarke, who laced a double into the corner in right field to score Kirwer from first and put the Blue Jays affiliate up 2-1. After a pitching change, Cameron Eden greeted the new reliever with his first Advanced-A home run, a 420-foot blast that plated a pair and gave the C's a 4-1 advantage.

Right-hander Troy Miller (W, 2-0) continued to impress in what was his third start of the year. Miller didn't have his best stuff but still limited Hillsboro to a single run on two hits in five innings pitched. He worked around five walks and struck out four to earn the win.

The C's added single runs in the sixth and ninth to pad their lead. Luis De Los Santos was hit by a pitch in the sixth stanza and scored on a DJ Neal single to left field, while Neal started the ninth with a rule book double to left and came home later in the frame on a bang-bang play at the plate after Kirwer dribbled one out in front of the batter's box.

Lazaro Estrada and Justin Maese handled the final four innings after Miller's departure. The former made his C's debut with two shutout frames while the latter faced seven batters in the final two stanzas to secure the win.

Kirwer kick-started the offense with a lead-off home run on the second pitch of the game, his team-high fourth of the year and the first time a Canadians lead-off batter has left the yard in the first inning.

**BATTLE FOR THE BORO:** This week marks the first meeting between Vancouver and Hillsboro. The C's and the Hops will match-up in five series this season; three with the Hops as the home team and two with the Canadians "hosting" the Diamondbacks affiliate. Vancouver leads 2-0.

**HOME AWAY FROM HOME:** Due to pandemic-related border closures, Ron Tonkin Field in Hillsboro will serve as Vancouver's home ballpark this year. 78 of 120 C's game will take place in the Tualatin Valley over the course of the season (60 home games, 18 against Hillsboro as the visitors).

**GOING STREAKING:** The C's enter tonight riding a seven-game winning streak, the longest active streak in the High-A West League and the team's longest since 2012, when they won seven in a row from August 29-September 6. That team, managed by Clayton McCullough, featured Marcus Stroman, Daniel Norris, Taylor Cole, Ian Parmley, Dalton Pompey and Dwight Smith Jr. They went on to win the Northwest League crown.

**GET AHEAD, STAY AHEAD:** Vancouver is 7-1 when they score first, and they're undefeated when leading after the seventh inning or later.

**RUNNING AMOK:** Cameron Eden and Tanner Kirwer lead the High-A West League with 12 and eight stolen bases, respectively. Eden has only been caught once while Kirwer has been nabbed twice. The C's have stolen 26 bases, tied for the eighth-most in High-A. Hillsboro leads the level with 38 bags.

**LEAGUE LEADERS:** Canadians are all over the High-A West League leaderboard. Out of 24 categories, at least one C's player is counted in 21 of them. Offensively, Luis De Los Santos leads the circuit with 13 RBI, Spencer Horwitz is tops in OBP (.542) and walks (18) and Cameron Eden leads in steals (11). A league-best four players are ranked in the top 10 in batting average and six in the top 10 for on-base percentage. On the mound, Adam Kloffenstein and Troy Miller are 1-2 in opponent's batting average (.136 and .140, respectively). Parker Caracci and Nick Frazee are tied atop the wins category with two apiece.

**GARDEN OF EDEN:** Vancouver outfielder Cameron Eden is in the midst of a blistering stretch at the plate. In his last three games, the Yuba City, CA native is 8-14 (.571) with six runs scored, five RBI and a home run. He hit a game-tying single in the ninth on Sunday against Spokane and drove in the game-winner later that afternoon.

**ON THE HILL:** #10 Blue Jays prospect (MLB.com) CJ Van Eyk makes his third professional start tonight. In his last turn on May 13 against Spokane, the right-hander went 4.2 innings in which he scattered three hits, gave up one run (a homer), walked two and struck out a season-high seven. Van Eyk, 22, was a second round pick in last year's draft out of Florida State.

RHP Bryce Jarvis gets the nod for Hillsboro. The #8 Diamondbacks prospect (MLB.com) took a tough-luck loss in his last turn on May 14 in Eugene, when he allowed two runs on four hits over a season-high 6.2 frames, didn't walk a batter and struck out a team-high nine batters. He was the 18<sup>th</sup> overall pick in 2020.

Off the field, Cundari runs his own private practice as a sports performance consultant. He is a licensed psychotherapist and specializes in peak performance and mental toughness for athletes of all levels.
