FRES-NOTES

TO INFINITY AND BEYOND: Tanner Thach keeps reaching new heights entering the weekend riding a California League-best 19-game hitting streak. It's the longest active streak in all of Minor League Baseball and the third longest hitting streak this year. Fresno's slugging first basemen continues to impress, collecting 30 hits since May 7 while continuing to launch himself atop the league leaderboards. Thach ranks among the CAL leaders in nearly every offensive category, including 1st in RBI (52), hits (69), total bases (115), extra-base hits (26) and slugging (.584) while sitting second in batting average (.350) and top three in OPS (1.002). During the streak, he has reached base 39 times, giving Fresno a true "to infinity and beyond" offensive engine in the middle of the order.

YOU'VE GOT A FRIEND IN THE BULLPEN: The Grizzlies bullpen is as well rested as its been all season as Riley Kelly, Angel Jimenez, and Ethan Cole turned in starts of at least five innings apiece. Its the first time this season that Fresno has had the starting pitcher make it through five innings for three consecutive games and setup a pair of games in which Fresno needed just two arms to complete nine innings on the mound. The bullpen has equally stepped up with Manuel Olivares, Dylan Crooks, Seth Clausen and Easton Marks each delivering scoreless outings this week against the Giants.

SNAKE IN THE BATTER'S BOX: Two of the highest scoring offenses in the California League have been limited to just six runs combined over the last two games. Fresno averaged 7.7 runs by itself in the six game series in San Jose. Even more baffling, each pitching staff has been below its average K/9 in the first three games of the series while neither offense has matched its usual walk rate, meaning both defenses have been pressed into action more often to help stymie their oppositions. More contact, but less runs which has allowed Ontario to surpass both teams for the most runs scored this season.
