LAST TIME OUT: The Cyclones' bats put on a clinic on Friday night, in a dominant 12-5 victory over Rome...RHP **Kade Morris** continued his spectacular stretch by taking a perfect game into the seventh inning, en route to his fourth High-A win of the season...Morris finished with six strikeouts and did not walk a batter in 6.1 innings...C **Chris Suero** and LF **Omar De Los Santos** each tattooed two-run home runs and were two of six Cyclones to finish with multi-hit efforts...SS **Mateo Gil** and 1B **Kellum Clark** registered three-hit games, while CF **Nick Morabito** and 3B **Jeffrey De Los Santos** added two hits apiece...Brooklyn was catapulted by a five-run second inning, following it up with a four-run fourth frame to take a commanding 9-0 lead they would not relinquish...The 12 runs plated by Brooklyn are the most in a single contest since a 13-7 takedown of Aberdeen on June 7...The six extra-base hits also tied the season-high for a single game.

THIS DATE IN CYCLONES' HISTORY: On July 27, 2009, trailing 2-0 in the eighth, the Cyclones rallied tie to tie the game two on a 1B **Sam Honeck** ground out and a fielding error...The Cyclones walked off Aberdeen in the bottom of the 14th, 3-2, when SS **Robbie Shields** scored on a wild pitch...In 2011, **Michael Terry** became the 3 millionth fan in Cyclones history, walking through the gates of the then-MCU Park...Brooklyn accomplished the feat faster than any other short-season team in history...In 2014, RF **Michael Bernal** went 4-for-4 with two doubles and four runs batted in coming off the bench in a 9-3 win at Lowell for the Cyclones' 600th win in franchise history...In 2021, the Cyclones set a franchise record with six home runs in a 14-5 win at Jersey Shore...DH **Edgardo Fernin** and SS **Ronny Mauricio** each homered twice, with the former driving in five runs...1B **Jeremy Vasquez** and 2B **Luis González** added the other two long balls.

BYE BYE RHY: OF **Rhylan Thomas** — who spent part of the 2023 season with the Cyclones — was traded by the New York Mets on Friday night to the Seattle Mariners in exchange for RHP **Ryne Stanek**...Thomas appeared in 39 games for Brooklyn last year, hitting .341/.432/.429 with a .861 OPS, adding 19 runs scored, five doubles, two home runs, 16 RBI, and more walks (19) than strikeouts (10)...The 2022 11th-round pick spent the 2024 campaign at Double-A Binghamton and Triple-A Syracuse before the deal.

'TALK 2 'EM: RHP **Kade Morris** has found his stride at the High-A level...The 22-year-old took a perfect game into the seventh on Friday against Rome and holds a minuscule 2.12 ERA over his last six appearances (five starts) dating back to June 21 vs. Jersey Shore...Morris' record during that span sits at 3-2...He has yielded just 24 hits and 10 walks while striking out 35...Since June 21, Morris has been one of the best arms in the South Atlantic League and is tied with Bowling Green RHP **Yoniel Curet** for the league lead in strikeouts (35)...He is also tied for the SAL lead in wins (3) and is second in innings pitched (34.0), sixth in WHIP (1.00), seventh in ERA (2.12), and tied for eighth in batting average against (.192)...Since making his SAL debut on May 22, Morris is second in the league in innings pitched (57.2), fifth in batting average against (.221), sixth in strikeouts (57), eighth in WHIP (1.16) and 10th in ERA (3.43).

MORABITO BITE: OF **Nick Morabito** has been outstanding throughout the 2024 season...The 21-year-old finished with his 26th multi-hit game of the year in Friday's win, and notched the go-ahead RBI single on Tuesday, in addition to scoring from second base on a sacrifice fly for an insurance run...The McLean, Va. native is 10th in Minor League Baseball in stolen bases (42)...Since making his SAL debut on May 7, Morabito has led the league in hits (69), is second in stolen bases (31), tied for fifth in runs scored (42), and 10th in batting average (.280)...The former second-round selection is tied for fifth in the SAL in stolen bases (31), ninth in batting average (.280), and 10th in on-base percentage (.366) on the season...The 21-year-old leads all full-season Mets farmhands in batting average (.309), stolen bases (42) and on-base percentage (.409)...He is also second in hits (100) and runs scored (56), and tied for fifth in triples (3).

GRAB A PINT-ARO: RHP **Jonathan Pintaro** has been on a tear over the past month or so...The Pelham, Ala. native surrendered only one unearned run over 4.2 frames of work in Tuesday's win over Rome...The 26-year-old has not surrendered an earned run since June 25 at Aberdeen...Over his four July outings, the veteran has a 0.00 ERA (0 ER in 14.0 IP), with eight hits, two hit batters, five walks, and 15 strikeouts...Pintaro is tied for the South Atlantic League lead in ERA (0.00) and is fifth in batting average against (.160) and tied for eighth in WHIP (0.93) during the month...As a starter, Pintaro sports a 2.96 ERA across six games, while giving up only one earned run over two relief appearances...Unfortunately, Shorter University has not received a lot of run support...The 'Clones have mustered only four runs with Pintaro on the bump against his six starts this season.

TAKING KELLUM 123: OF **Kellum Clark** snapped out a 1-for-37 funk at the plate with a three-hit game on July 6 at Hudson Valley and has been on a tear offensively since...The 23-year-old had a four-game multi-hit streak snapped last Saturday but has six multi-hit efforts in his last 12 games...Since July 6, he is hitting .381/.435/.429 with a .864 OPS, five runs scored, two doubles, and three runs batted in over 12 games...Clark is second in the league in batting average (.381) and on-base percentage (.435), and fourth in hits (16) since that date.

vs. ROME: Brooklyn continues a nine-game homestand with six contests against the Braves' High-A affiliate...The Emperors have six of Atlanta's top 30 prospects per MLB Pipeline: RHP **Cade Kuehler** (7), RHP **Jhancarlos Lara** (12), INF **Sabin Ceballos** (17), and RHP **Blake Burkhalter** (26)...RHP **Owen Murphy** (4) and INF **Ambioris Tavarez** (20) are on the injured list...This marks Rome's first trip to Coney Island and the second series ever between the two franchises...Brooklyn and Rome split a six-game series at AdventHealth Stadium from May 7-12.

OMAR-I-GONE: OF **Omar De Los Santos** rejoined Brooklyn's roster on June 24 from Double-A Binghamton...The 24-year-old went yard again on Friday night, and has homered four times in his last seven games, going 8-for-26 (.308) at the plate with eight runs scored, a double, and seven runs batted in...Despite spending a month at Double-A, De Los Santos is still fourth in the South Atlantic League with 33 stolen bases...The Santo Domingo, D.R. native set Brooklyn's single-season stolen base record (37) in 2023 and broke UT **Jaylen Palmer's** (50) all-time franchise mark for stolen bases (70) earlier this season on May 2 vs. Aberdeen...Since the start of the 2022 season, De Los Santos has led the South Atlantic League (70) and is tied for fourth across Minor League Baseball in swiped bags (142).

SHUT IT: Brooklyn has been no stranger to tossing shutouts lately...The Cyclones tied a franchise record with its 11th shutout win of the season on July 14's 5-0 win at Wilmington...The 11 shutout performances match the 2023 mark for the single-season record...The 11 shutouts are two behind Rome (13) for the most in the South Atlantic League...The Cyclones are also tied for fifth in all of Minor League Baseball in shutouts...Brooklyn has thrown consecutive shutouts three times this season...The Cyclones blanked the IronBirds, 2-0 and 4-0, on May 3 and 4 at Maimonides Park...The Cyclones then earned 7-0 and 3-0 wins at Jersey Shore and vs. Aberdeen, respectively.

LOCATION, LOCATION: The Cyclones have several players with intriguing home and road splits in 2024...OF **Nick Morabito** loves his time on the road...He is hitting .302/.385/.396 with a .781 OPS, adding two home runs, nine RBI, and 25 stolen bases in 36 road contests...He is fourth in the circuit in road batting average (.302) and, since his SAL debut, the 21-year-old has had the most road hits (45) and stolen bases (25) in the circuit...In Brooklyn, Morabito has collected a .247/.336/.278 line with a .614 OPS, three extra-base hits, four RBI, and six stolen bases over 24 games...INF **Junior Tilen** has thrived at Maimonides Park, posting a .289/.359/.415 mark with a .774 OPS, three home runs, and 14 RBI in 38 games...On the road, Tilen is hitting .171/.272/.243 with a .515 OPS, a home run, and nine runs batted in over 38 contests...C **Chris Suero** is hitting .270/.389/.473 with a .862 OPS, four home runs and 19 RBI in 21 games on Coney Island...The 20-year-old is batting .170/.284/.250 with a .534 OPS, a home run, and 15 RBI in 33 affairs in visiting ballparks.

THE TONG SONG: RHP **Jonah Tong** has been magnificent for the Cyclones in the last few weeks...Even after suffering a loss on Thursday, the 21-year-old is 2-2 with a 2.30 ERA (7 ER in 27.1 IP), allowing only 18 hits and nine walks, while striking out 40 over his last six starts since June 20...Since making his South Atlantic League debut on May 2, the Markham, Ont. native leads the circuit in strikeouts (78)...He is also fourth in batting average against (.212), sixth in ERA (3.36), and WHIP (1.25), and tied for 10th in innings pitched (59.0)...Tong has been as good as any pitcher in Minor League Baseball this year, tossing 26.0 consecutive innings without allowing an earned run to start the season...Among full-season Minor Leaguers with at least 70.0 innings of work, the Markham, Ont. native is second in FIP (2.07), third in strikeout rate (35.4%), sixth in strikeout-to-walk rate (25.8%) and 10th in strikeouts (114).

FLARE FOR THE DRAMATIC: Brooklyn's 2-1 walk-off win on Wednesday afternoon marked the second time in the last five games that the Cyclones won via a walk-off single...On Friday vs. Jersey Shore, **Chris Suero** provided the game-winning RBI single with the bases loaded in the bottom of the 10th in a 6-5...**Nick Lorusso** delivered the first walk-off win of the year, clubbing a game-ending solo home run in the bottom of the ninth in a 4-3 win vs. Asheville on April 14...On the flip side, Brooklyn has suffered seven walk-off defeats this season, most recently a 3-2 loss at Wilmington on July 12...Since the start of the 2023 season, the Cyclones have suffered 17 walk-off losses, accumulating 14.78% of all defeats, including 26.15% of all road losses, while earning 10 walk-off wins...27 of Brooklyn's 225 games since the start of the 2023 season have ended in a walk-off (12.00%)...The Cyclones have also earned 21 wins in their last at-bat.

AMAZIN' STARTS HERE: The Brooklyn Cyclones have several Top 30 prospects according to *Baseball America* and MLB Pipeline...The 'Clones have four of the Top 30 per BA: INF **Jesús Báez** (10), RHP **Jonah Tong** (17), RHP **Kade Morris** (26), and RHP **Jack Weninger** (30)...Báez is currently on the 7-day injured list...Plus six of the Top 30 per MLB: Tong (19), Báez (21), RHP **Calvin Ziegler** (22), **Wifredo Lara** (23), OF **Nick Morabito** (25), and Morris (26)...Ziegler is on the full-season injured list.

LAST TIME OUT: Took a no-decision last Sunday afternoon vs. Jersey Shore...Surrendered five runs on five hits over 3.1 innings...Walked two and struck out two...Tossed a wild pitch... Threw 69 pitches and 44 strikes (63.77%)...Relieved by RHP **Jawilme Ramirez** with runners at first and second and one out in the top of the fourth and Brooklyn trailing 4-2...One of two bequeathed runners scored...The Cyclones rallied to tie the game in the sixth and take the lead on a CF **Omar De Los Santos** home run in the seventh...However, the BlueClaws tied the game in the ninth and scored three in the 10th to defeat Brooklyn, 9-6.

PROSPECT RADAR: After a stellar 2023 season, De La Cruz was deemed the New York Mets' No. 39 prospect entering the 2024 campaign by *Baseball America*.

HOME COOKING: De La Cruz has been outstanding on Coney Island in 2024...Through his first seven appearance (six starts) of the campaign, the southpaw is 1-2 with a 3.03 ERA (11 ER in 32.2 IP), 15 walks, and 40 strikeouts...De La Cruz has not seen the same level of success on the road...The 23-year-old holds a 2-4 mark in visiting parks, but yields a 6.03 ERA (25 ER in 37.1 IP), with 15 walks, and 38 strikeouts.

FELIP-IN' AMAZIN': The 23-year-old celebrated his birthday a day early by shutting out Hudson Valley on May 25 over 6.0 innings with a career-high 13 strikeouts...De La Cruz was one shy of the single game Brooklyn franchise record of 14 set by LHP **Mike Cox** (8/25/01 vs. HV) and RHP **Brad Holt** (7/24/08 vs. VER)...He was the first Cyclone to strike out 13+ hitters in a single contest since RHP **Rob Gsellman** accomplished the feat on August 24, 2013, at Vermont...De La Cruz is the sixth Cyclones pitcher ever to hit the 13 punchout threshold and the third to strikeout 13 or more in 6.0 or fewer innings.

WELCOME TO BROOKLYN: The 22-year-old joined the Cyclones from Single-A St. Lucie last year on August 22 and thrived over three starts...De La Cruz accumulated a 2-1 record with a 2.45 ERA (5 ER in 17.0 IP) with five walks and 17 strikeouts...The southpaw hurled quality starts in two of his three starts, including going all six innings in the lid-lifter of a doubleheader on August 31 at Greenville...After allowing a leadoff home run, De La Cruz retired 18 of the final 19 batters he faced, including sitting the last 11 down in order...The southpaw was credited with a complete game, the first for a Brooklyn pitcher since RHP **José Butto** accomplished the feat, tossing six innings in a seven-inning loss at Aberdeen in Game 1 of a twinbill on June 30, 2021...After making his SAL debut on August 23 at Asheville, De La Cruz ranked third in the circuit in WHIP (0.94), fifth in batting average against (.183), and sixth in ERA (2.65).

FLORIDA STATE FELIPE: De La Cruz was among the best strikeout artists in the Florida State League in 2023...Among FSL pitchers with 90.0 or more innings pitched, the 22-year-old led the circuit in strikeout rate (28.7%)...The southpaw also led the league in strikeouts-per-9 innings (11.36) and swinging strike rate (15.5%), while ranking 2nd in xFIP (3.68)...In 21 appearances (19 starts) with St. Lucie, De La Cruz was 3-6 with a 4.68 ERA (47 ER in 90.1 IP), 41 walks, and 114 strikeouts.
